

**Fair Housing Awards
Judging Criteria**

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the awards is to recognize exemplary performance in fair housing by individuals, organizations, and governmental bodies. Nominees must have made an outstanding contribution toward furthering fair housing objectives.

NOMINATION CRITERIA:

The following criteria should be used in considering nominees for these awards:

MAXIMUM POINTS: 100

Criterion 1: 25 Points

-- The nominee's personal performance during the past year made an outstanding contribution toward furthering fair housing.

Criterion 2: 15 Points

-- The nominee's sustained long term contributions to fair housing has made a significant positive difference in their community.

Criterion 3: 35 Points

-- There is clear evidence of the fair housing impact in the community as a direct result of the nominee's performance.

Criterion 4: 25 Points

Rate a or b

a. -- The nominee's fair housing activities or projects extend beyond the scope of their job requirements.

b. -- The nominee's volunteer fair housing activities are note worthy.
