

CHAPTER 8. SPECIAL INTEREST AREAS

8-1. Child Care.

Federal Women's Program Managers and Coordinators involvement in the area of child care may include, but is not limited to, conducting need surveys for centers within their jurisdictions, distributing information about community centers, and keeping employees informed on policy, direction, and legislation about child care. Further, the role of the Federal Women's Program Manager and Coordinator may include sponsoring fund raising activities to support Headquarters or Regional Child Care Centers. In working to institute day care centers, FWP Managers and Coordinators are actively involved in advocating programs directed to the special concerns of women.

8-2. Part-time Professional Program.

As a method of facilitating the employment of women in government, the Part-time Professional Program is one of the most effective means available to management. FWP Managers and Coordinators should explore the use of the Part-time Professional Program and urge managers and supervisors to consider this program when developing staffing plans.
