

## Do you think you have been discriminated against in your search for housing?

Under federal and state anti-discrimination laws, it is illegal to discriminate in housing sales, rentals, housing lending and insurance on the basis of:

- Race
- Color
- National origin
- Religion
- Sex
- Family status (living with person under 18)
- Disability
- Ancestry

- Age (over 40)
- Marital status
- Source of income (public assistance and/or housing subsidy recipients)
- Sexual orientation
- Military history
- Genetic information
