Important Notice for Applicants for HUD's Fiscal Year 2014-2015 Comprehensive Housing Counseling Program Grant:

Information on the Grace Period: If your application is received by Grants.gov before the deadline, but is rejected with errors, you have a grace period of one day beyond the application deadline to submit a corrected application that is received and validated by Grants.gov. The Department will use the date and time stamp on the Grants.gov system to determine dates when the grace period ends. The grace period ends at 11:59:59 p.m. Eastern time one calendar day after the deadline date published in the Program NOFA. Any application submitted during the grace period that does not meet the criteria above will not be considered for funding. Please contact the [Grants.gov](#) Customer Support Center for assistance. There is no grace period for paper applications.
