

FISCAL YEAR INDICATORS

1. DESCRIPTION. The Fiscal Year Indicator is used with program code to specifically identify the appropriation to which a transaction relates in programs which are or once have been funded from single or multi-year appropriations. The indicator is one position, either numeric or alphabetic, and must be entered with all transactions relating to such a program (unless the indicator is "X").

1 -- (or any single number) - for single year appropriations, the last number of the fiscal year. For multi-year appropriations, the last number of the last fiscal year.

M -- for merged accounts.

X -- For those programs with No-Year appropriations, the fiscal year indicator will be left blank on the input formats. The computer will assign the "X" to the transaction.
