### **FY 2014 FHIP Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA):**

The FY 2014 Fair Housing Initiative Program (FHIP) Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) was published on [www.grants.gov](http://www.grants.gov) on July 31, 2014. The NOFA closing date is September 02, 2014. The total funding amount available under this NOFA is \$38,300,000. Click the following link to access the FHIP NOFA: [View the FY2014 FHIP NOFA on-line](#). As a reminder, there are additional Departmental requirements that may not be identified in the FHIP program NOFA. Please ensure that you read [HUD's General Section](#).

To apply for a FHIP grant, all applicants must have an active registration in the System for Award Management (SAM) system. We strongly recommend that your organization check SAM to ensure that all information is up-to-date and active. If you are a new organization using grants.gov for the first time, we recommend that you visit [grants.gov](http://grants.gov) to get detailed registration information. The grants.gov registration process takes from three to five business days to complete; however, it may take as long as four weeks if information is not submitted accurately and timely.
