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FOREWORD

This Handbook provides procedures for the implementation of HUD's responsibilities, as set forth in the Memorandum of Understanding Between the Department of Housing and Urban Development and the General Services Administration Concerning Low- and Moderate-Income Housing, executed on June 12, 1971.

The duties of the Department, as set forth in this Handbook, include investigation and reporting procedures whereby HUD will advise GSA as to the availability and accessibility of housing available on a nondiscriminatory basis for low- and moderate-income employees of new and relocating Federal facilities for which GSA is negotiating a site.

In addition, this Handbook provides instructions and compliance procedures for developing and monitoring a written affirmative action plan, which is required to help provide the necessary low- and moderate-income housing available on a nondiscriminatory basis, in the event that GSA chooses a site which HUD has determined is not accessible from a supply of such housing.
