



Updated Invitation - 2016 MAP Guide Briefing: Chapters 5 & 9

Please note that the GoToWebinar format is different from the previously published phone conference format, so please ensure all invitees have the invitation shown below. While the Chapter 5 & 9 briefing formats have changed, the times and dates have not. The first webinar will be held on March 10, 2016 at 1:30 PM EST and again on March 15, 2016 at 10:00 AM.

GoToWebinar does not use HUD Technology and this offers several advantages:

1. Seating (capacity) is unlimited and so people can register and sign on from any computer with internet access. No sharing of screens or group viewing is required.
2. Audio and video are tied together and may be accessed via the user's PC or their telephone. The telephone call in number will be sent to each person who registers for the webinar AND IS NOT THE SAME PHONE NUMBER AS PREVIOUSLY ANNOUNCED.

Registering is easy and will automatically enter the GoToWebinar reservation on your calendar (Outlook, Google, etc.) if you give it permission. To avoid confusion, you may want to delete any prior invitation you've received for this same briefing.
