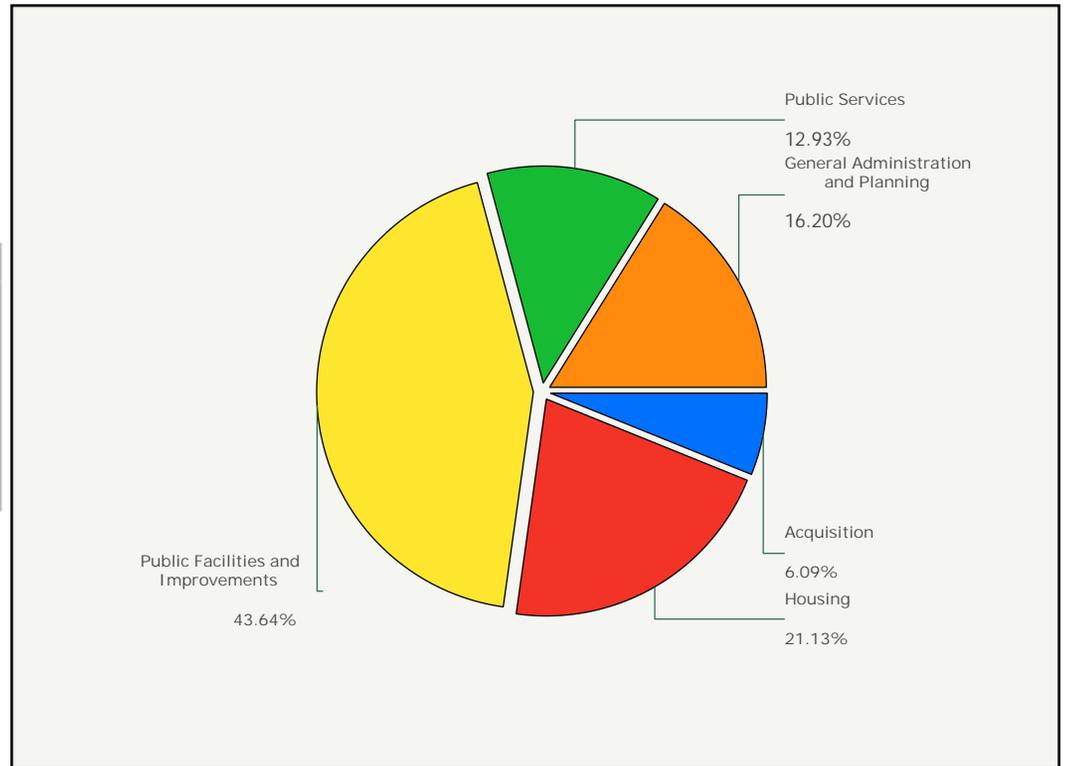

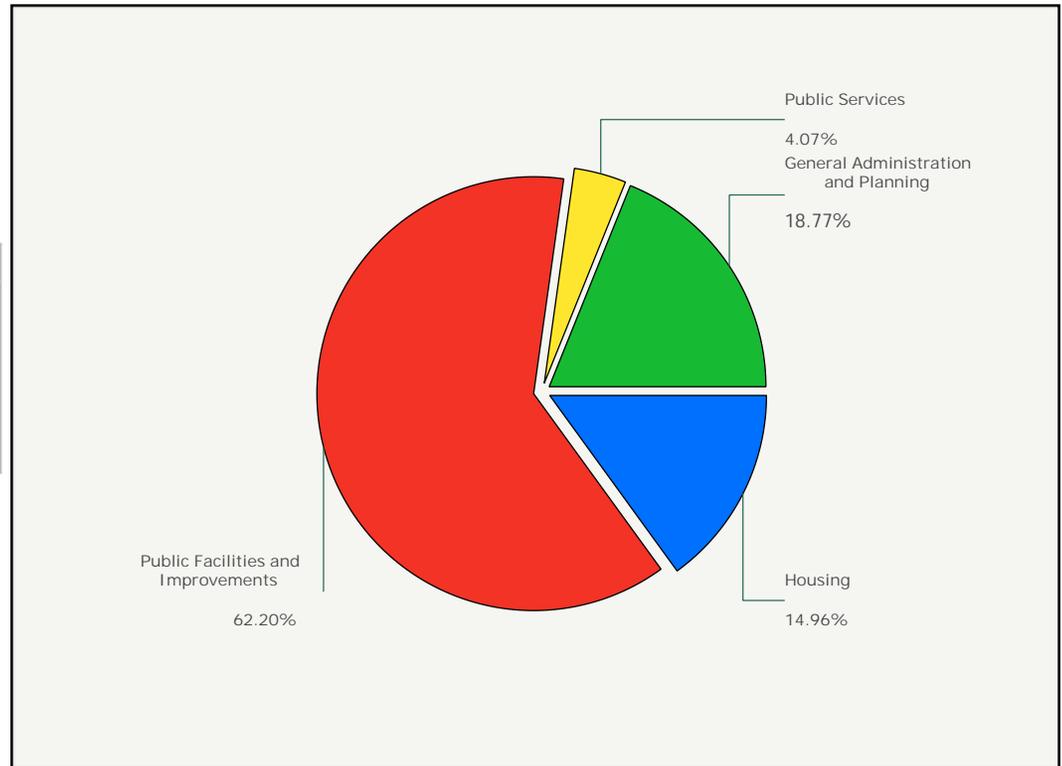

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



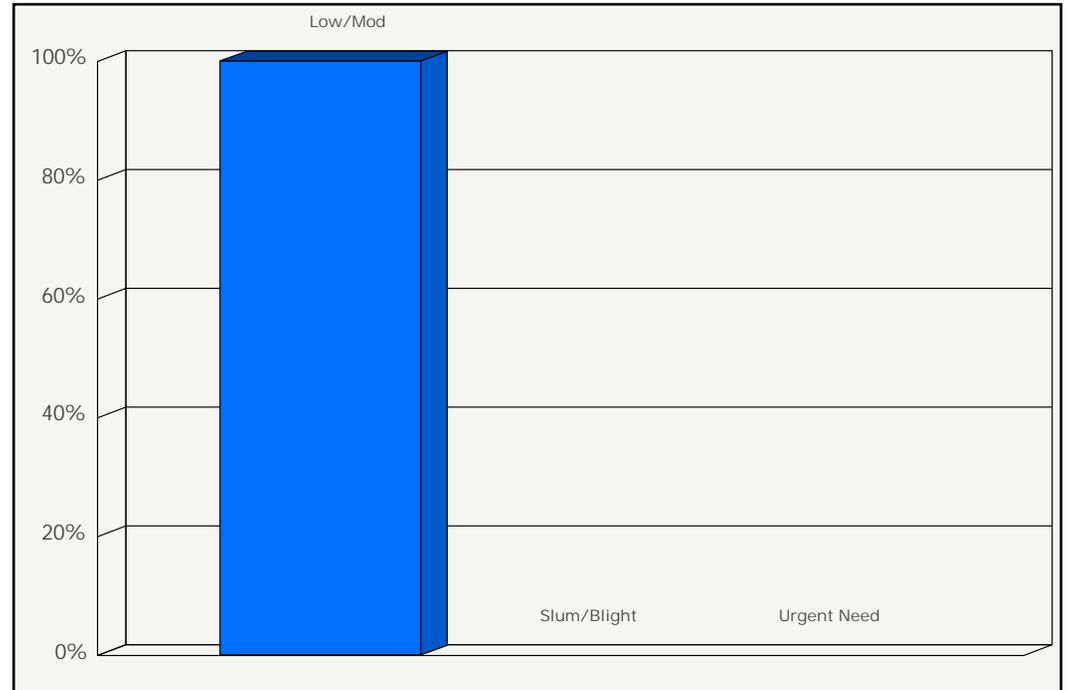

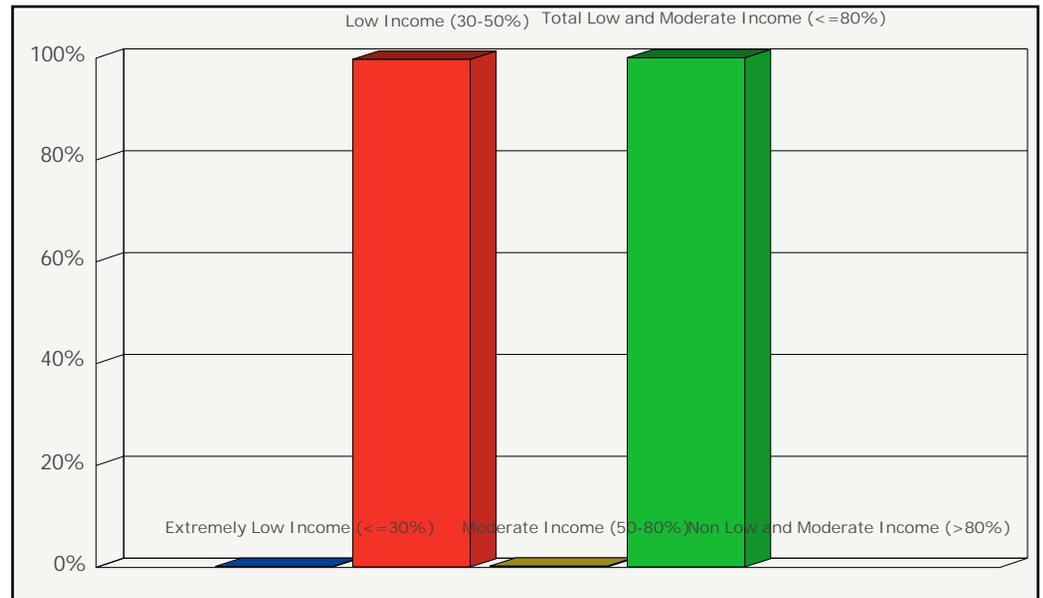

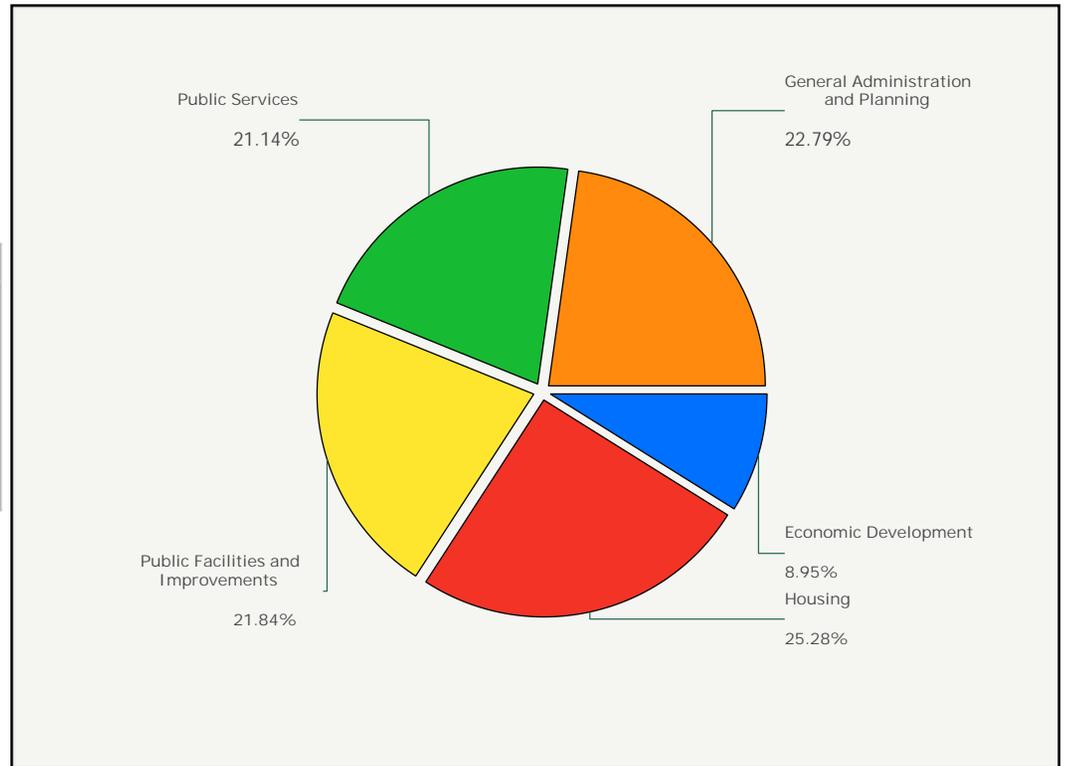

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



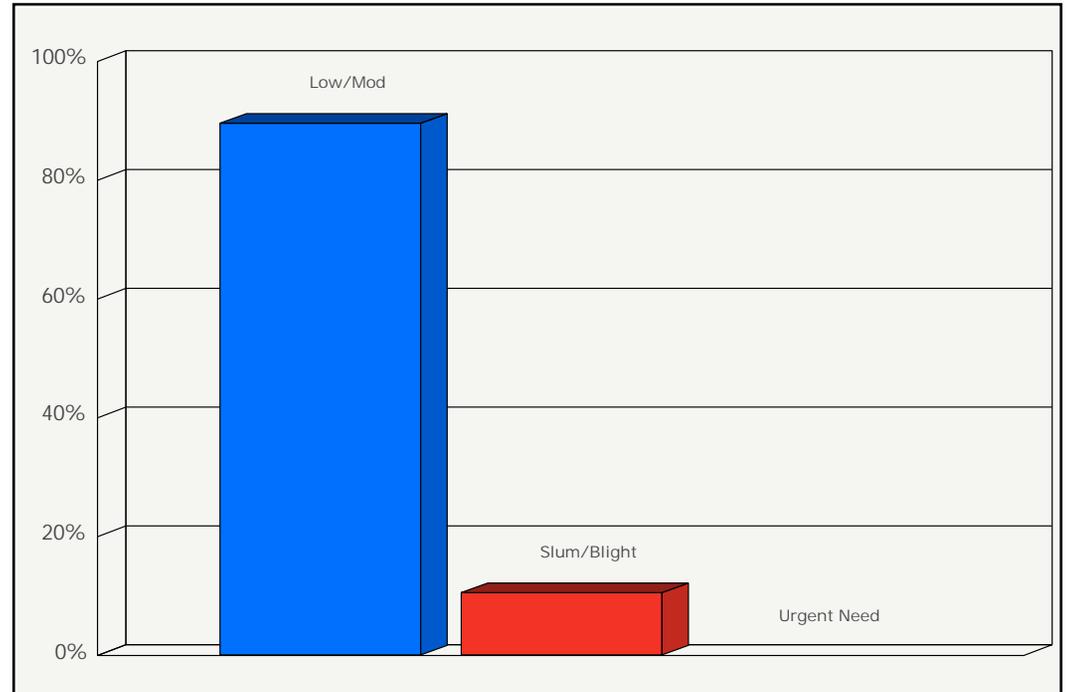

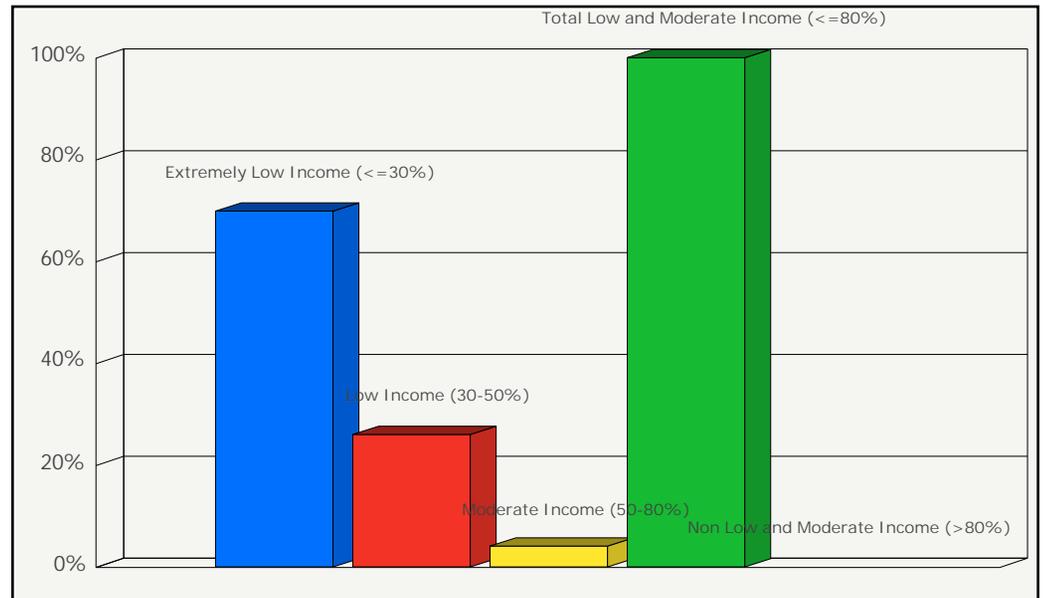

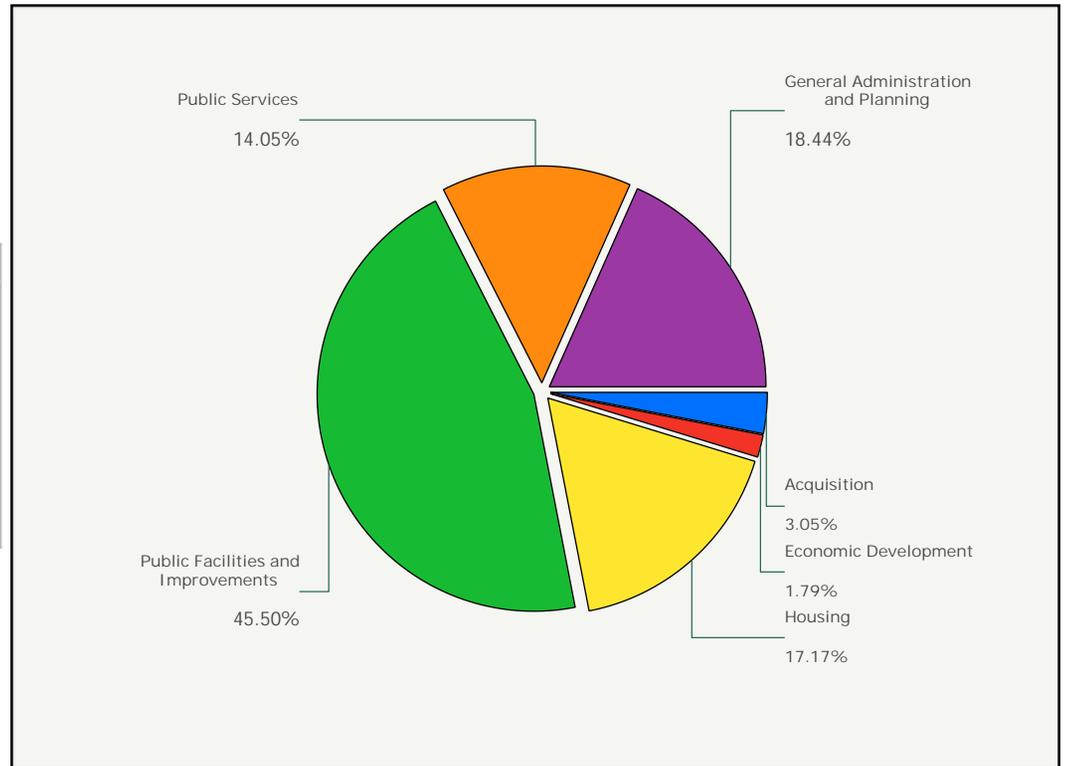

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



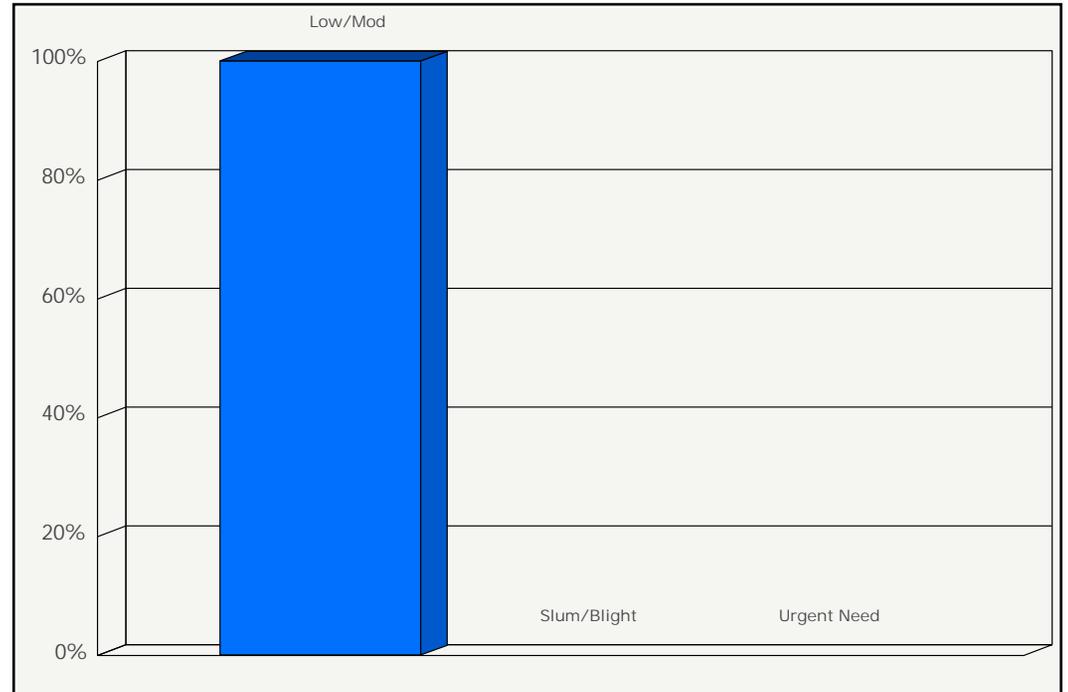

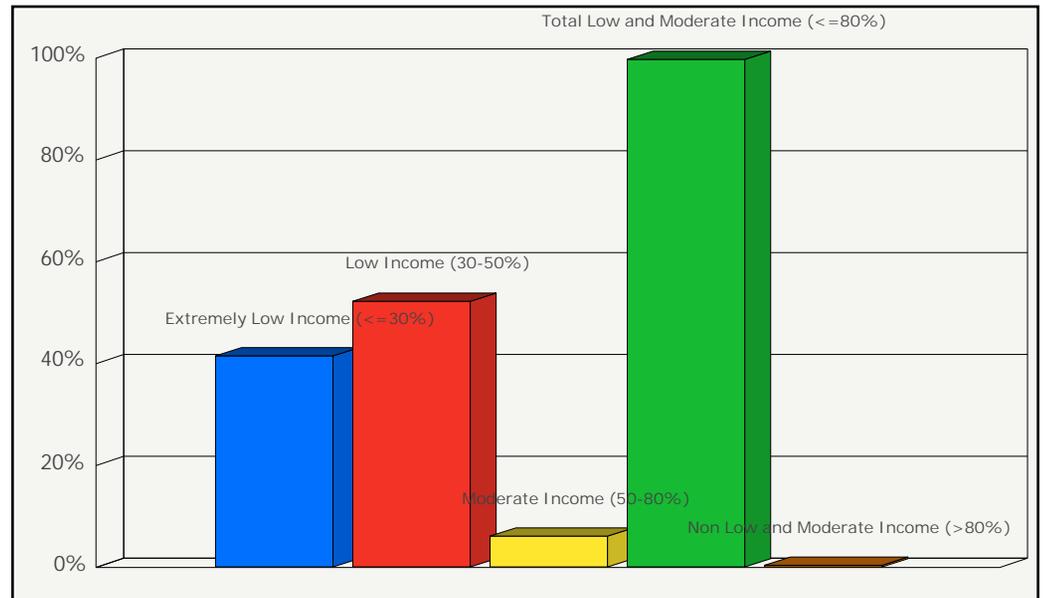

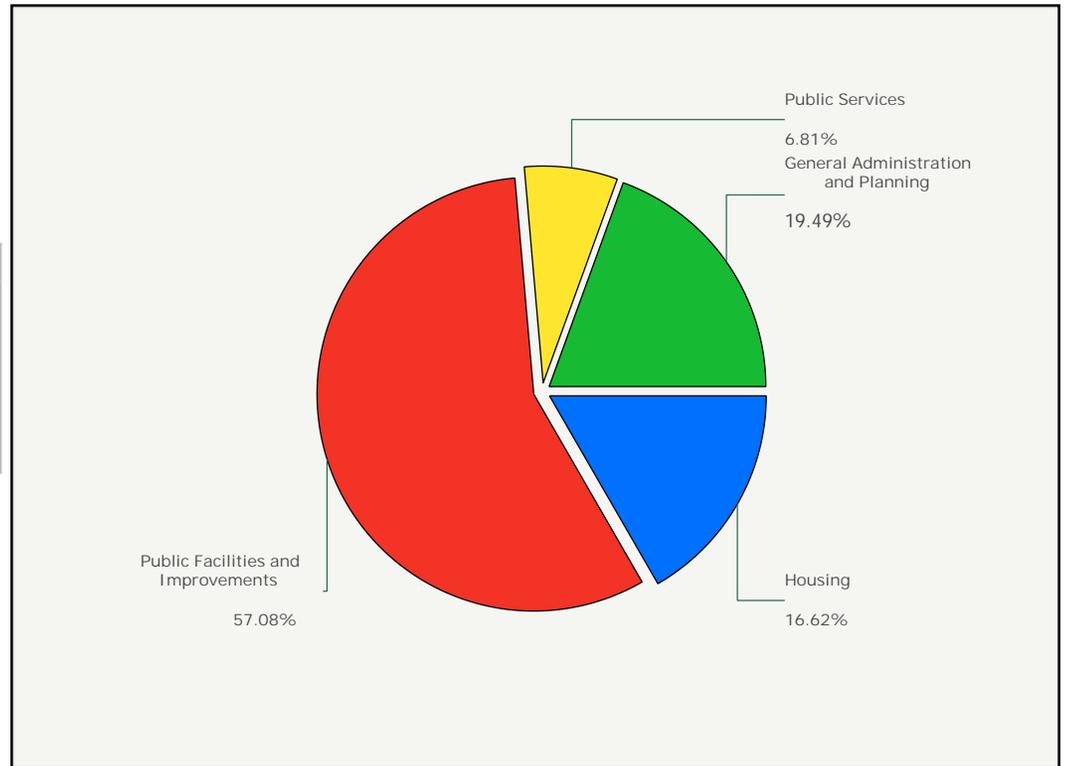

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



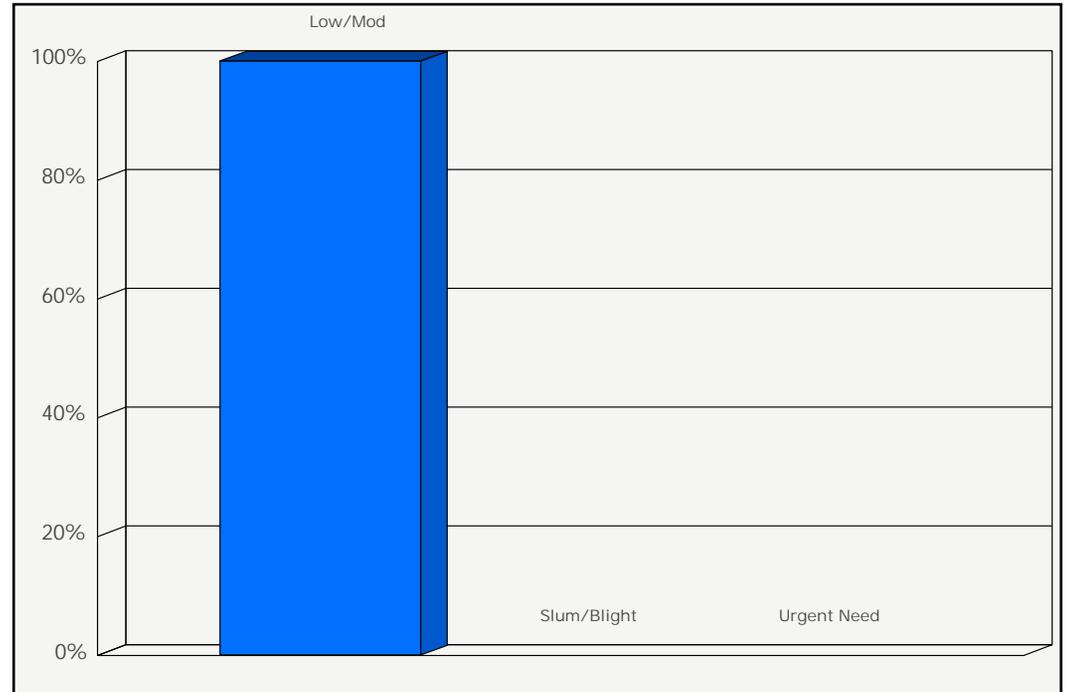

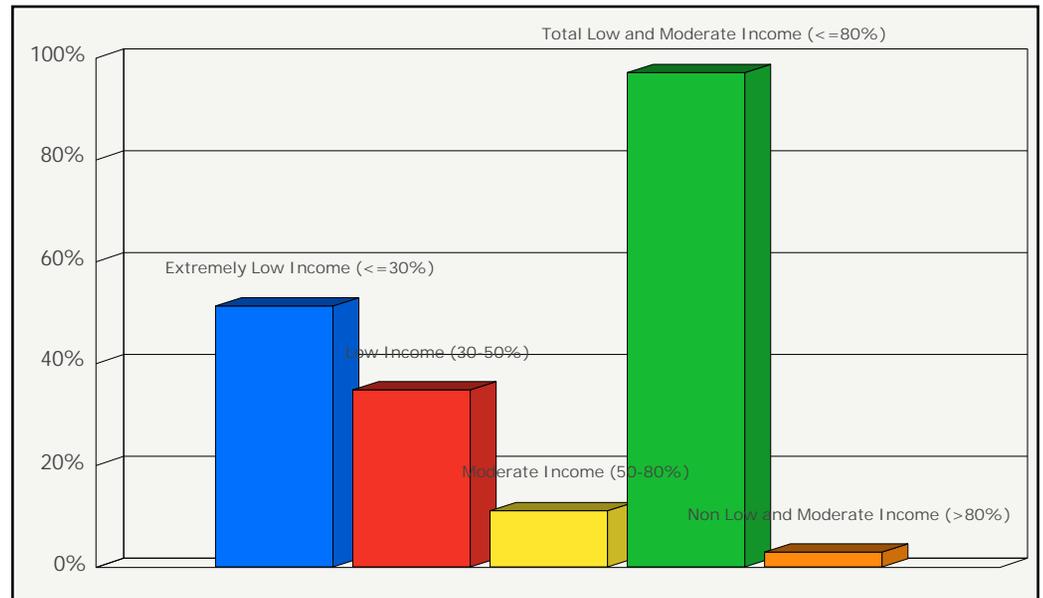

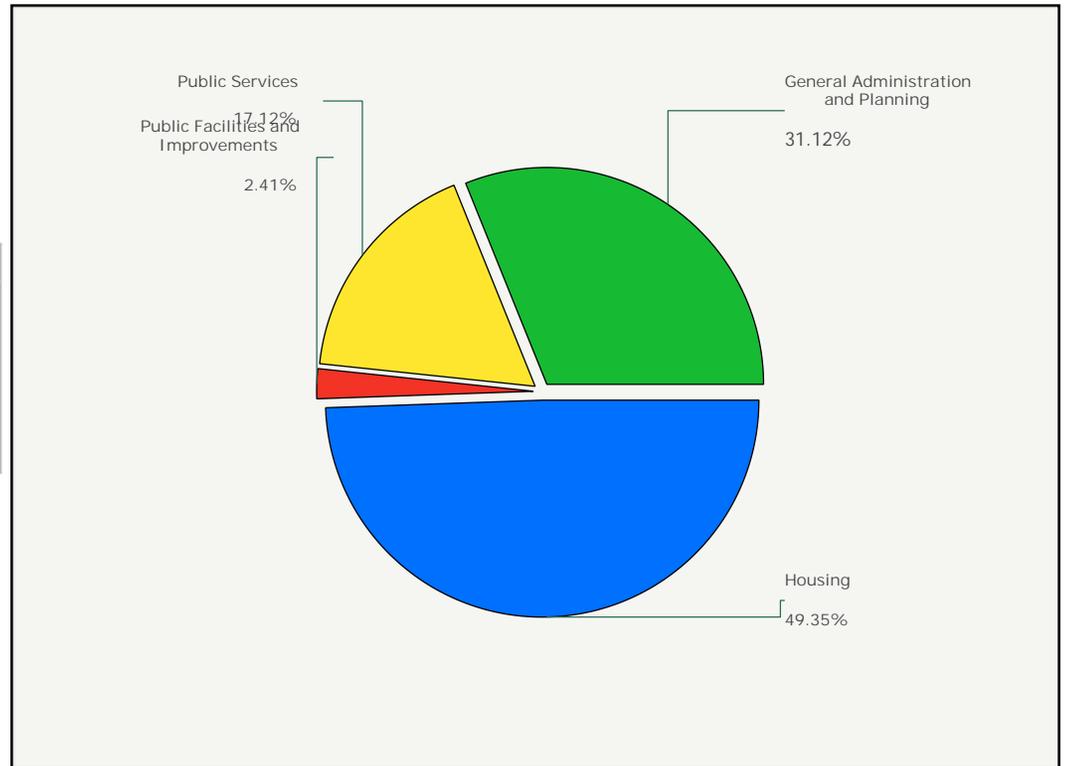

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



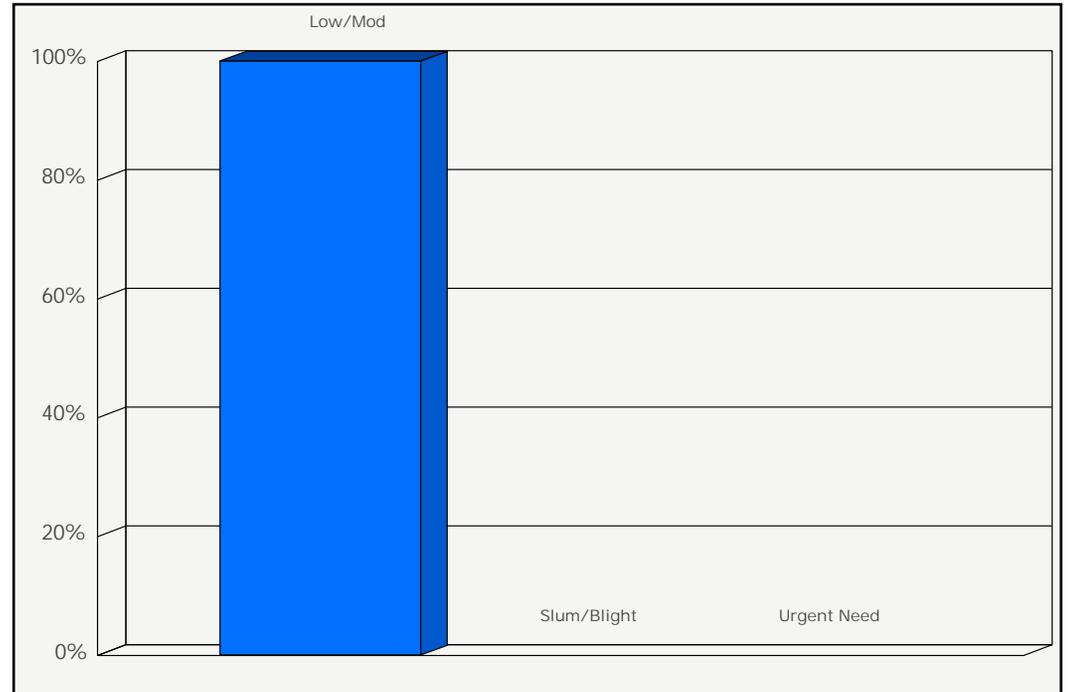

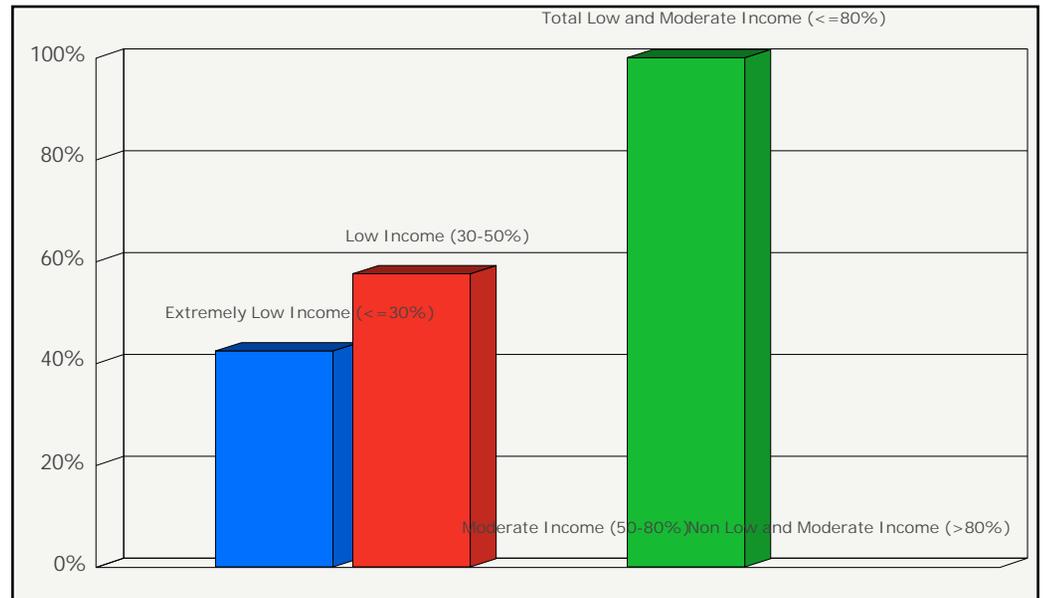

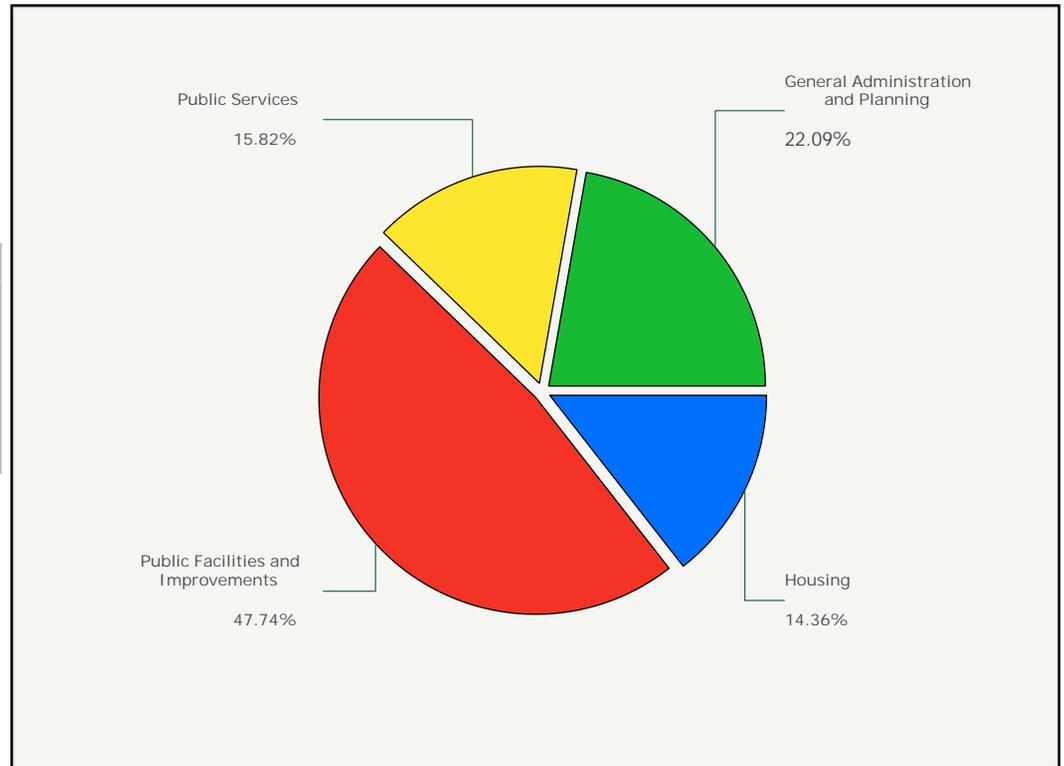

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



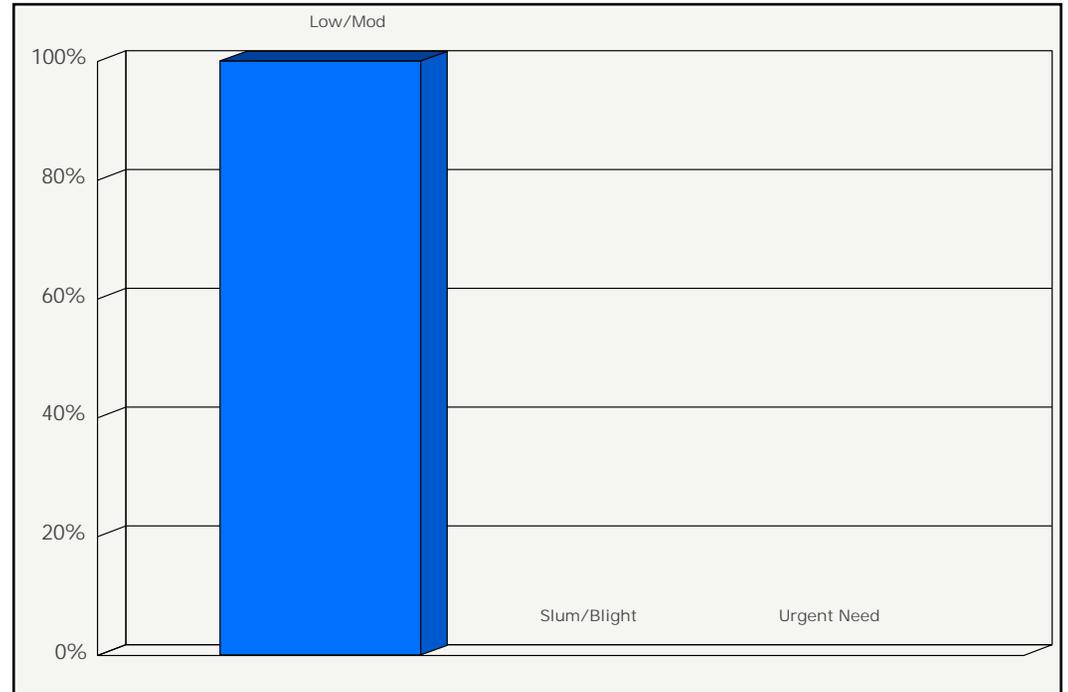

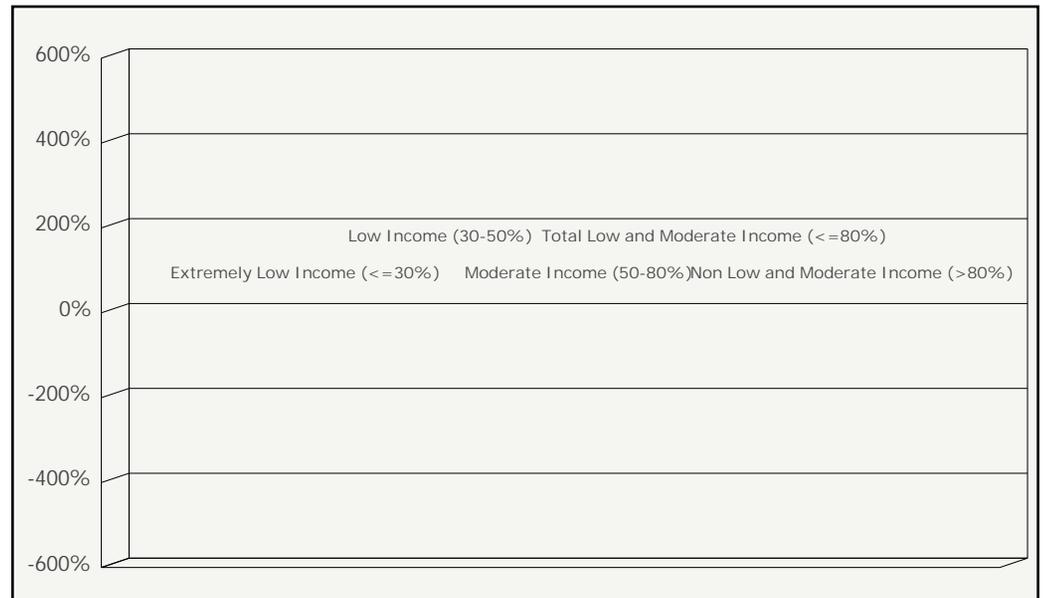

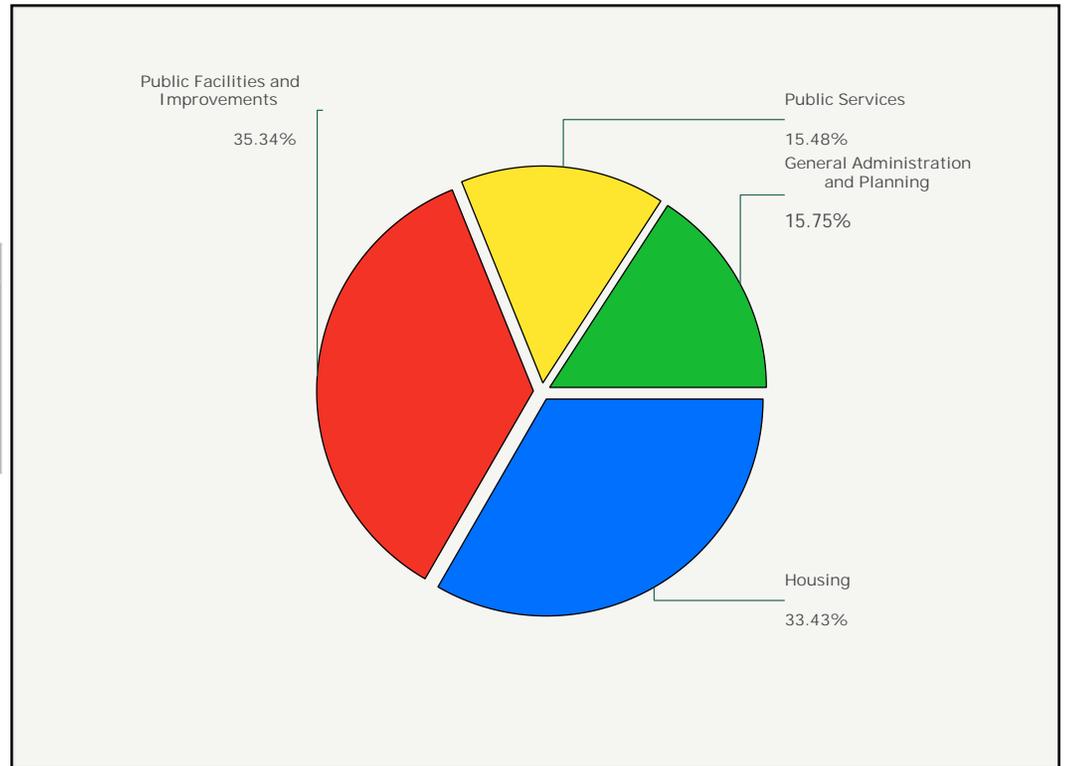

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



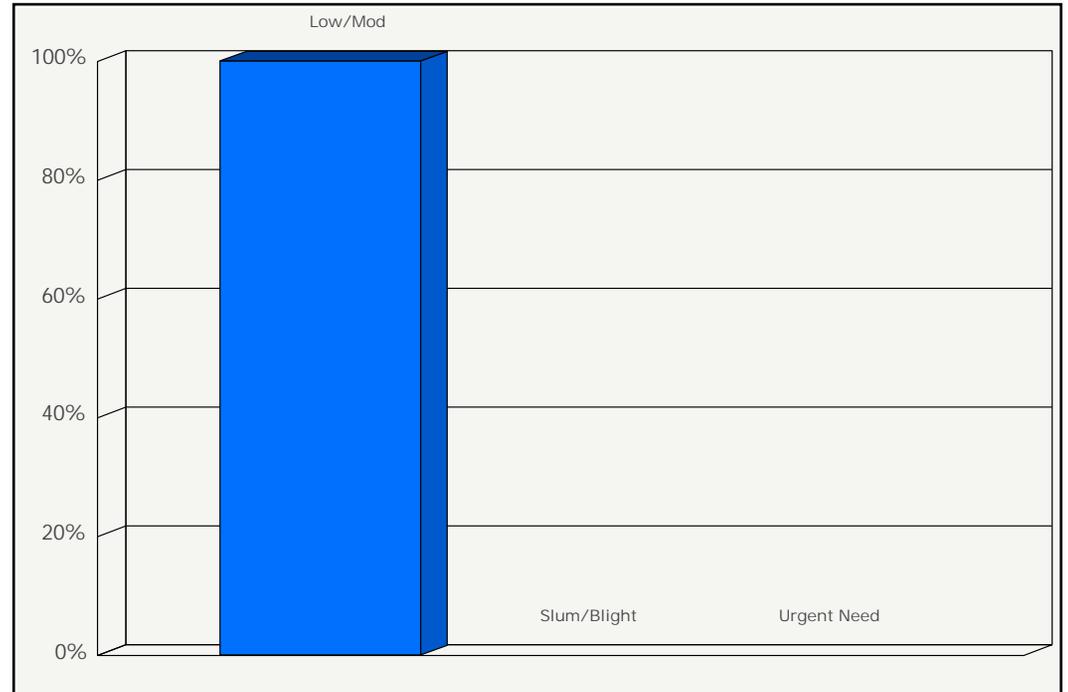

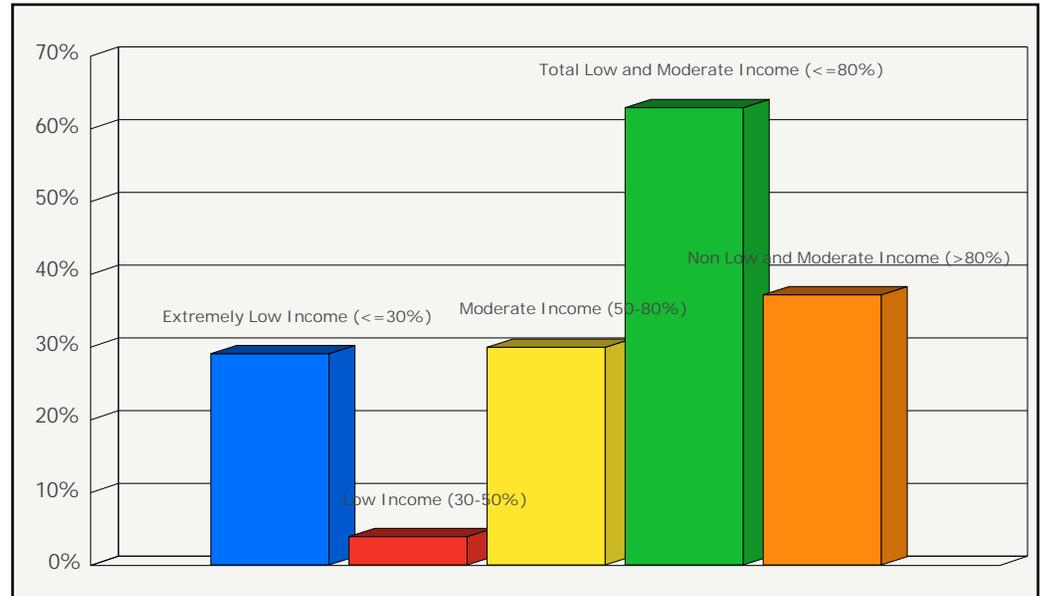

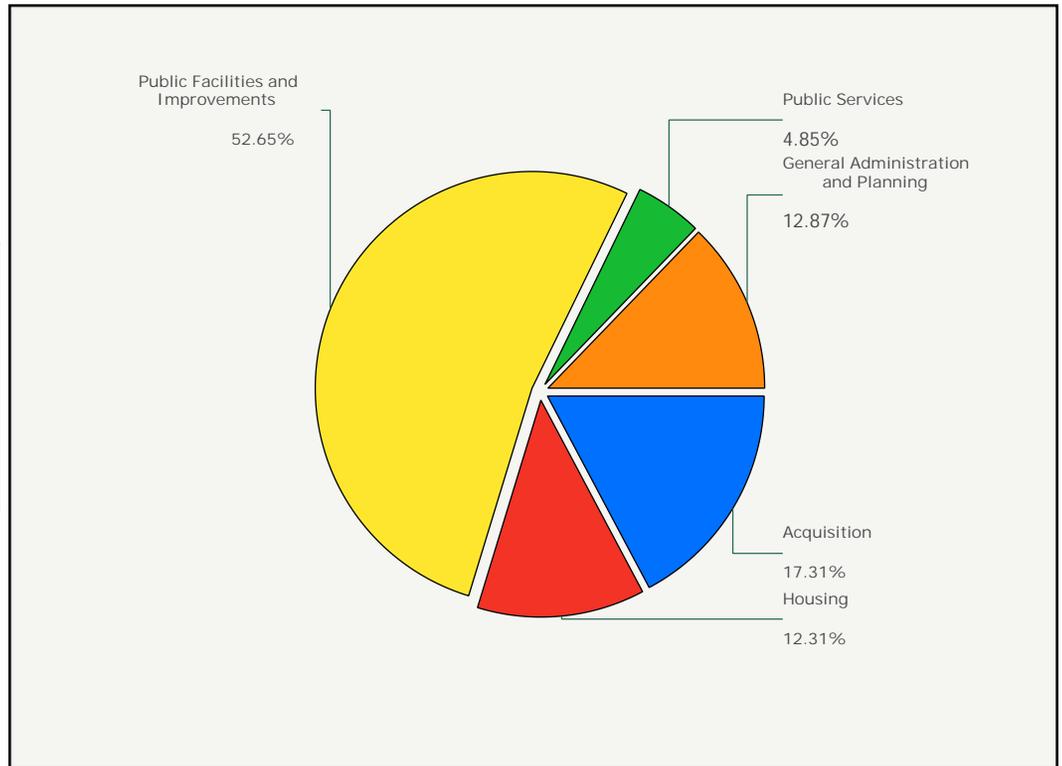

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



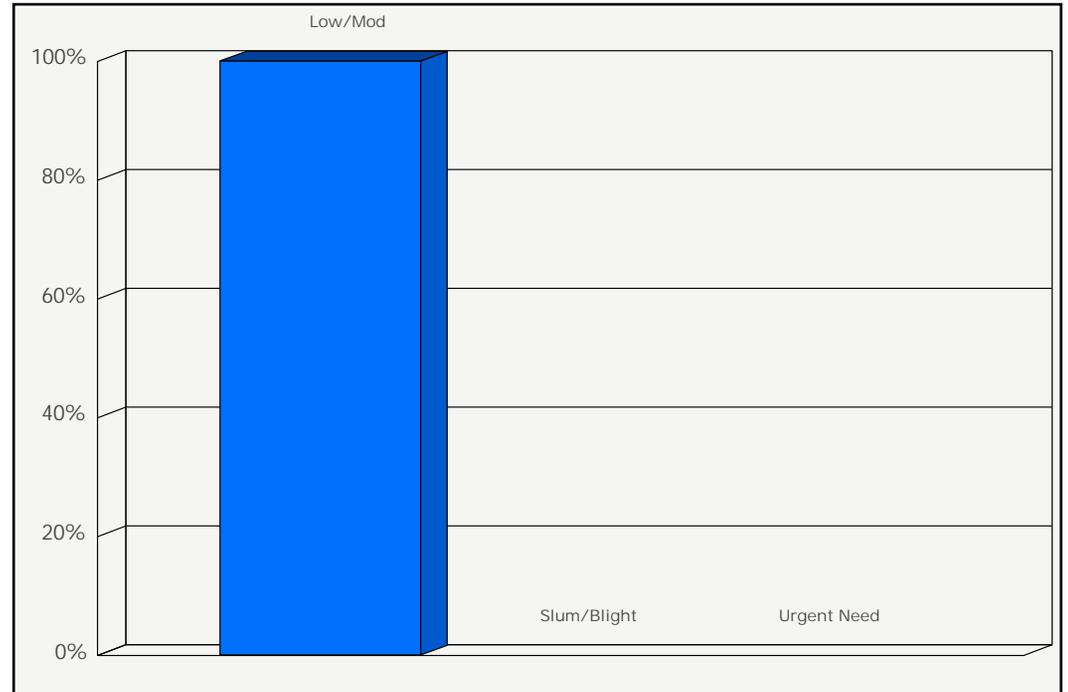

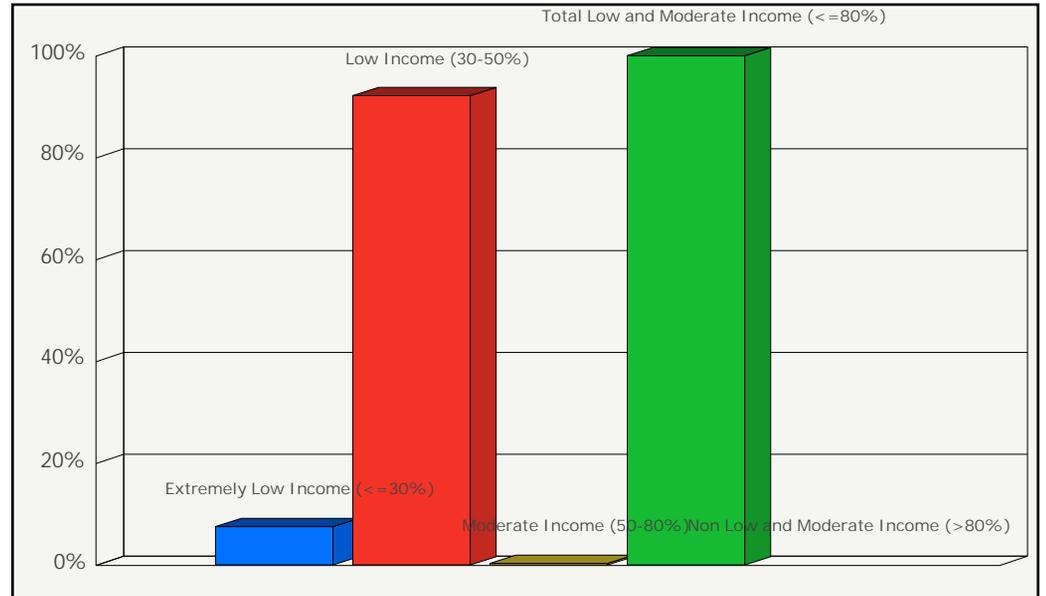

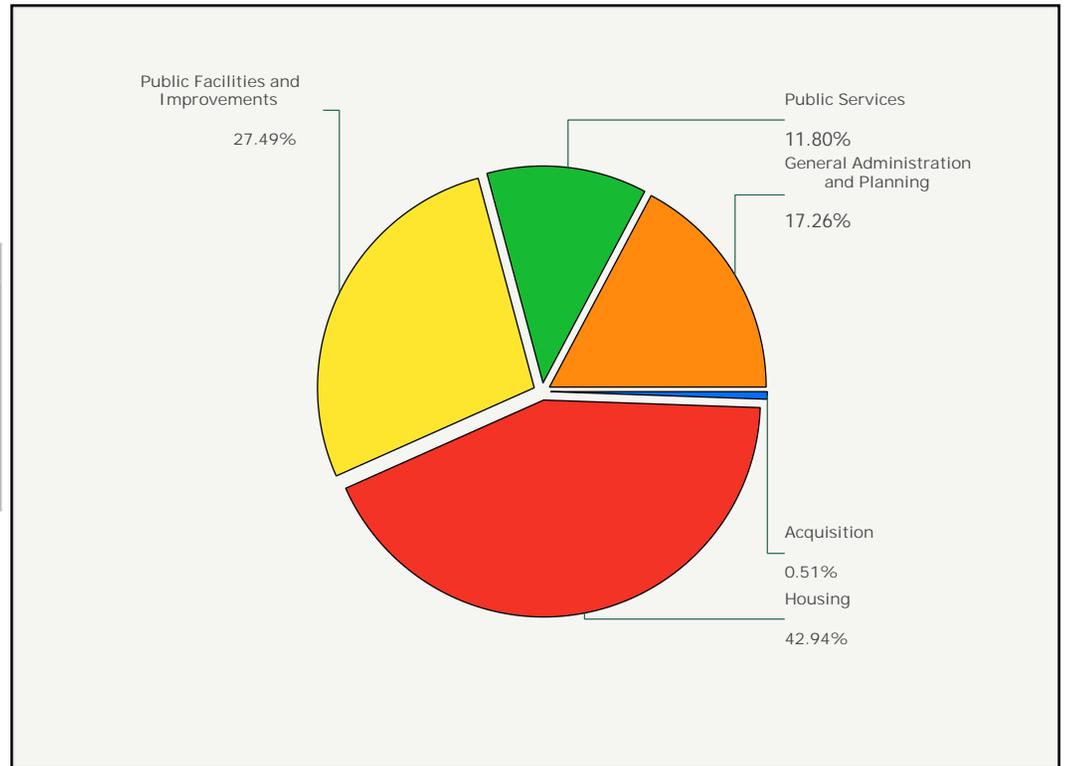

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



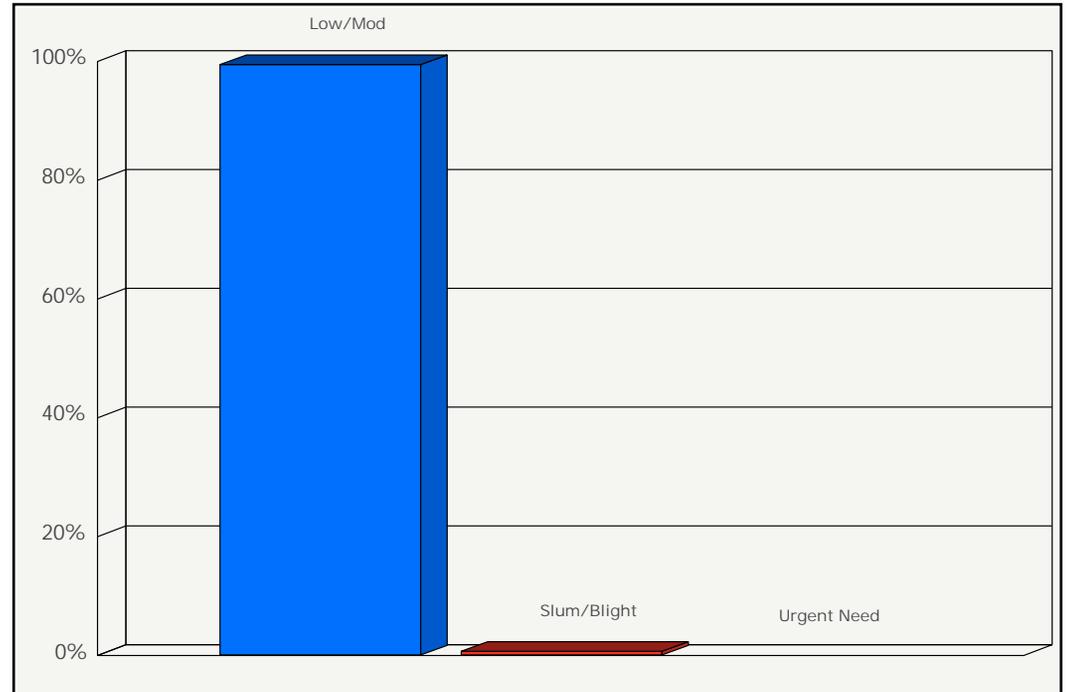

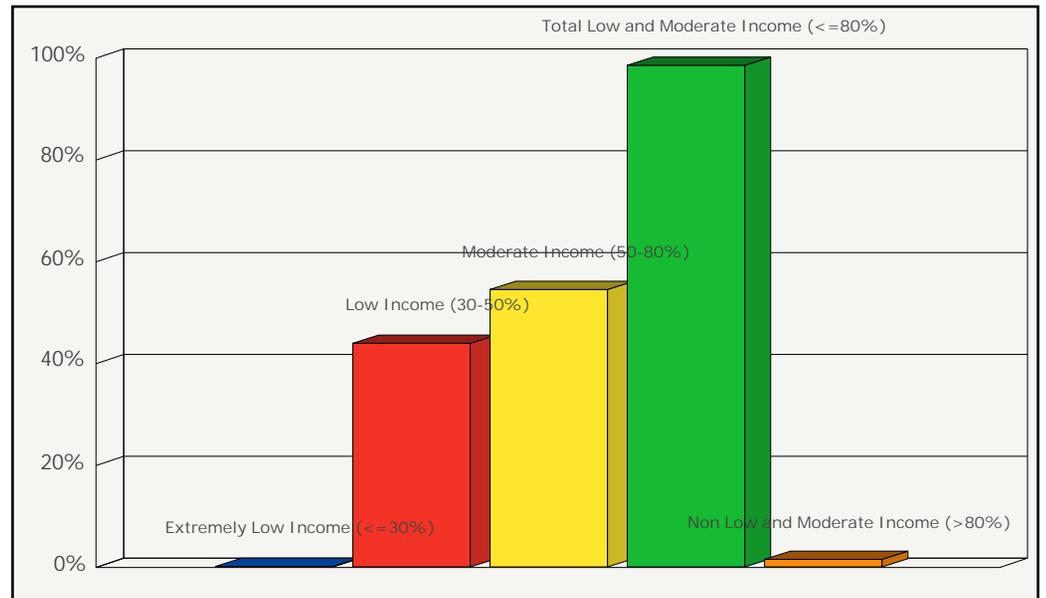

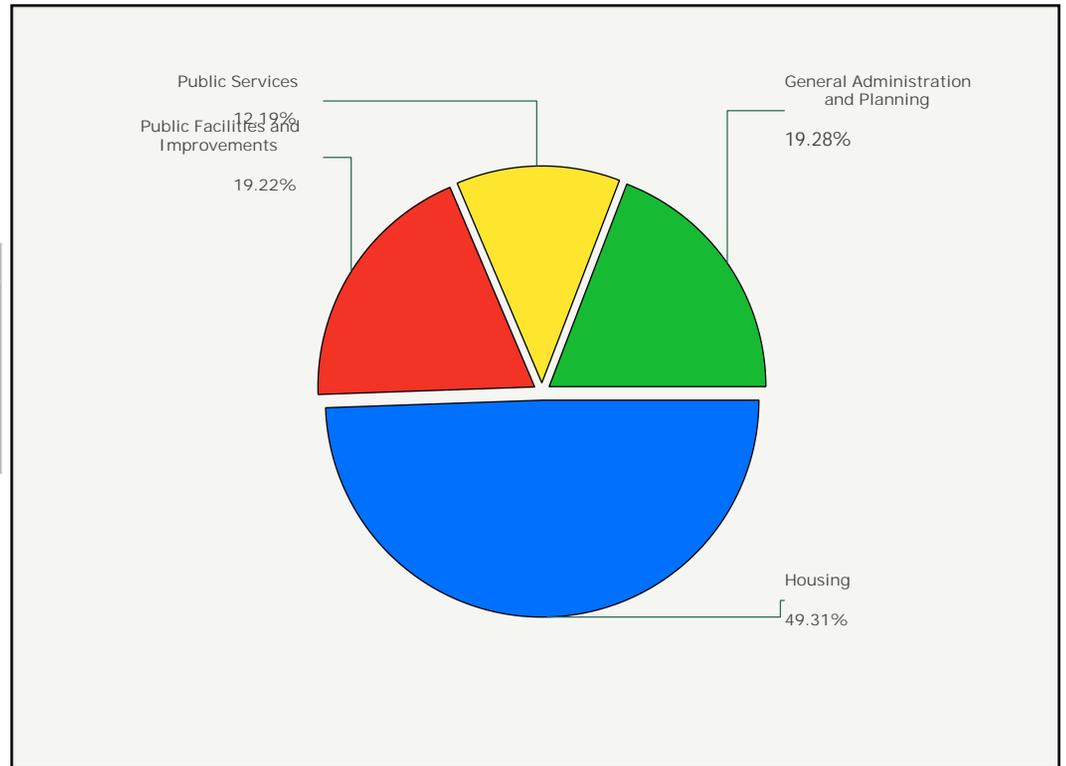

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



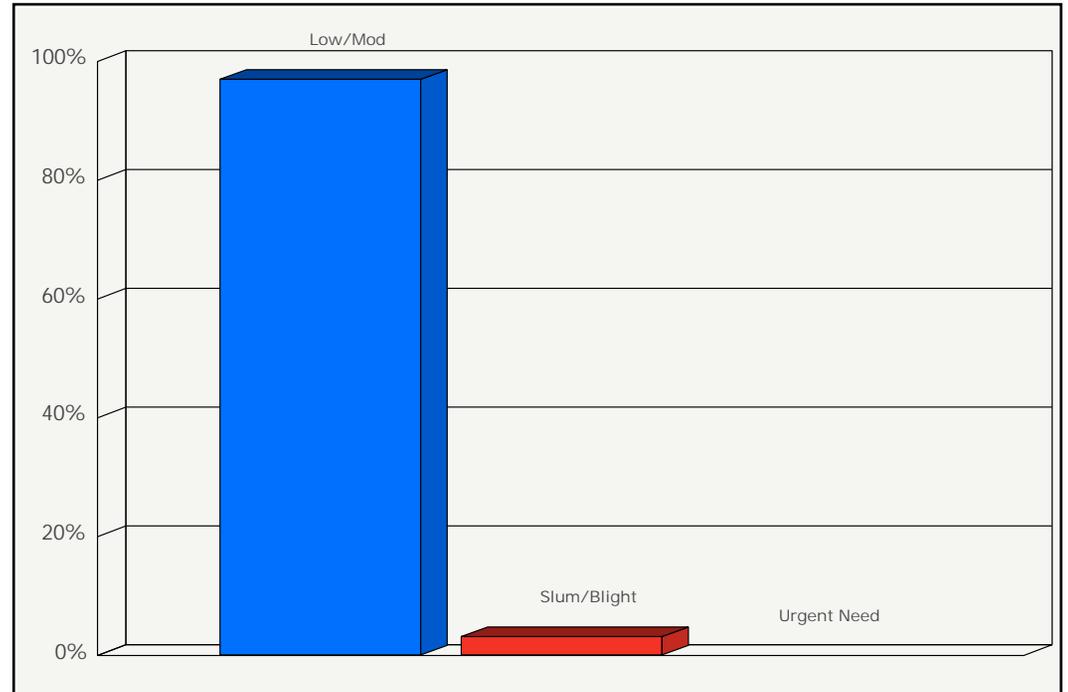

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



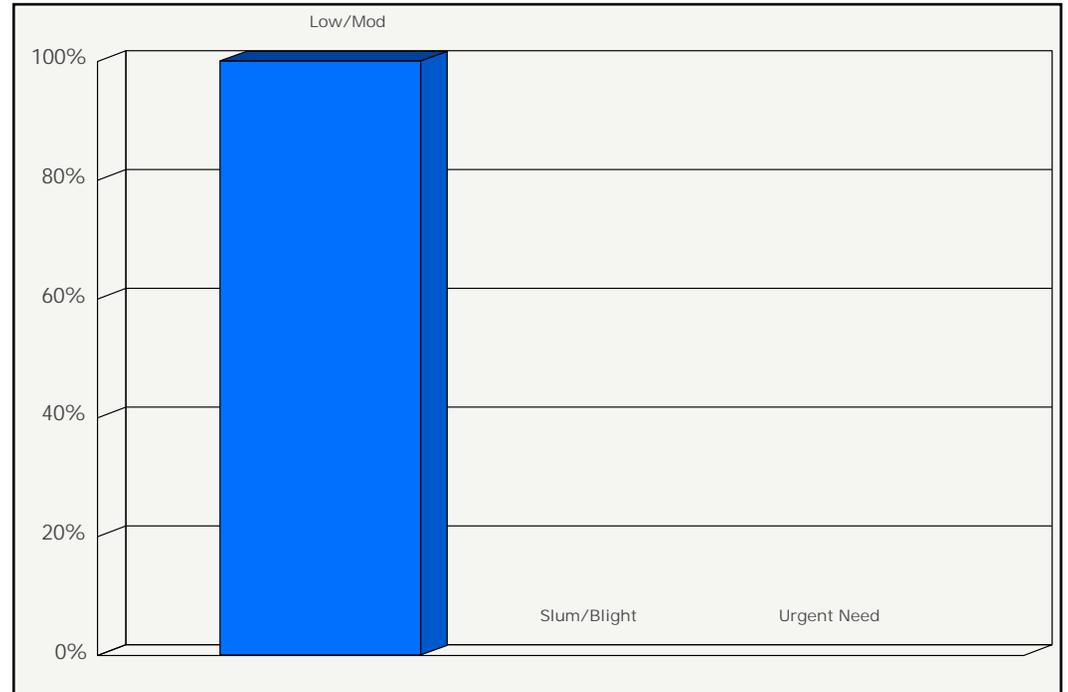

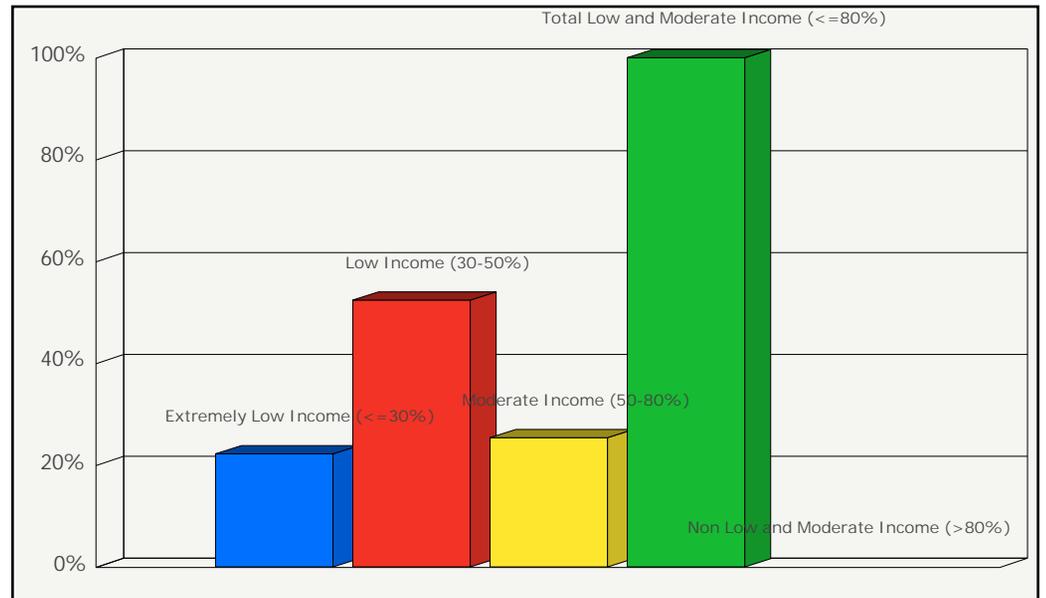

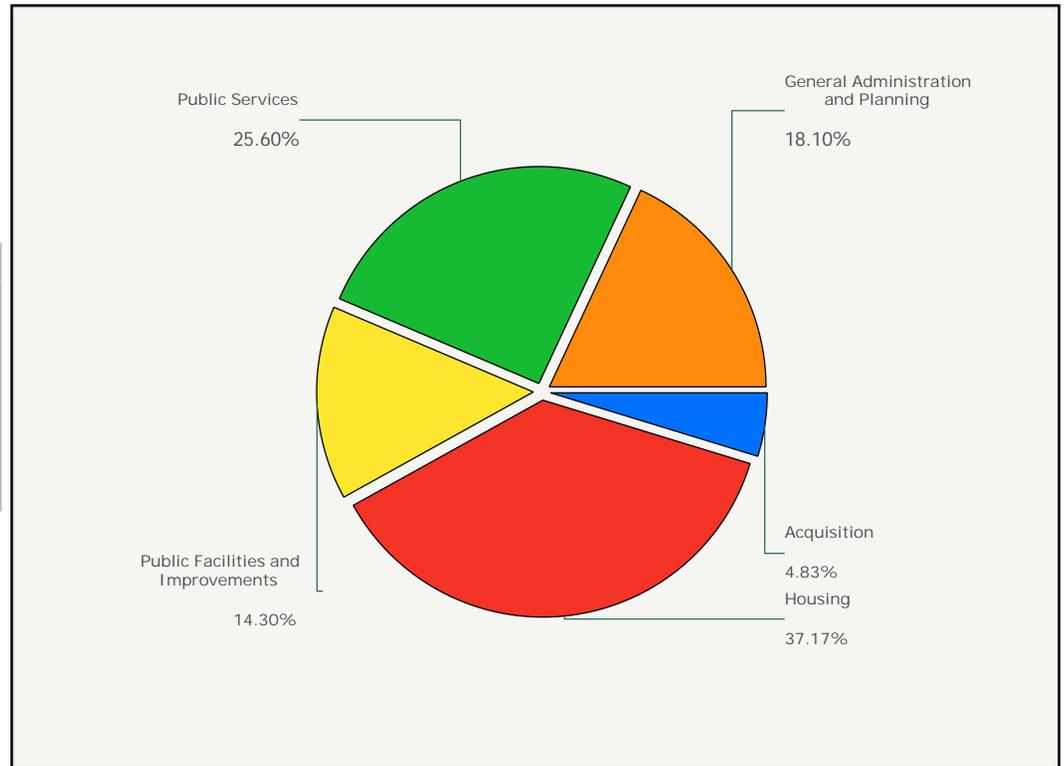

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



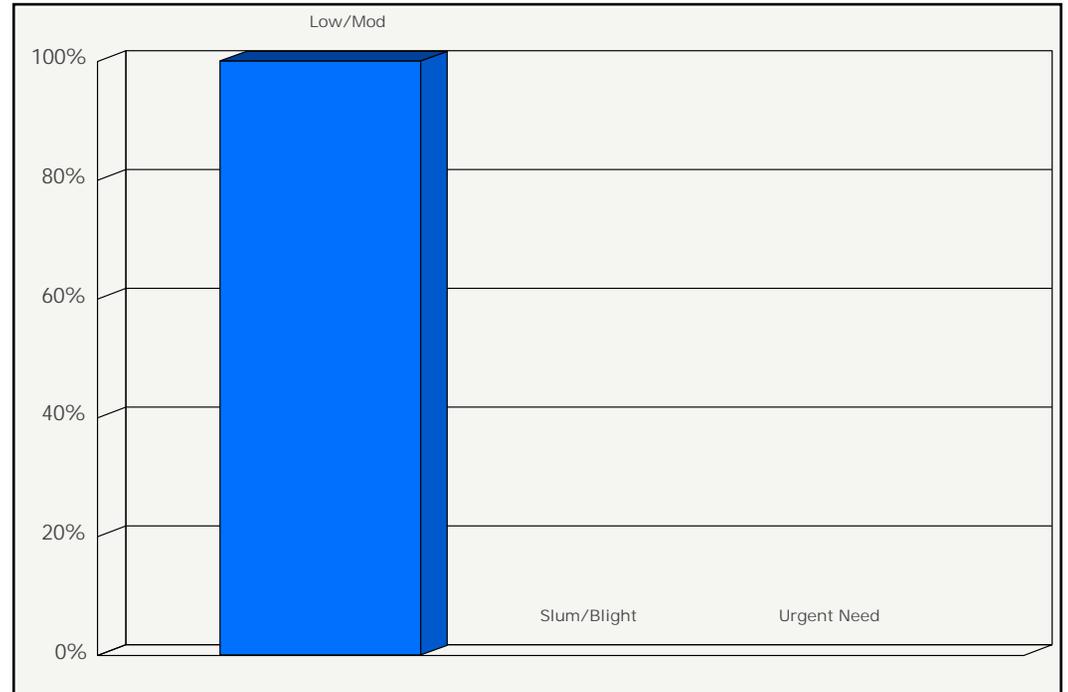

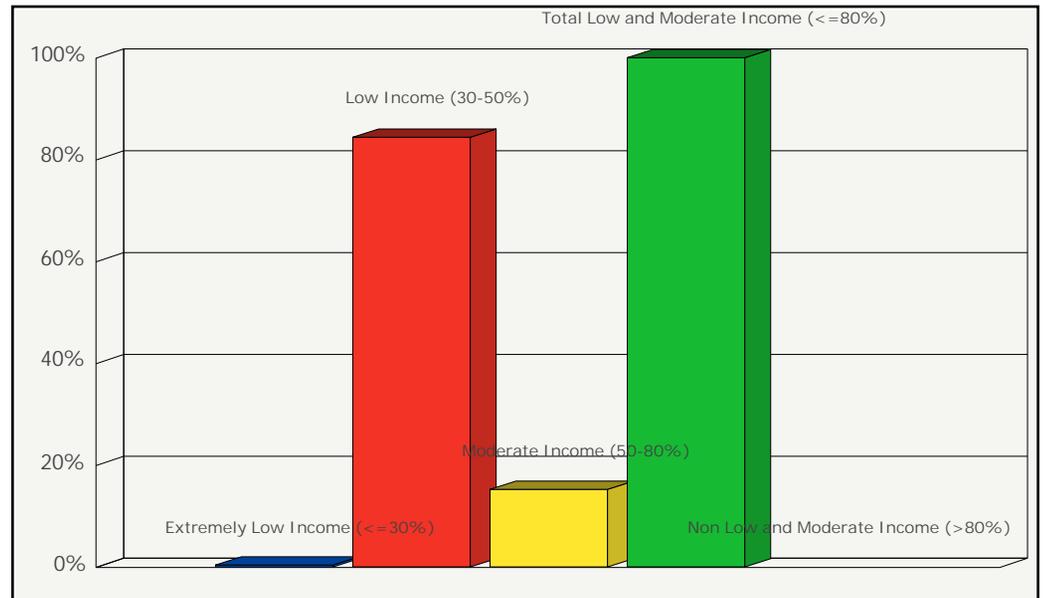

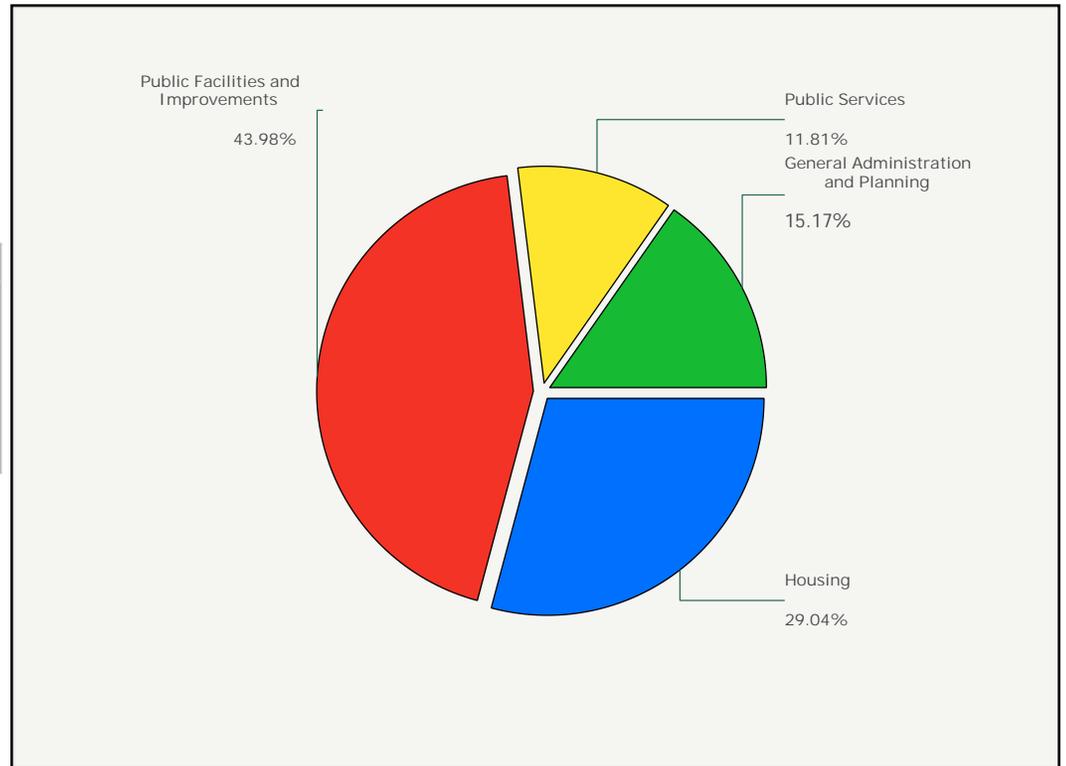

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



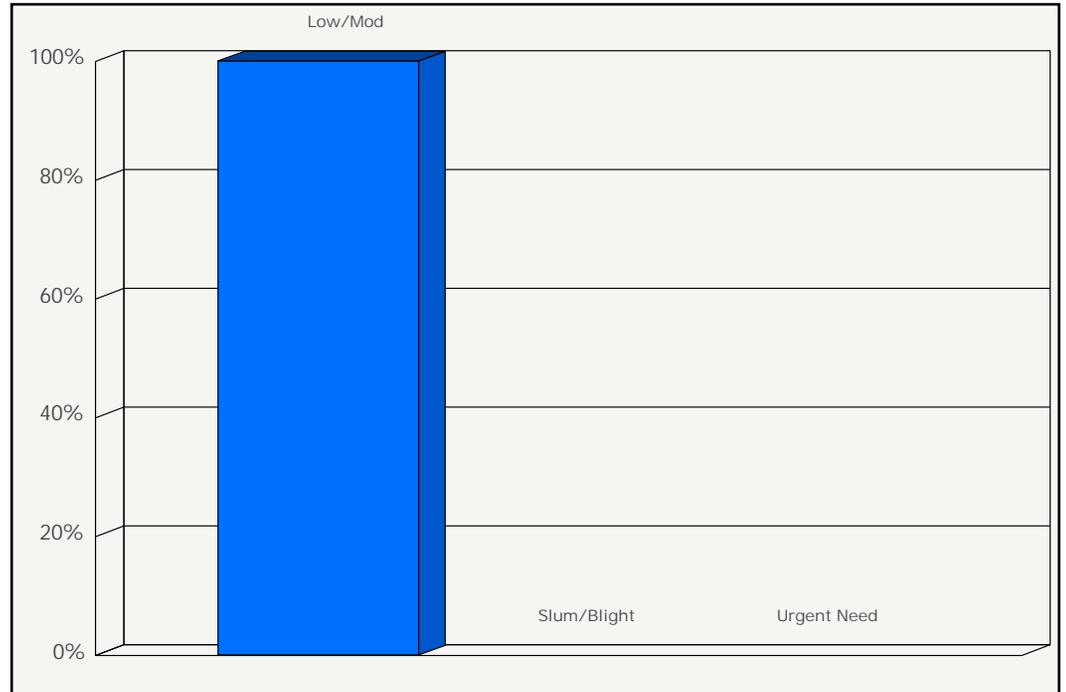

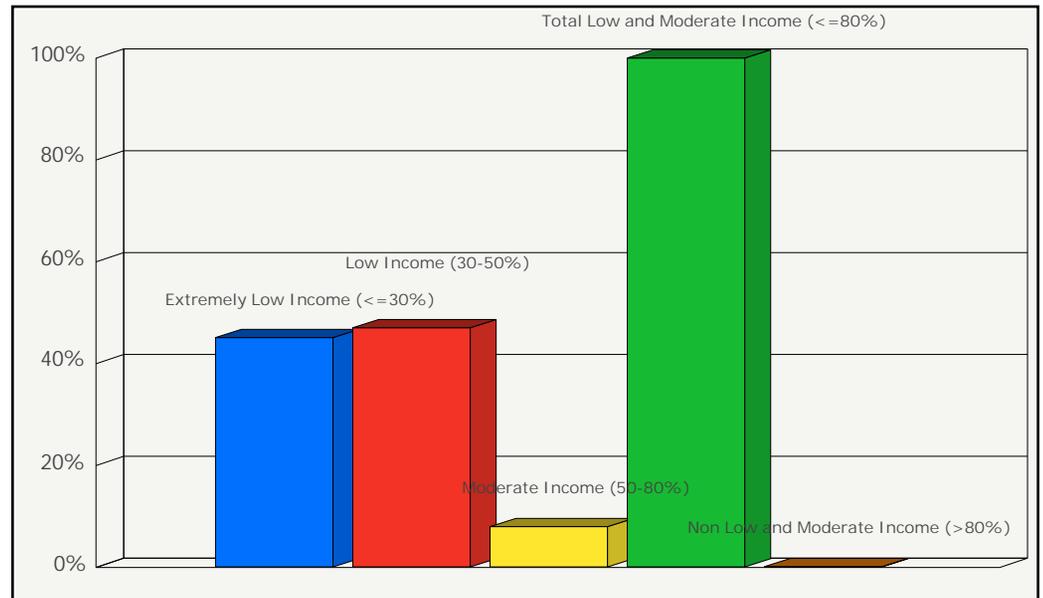

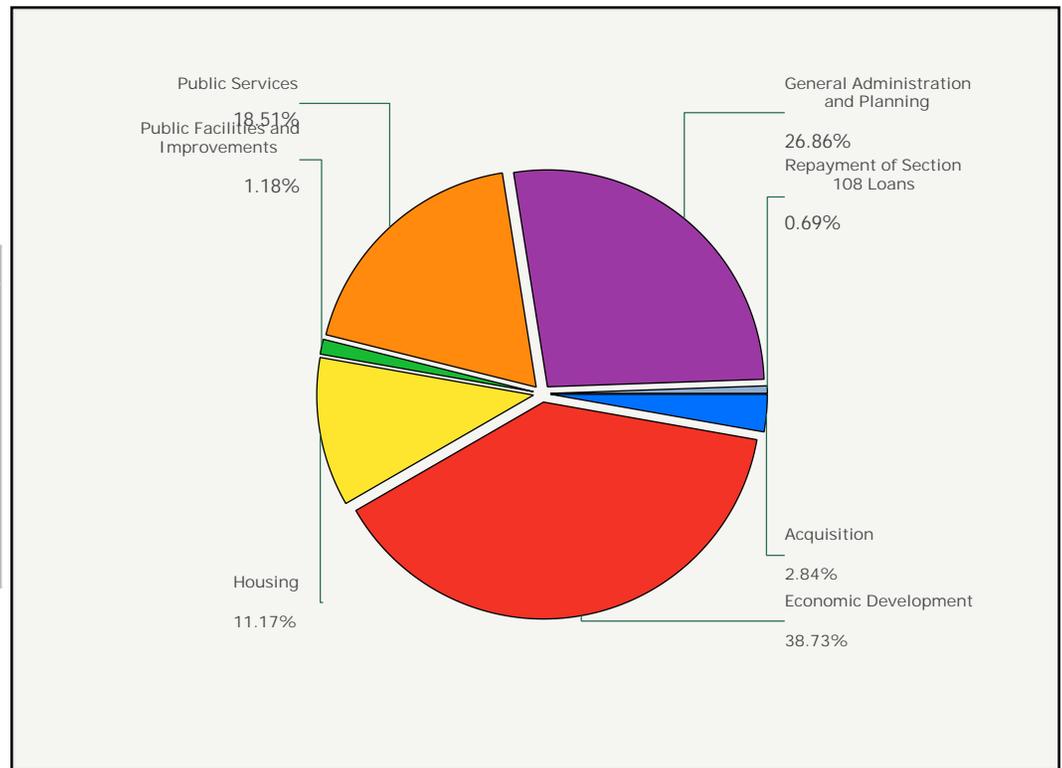

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



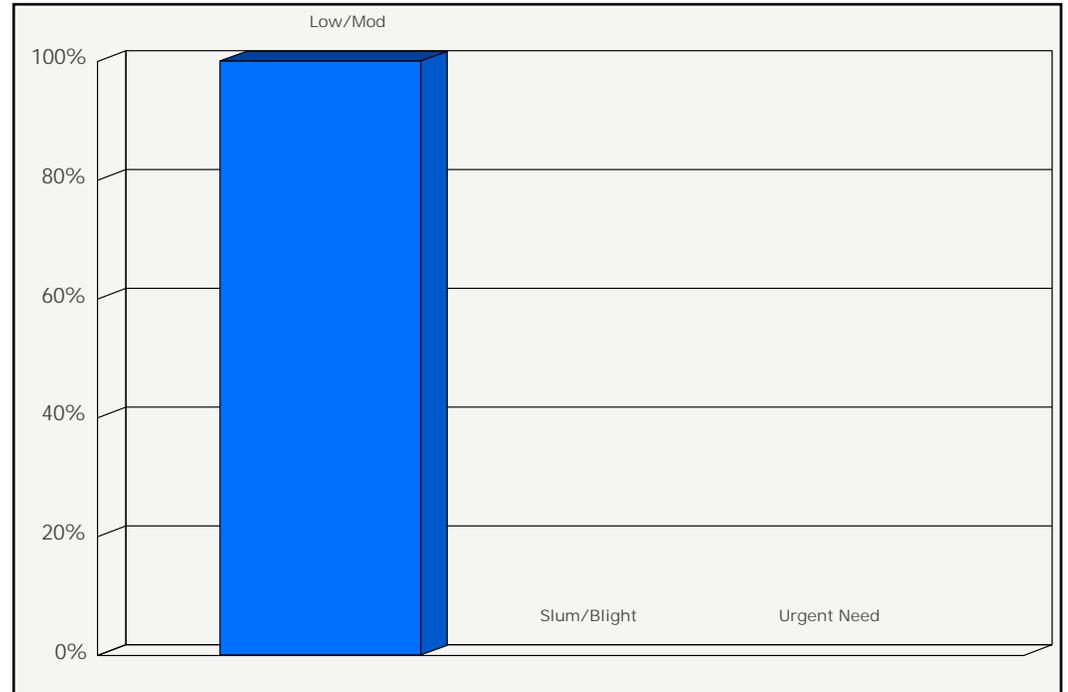

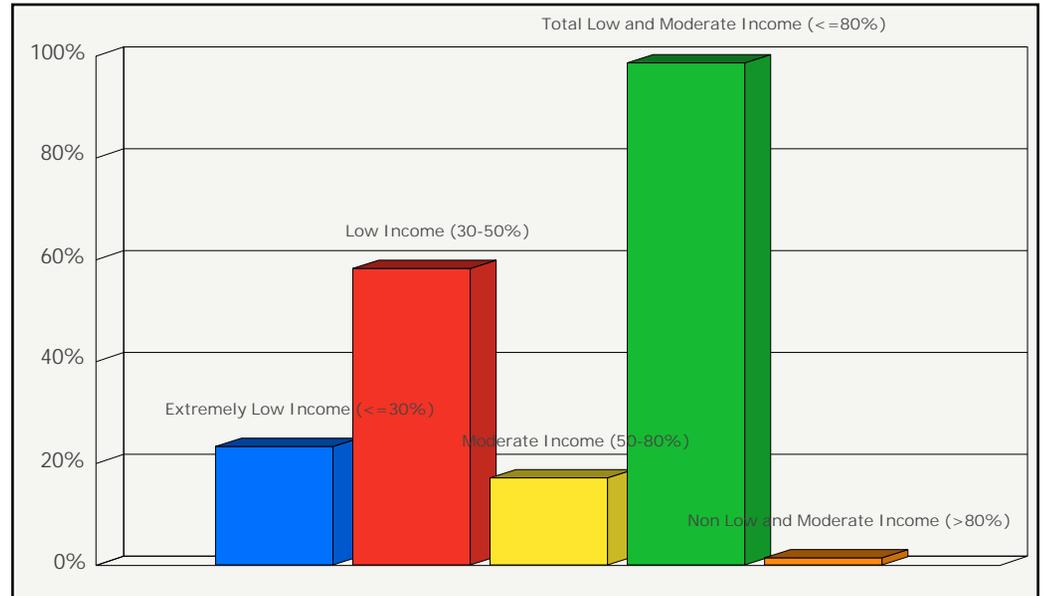

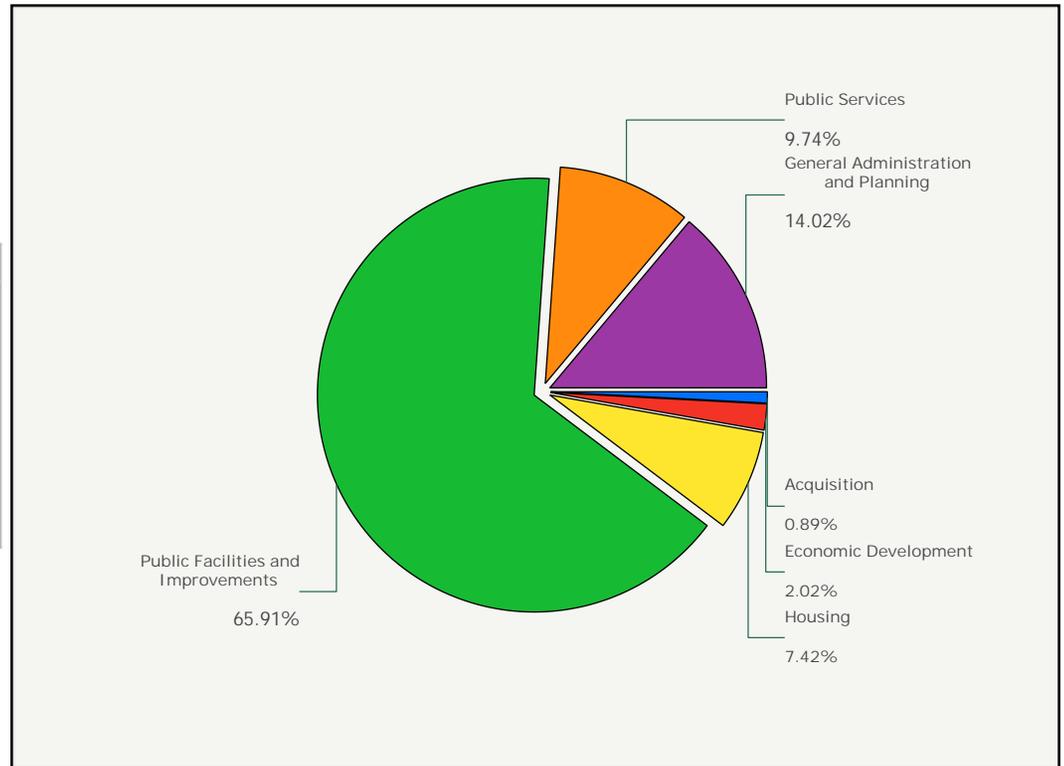

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



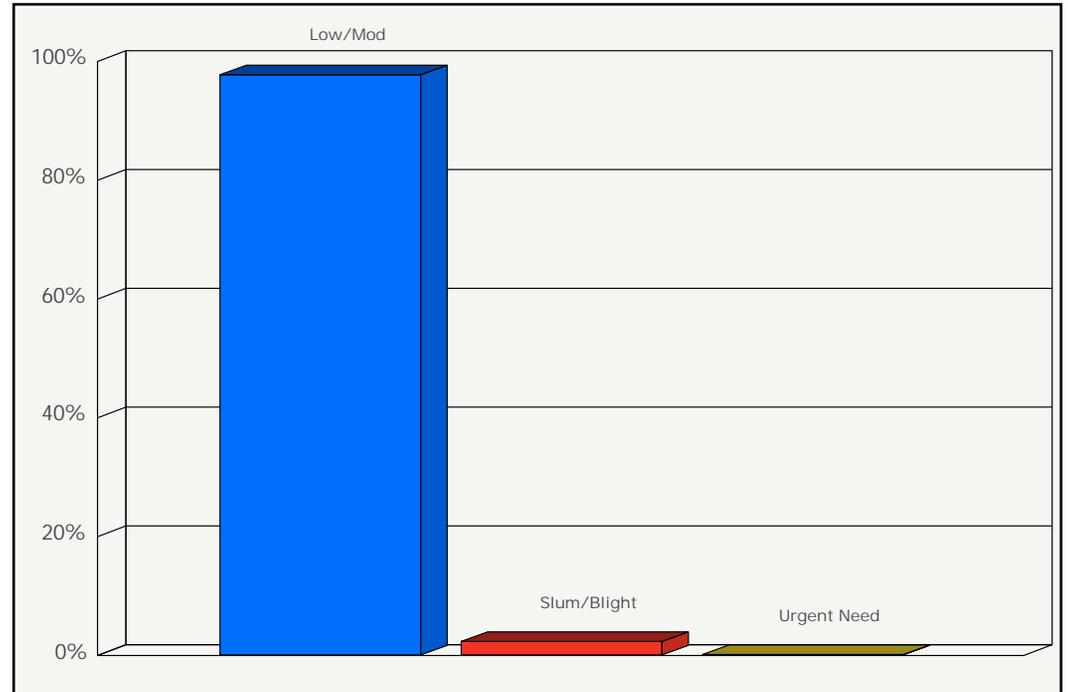

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



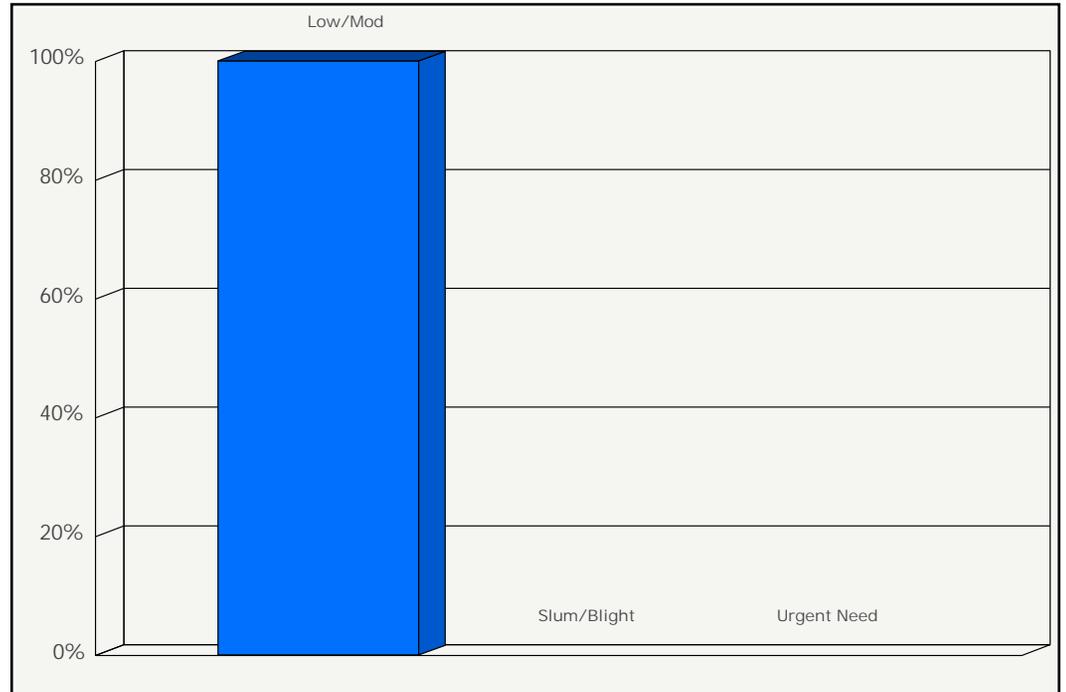

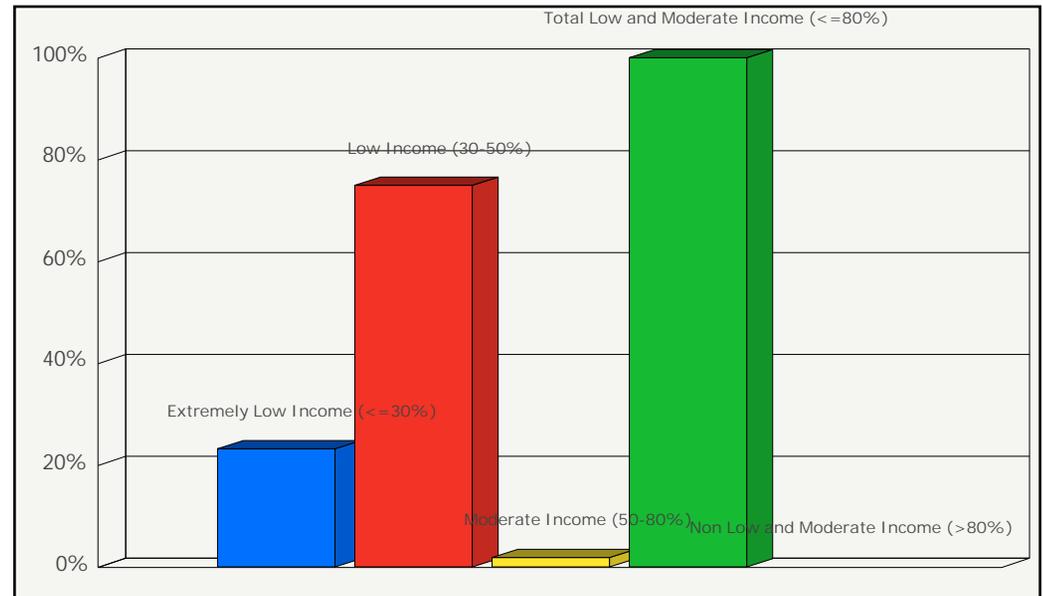

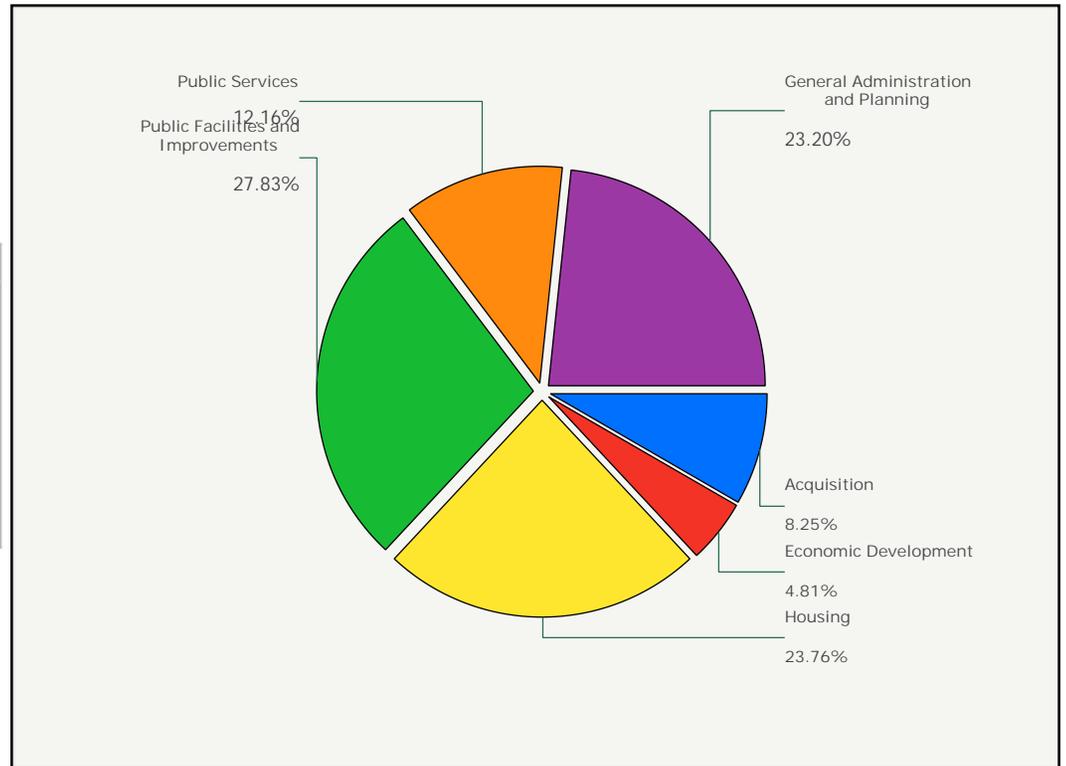

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



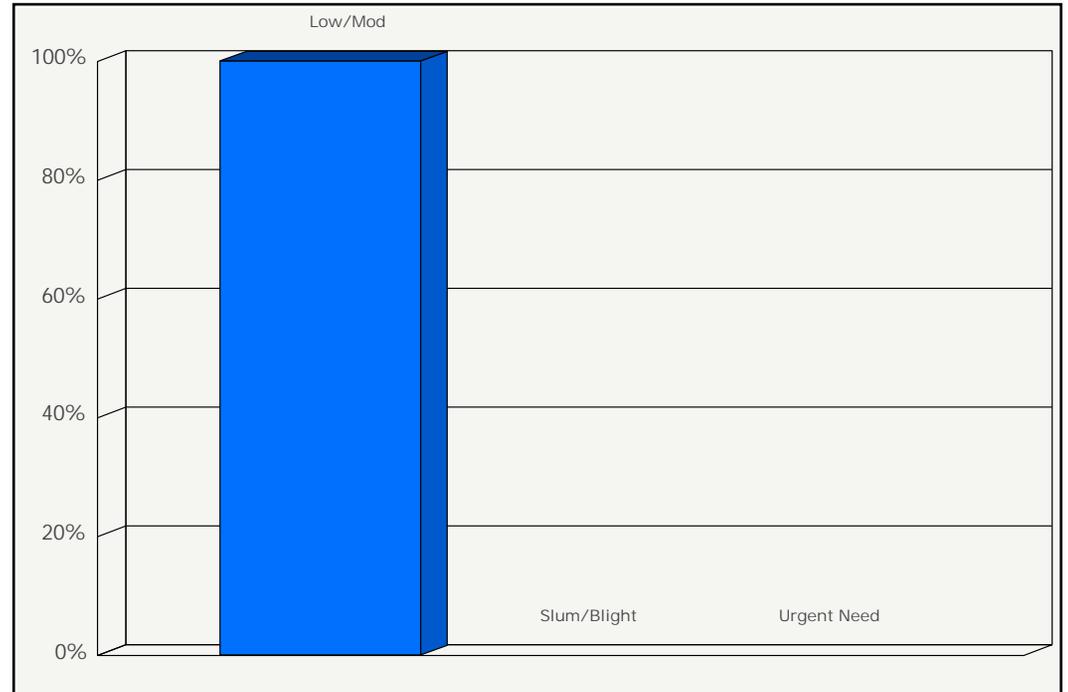

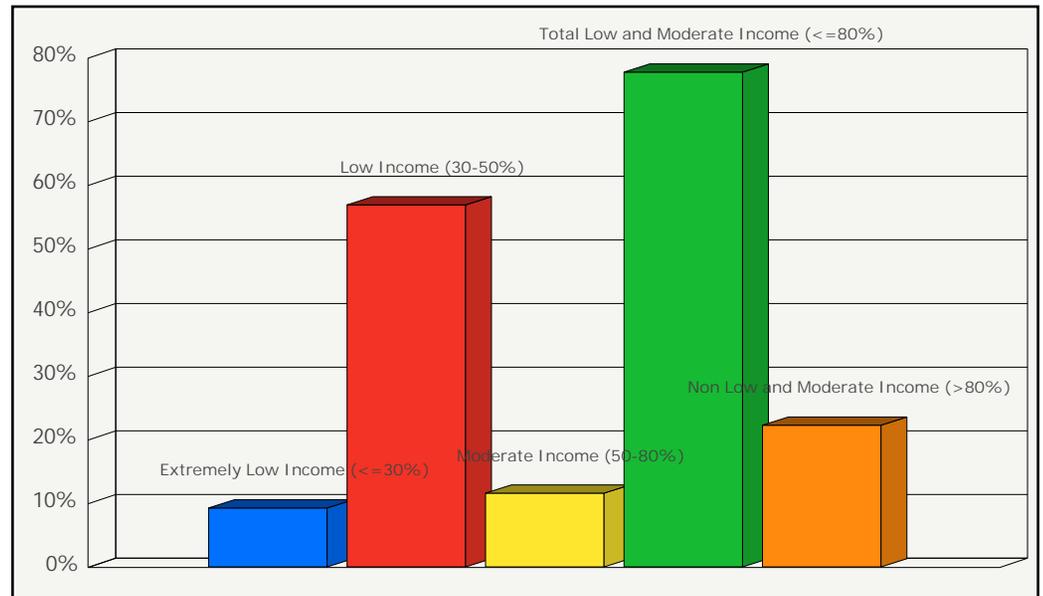

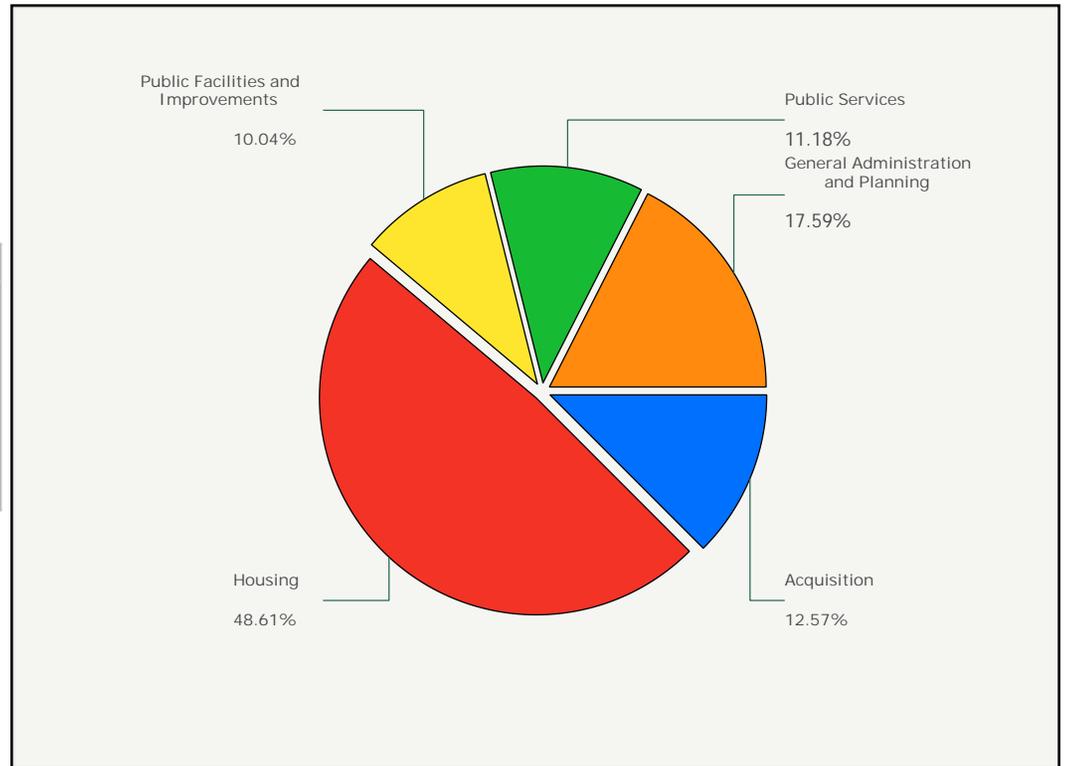

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



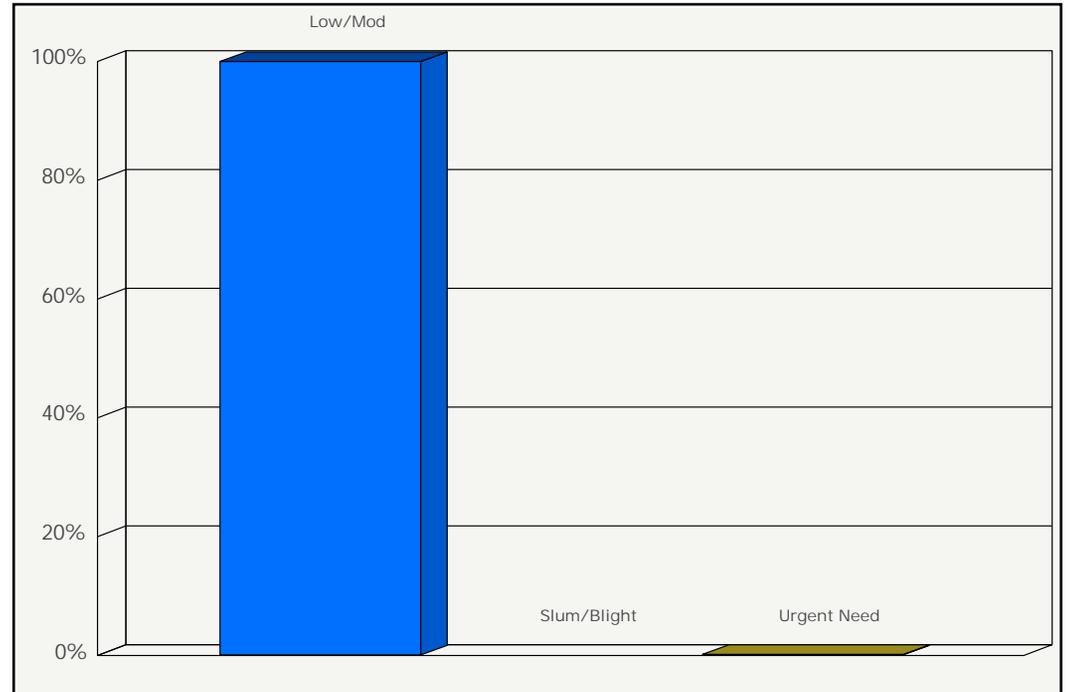

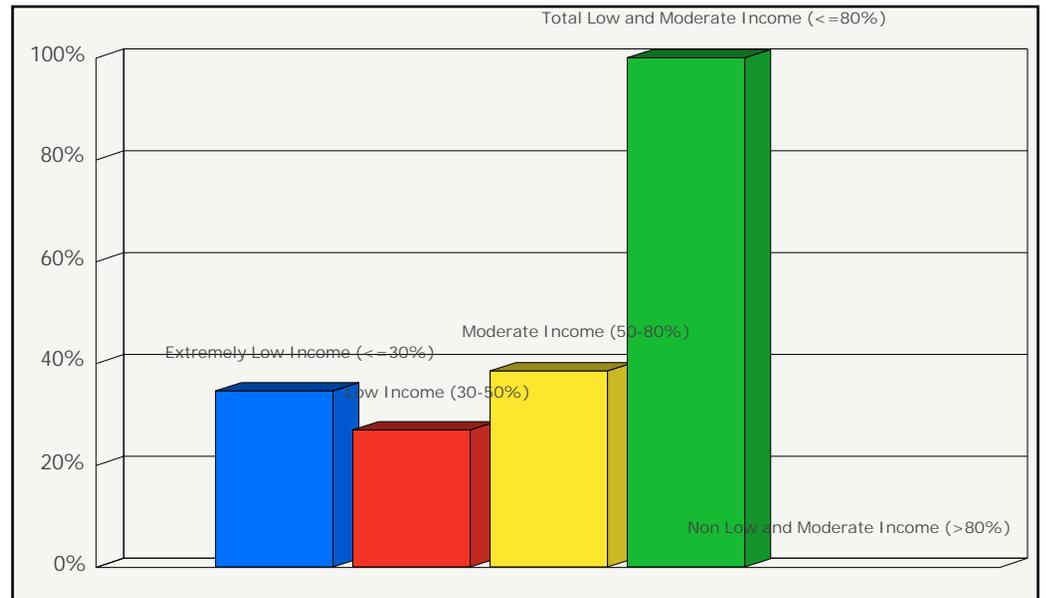

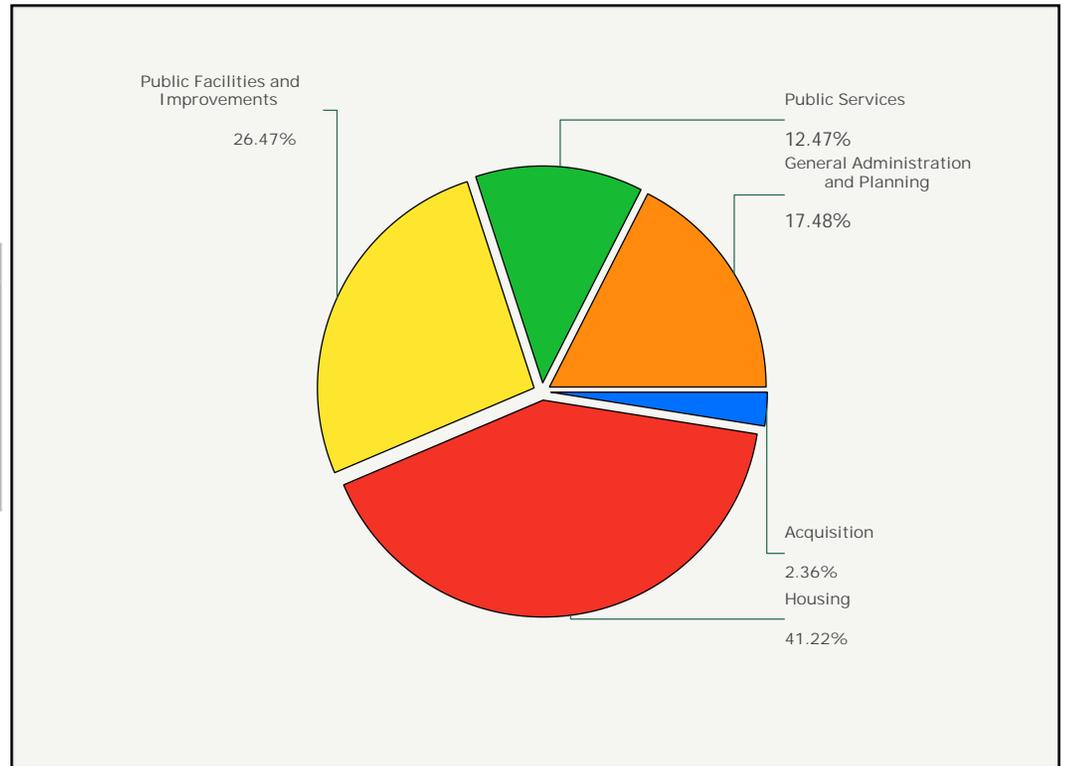

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



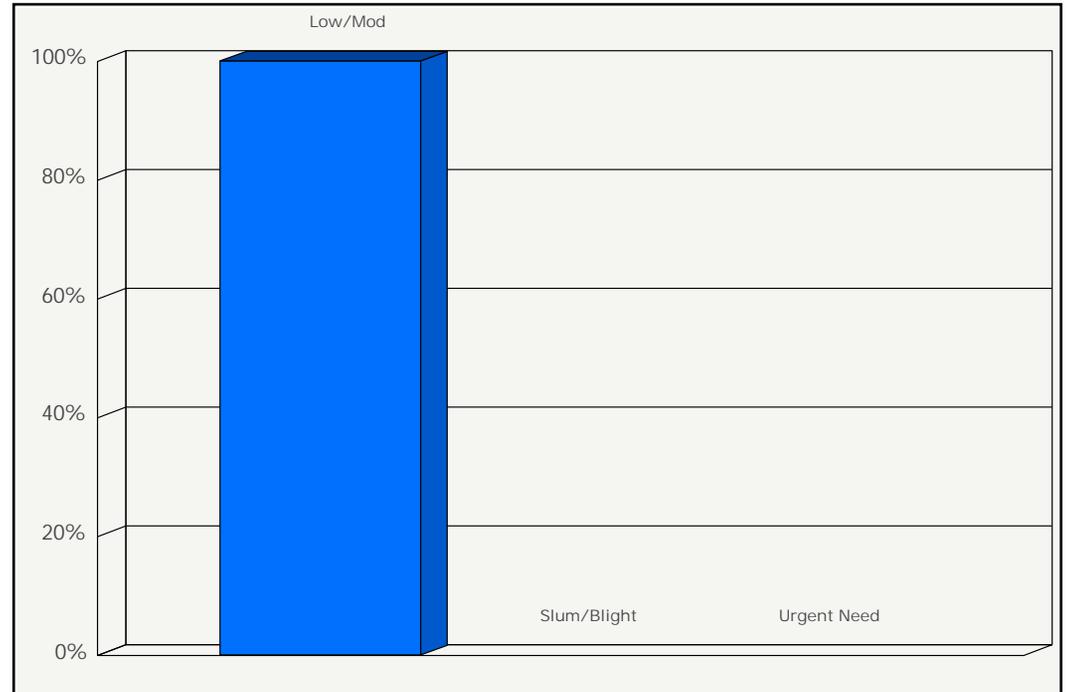

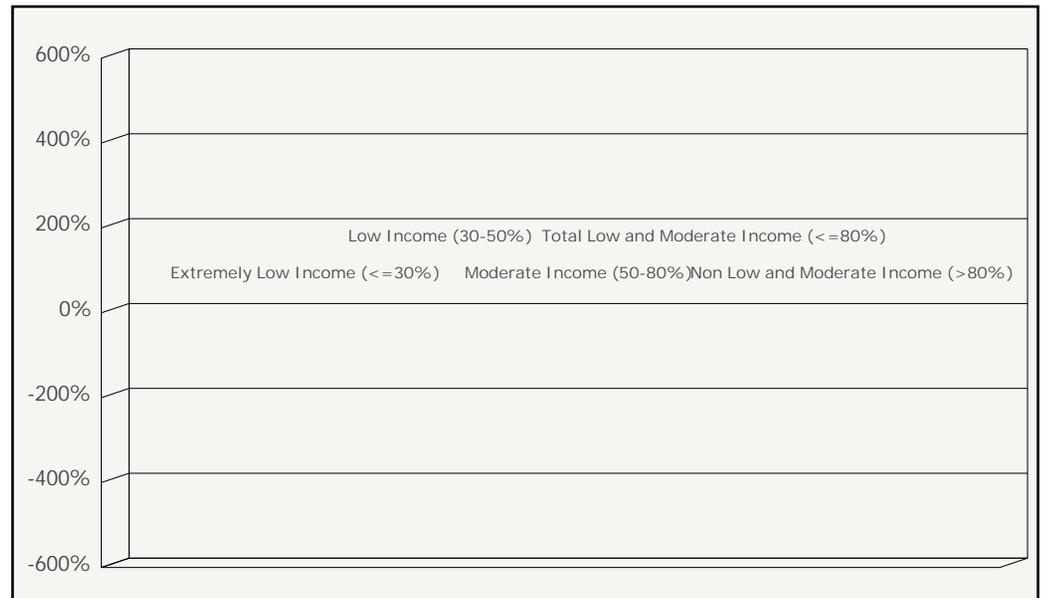

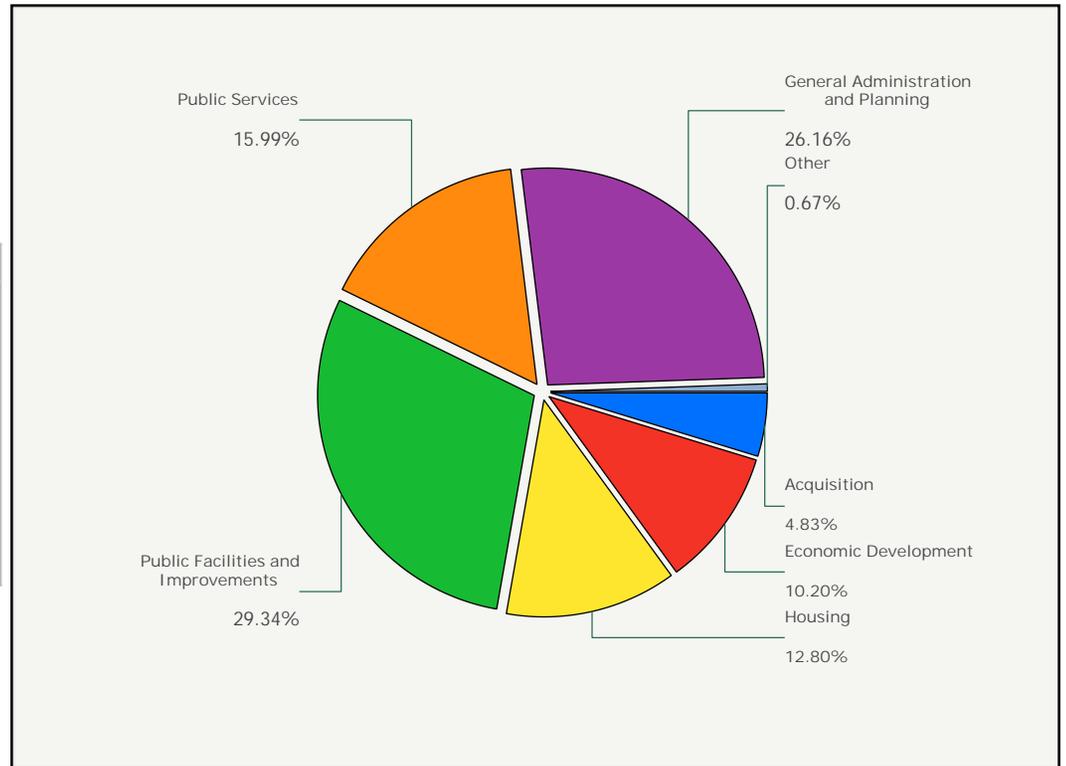

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



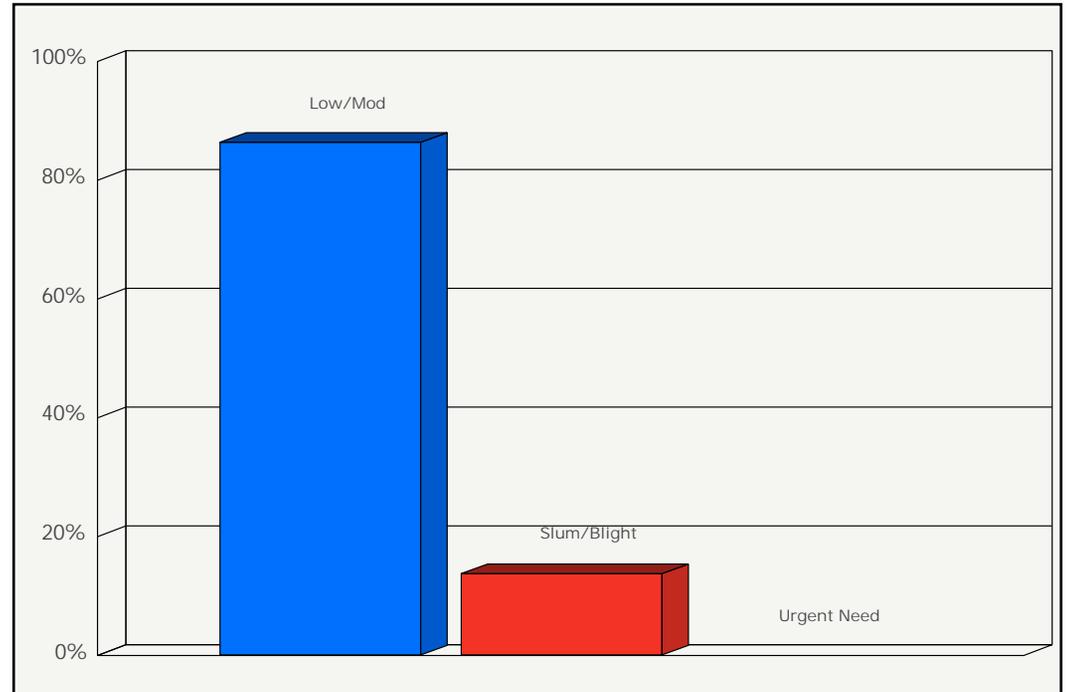

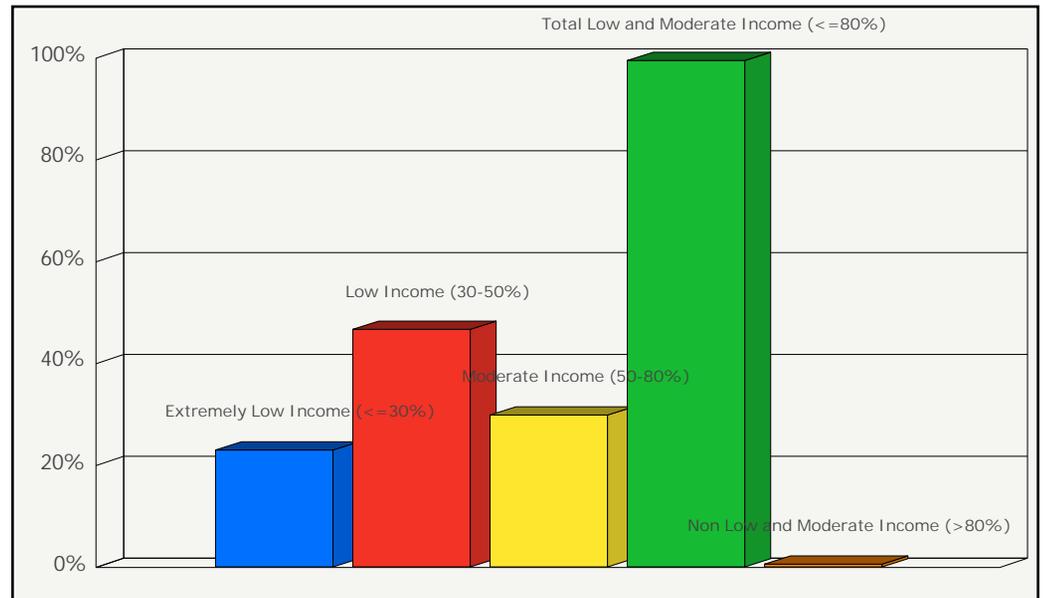

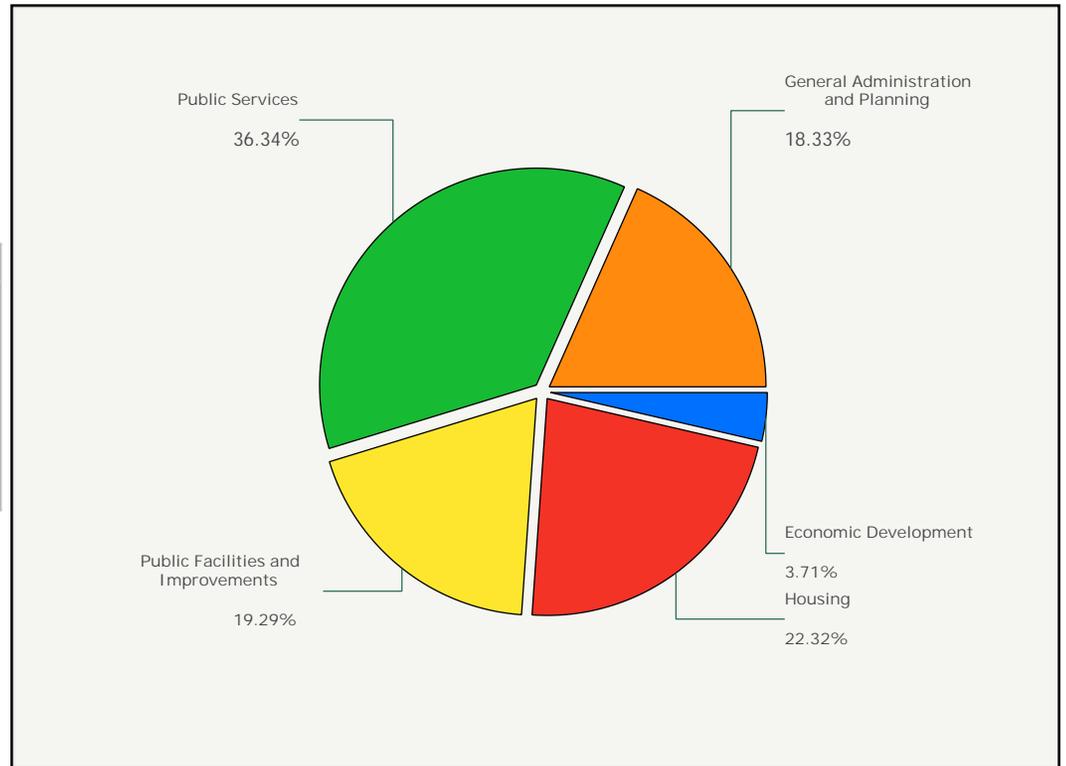

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



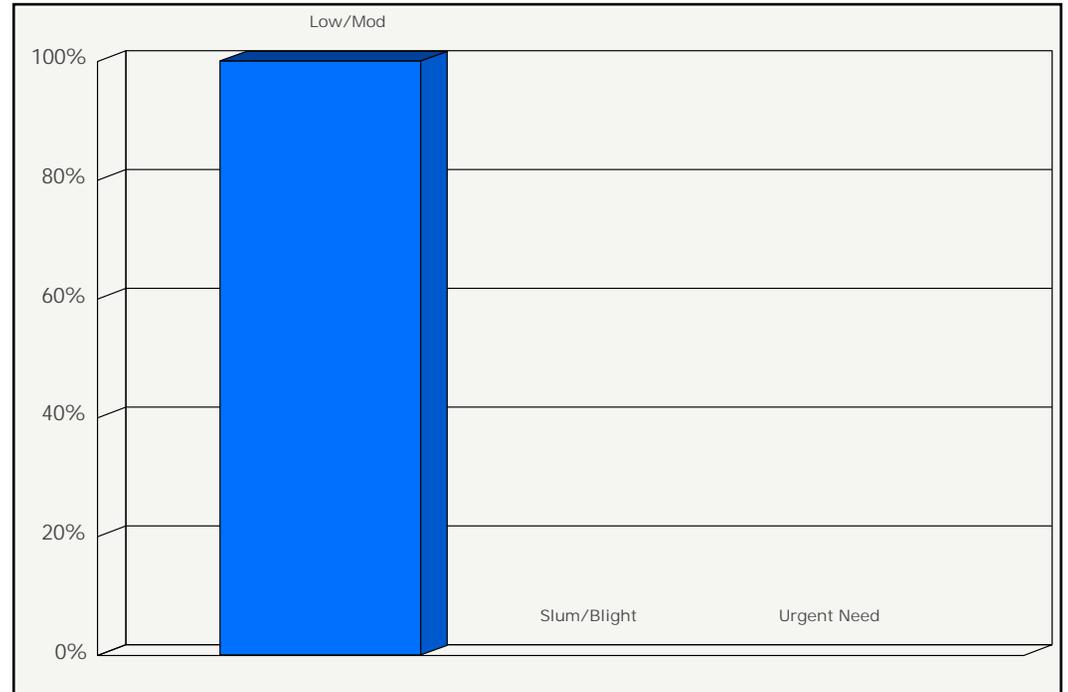

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



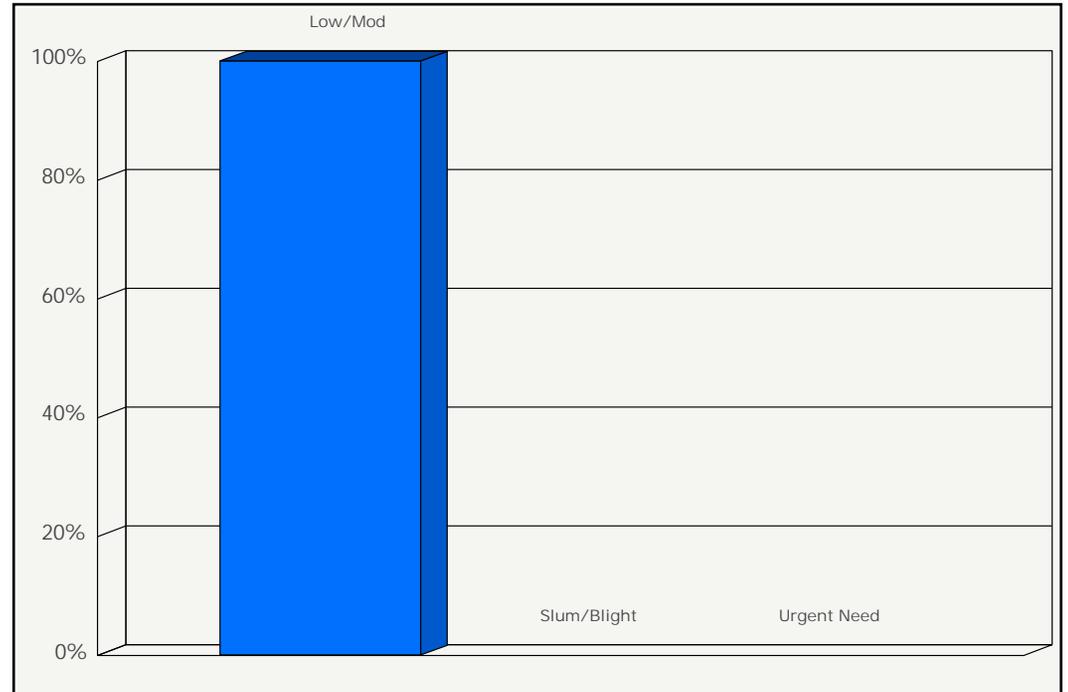

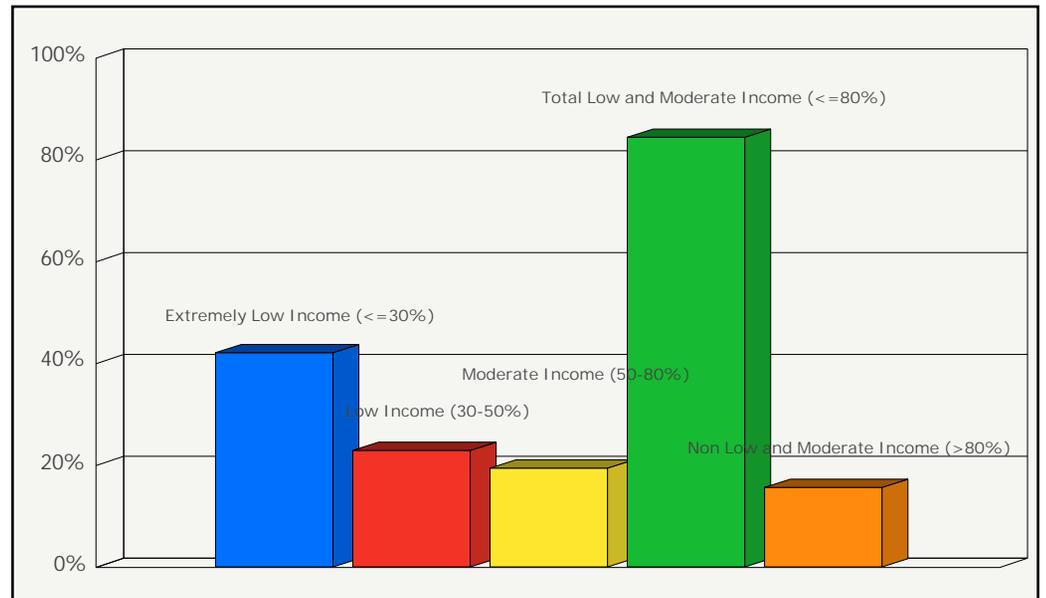

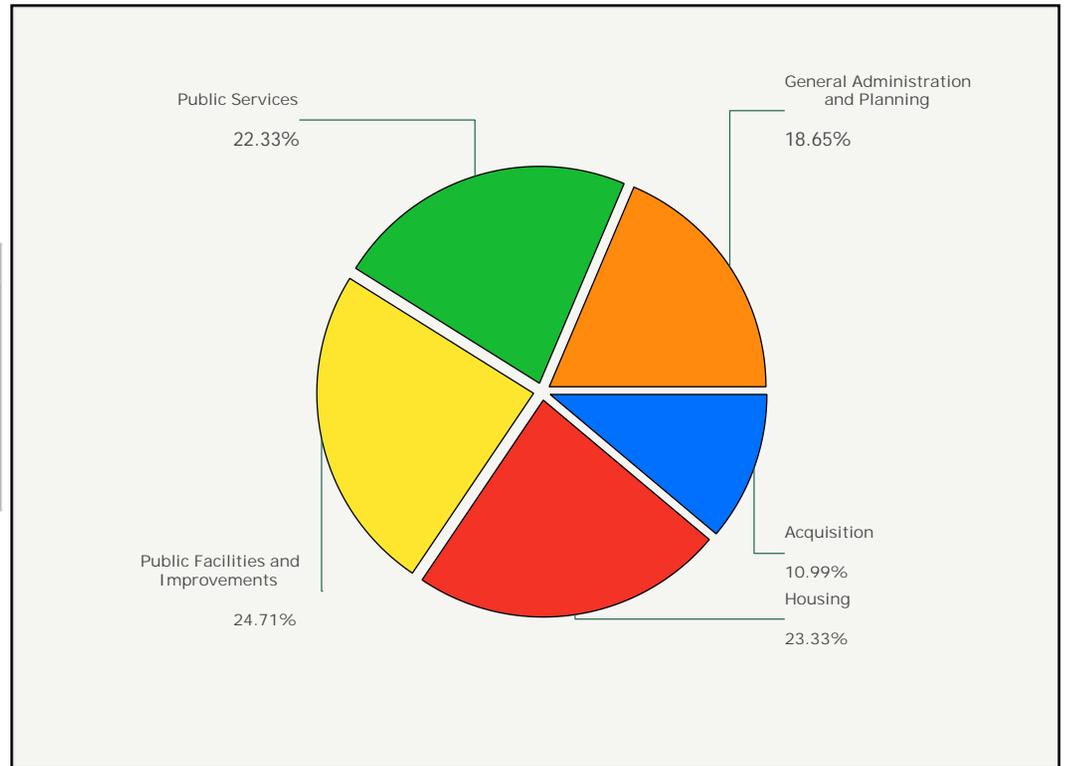

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



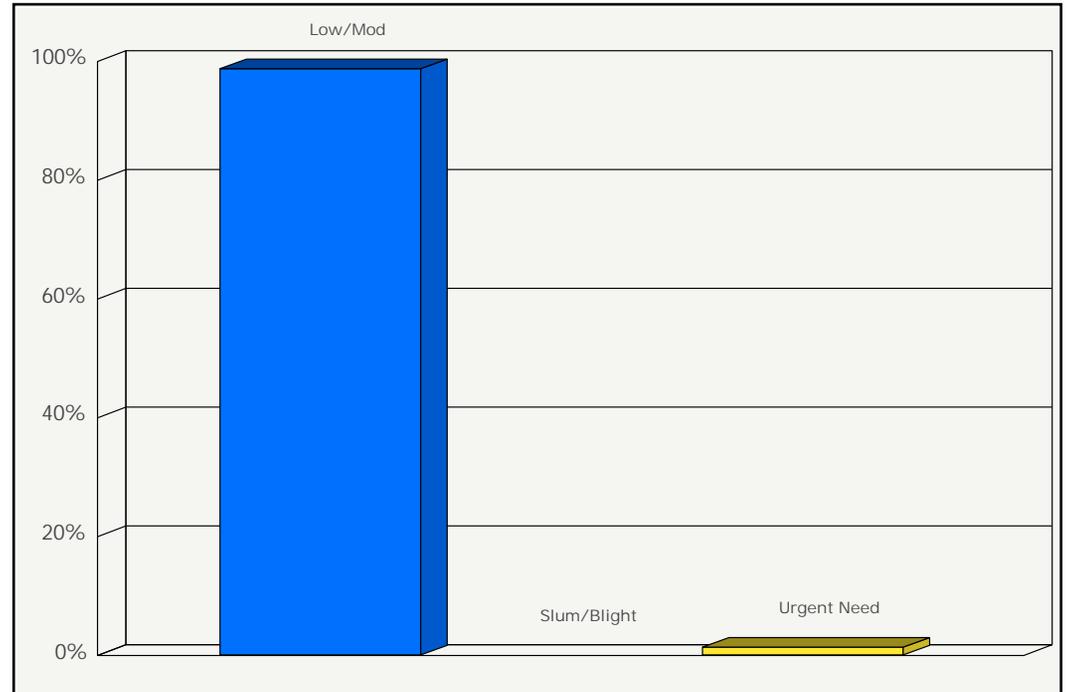

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



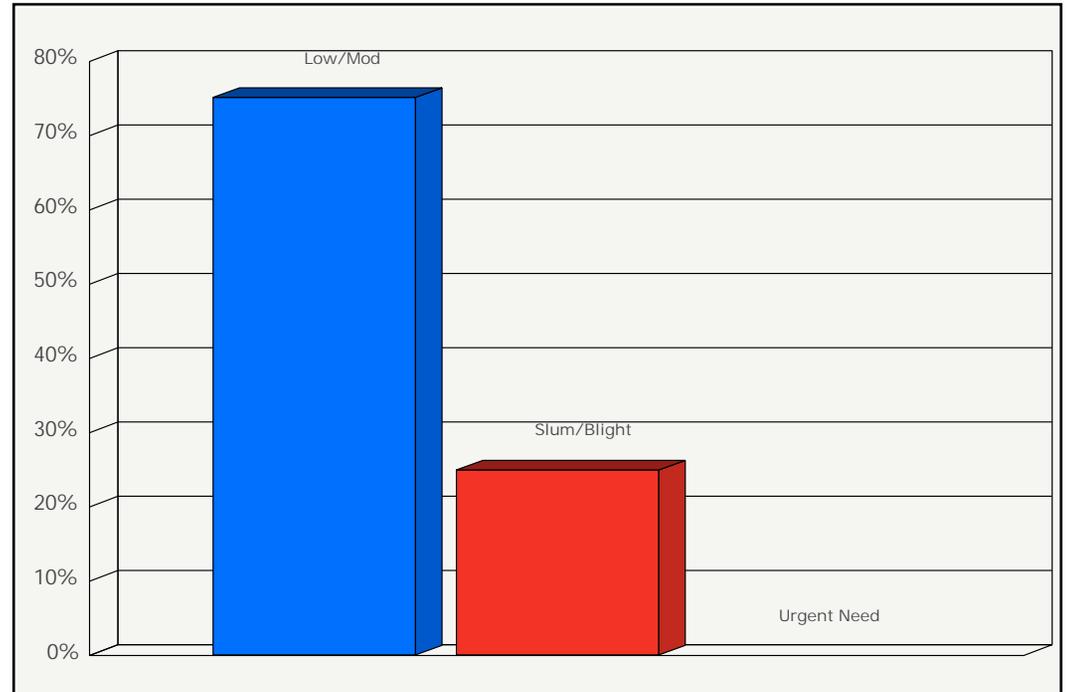

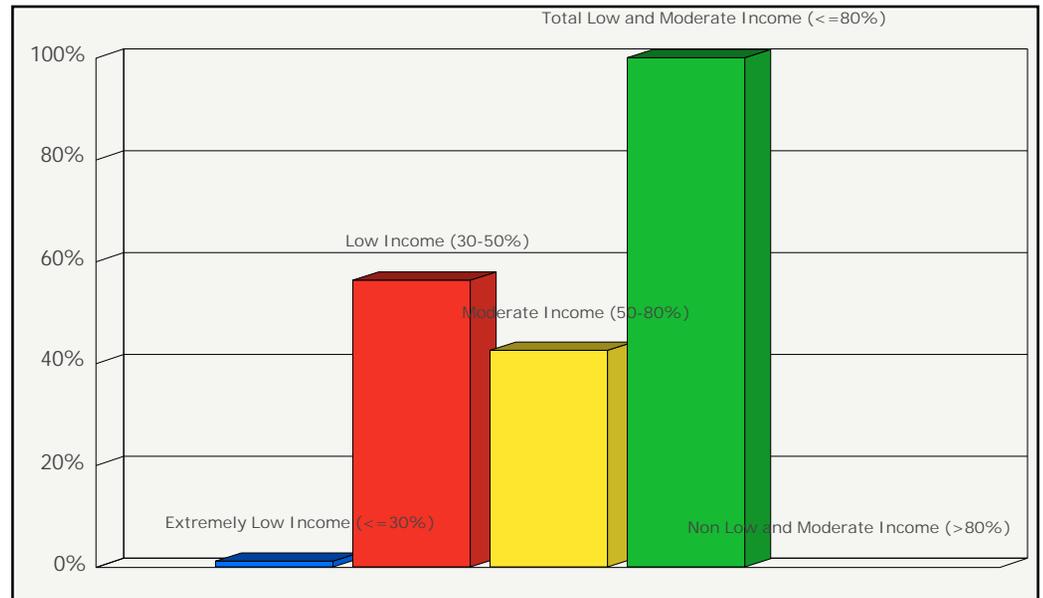

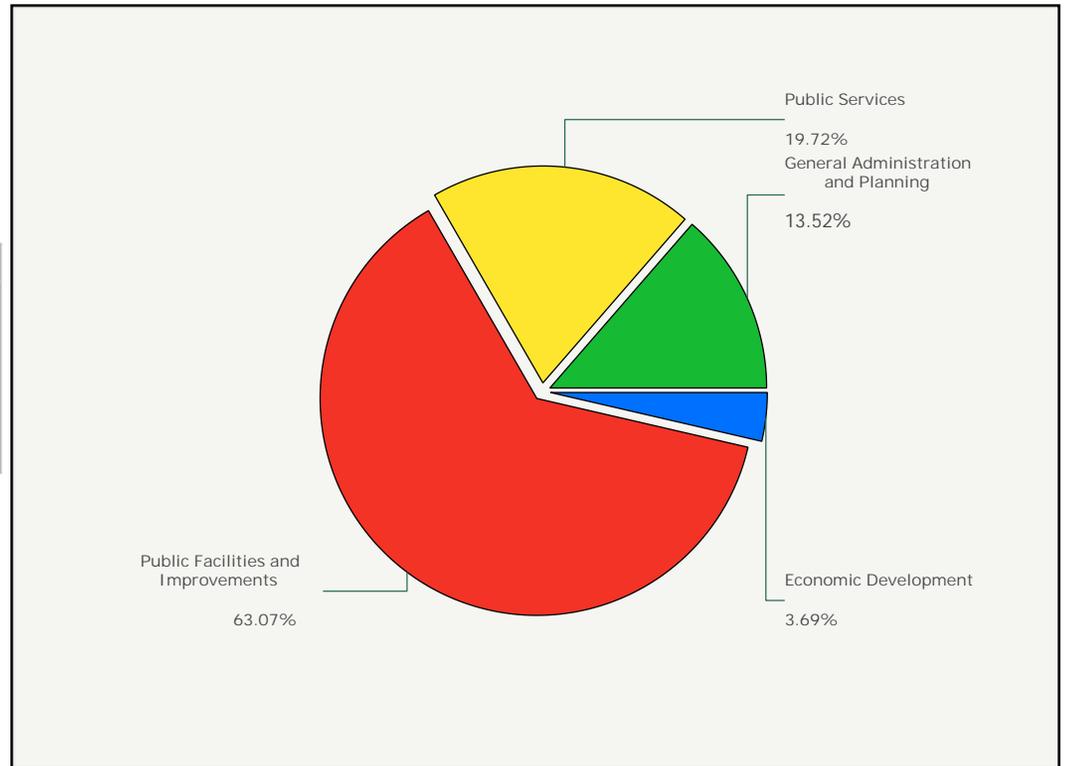

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



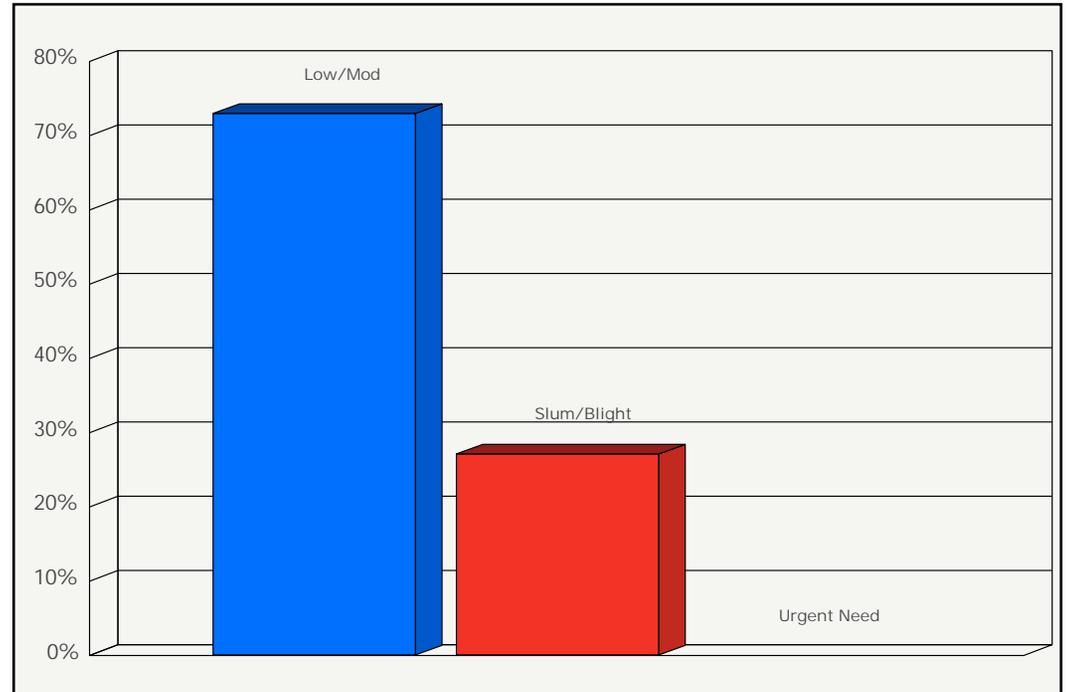

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



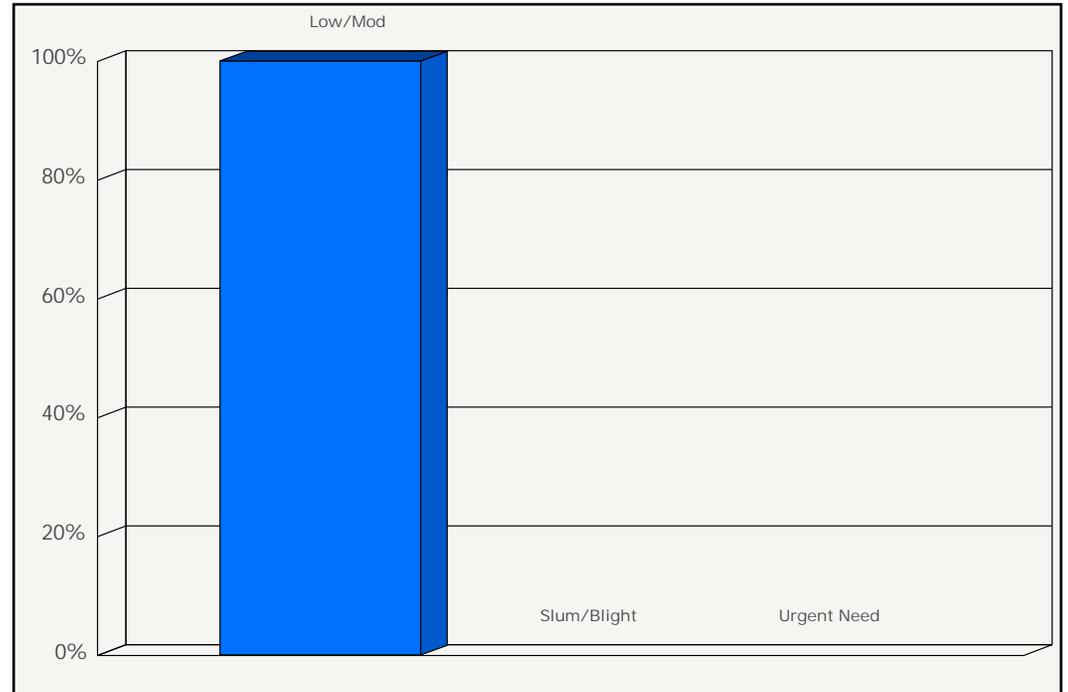

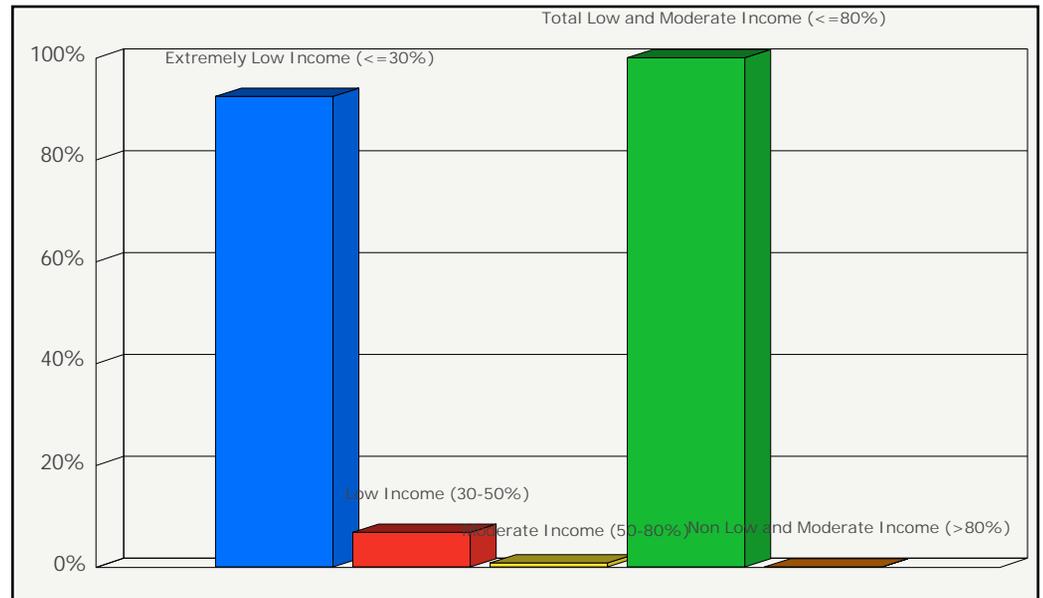

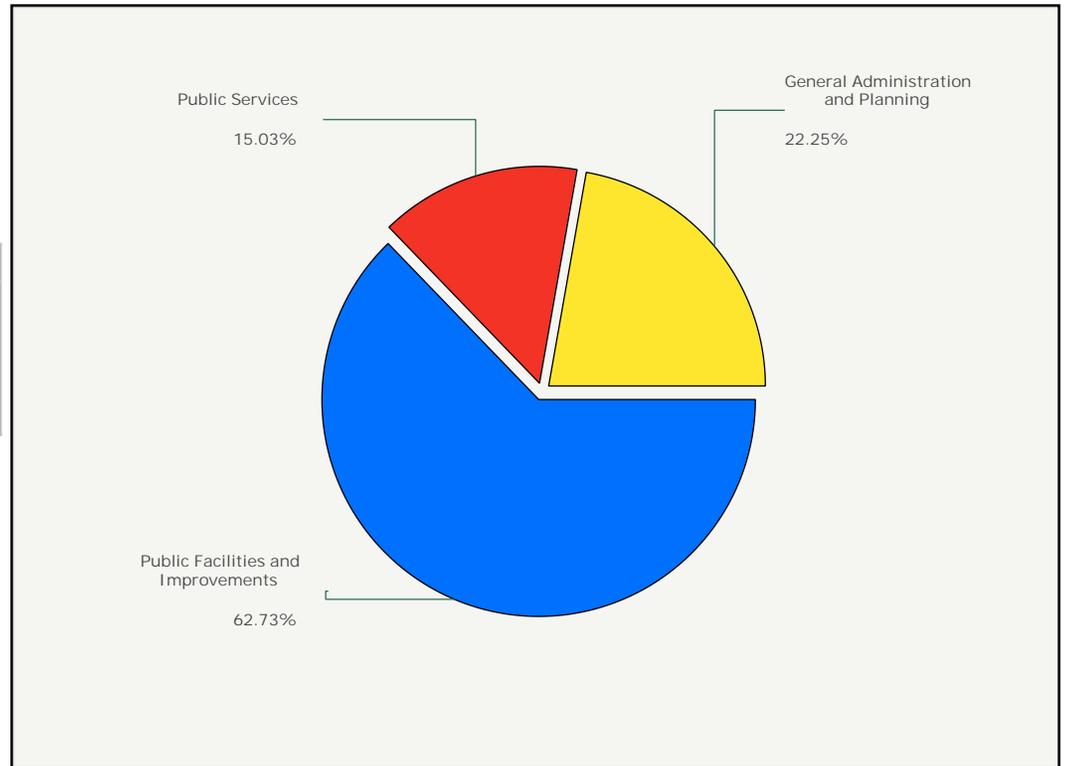

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



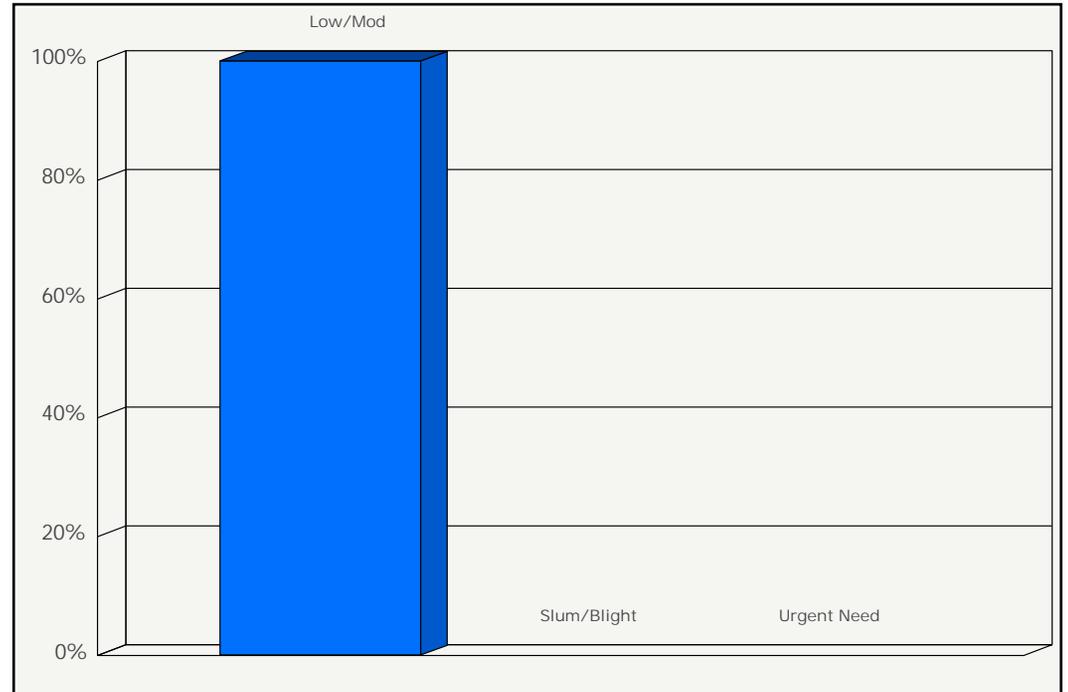

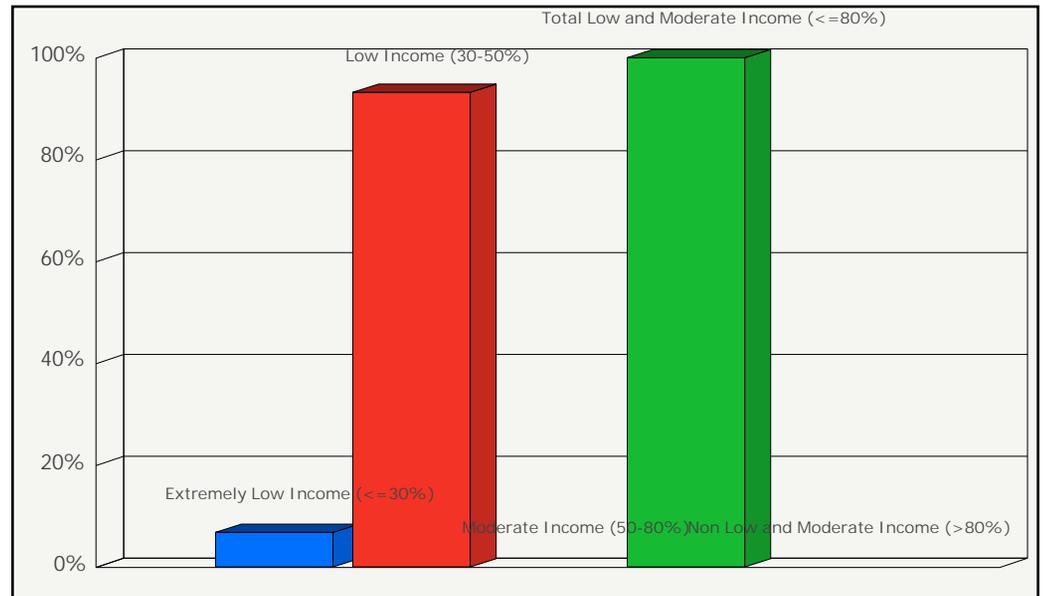

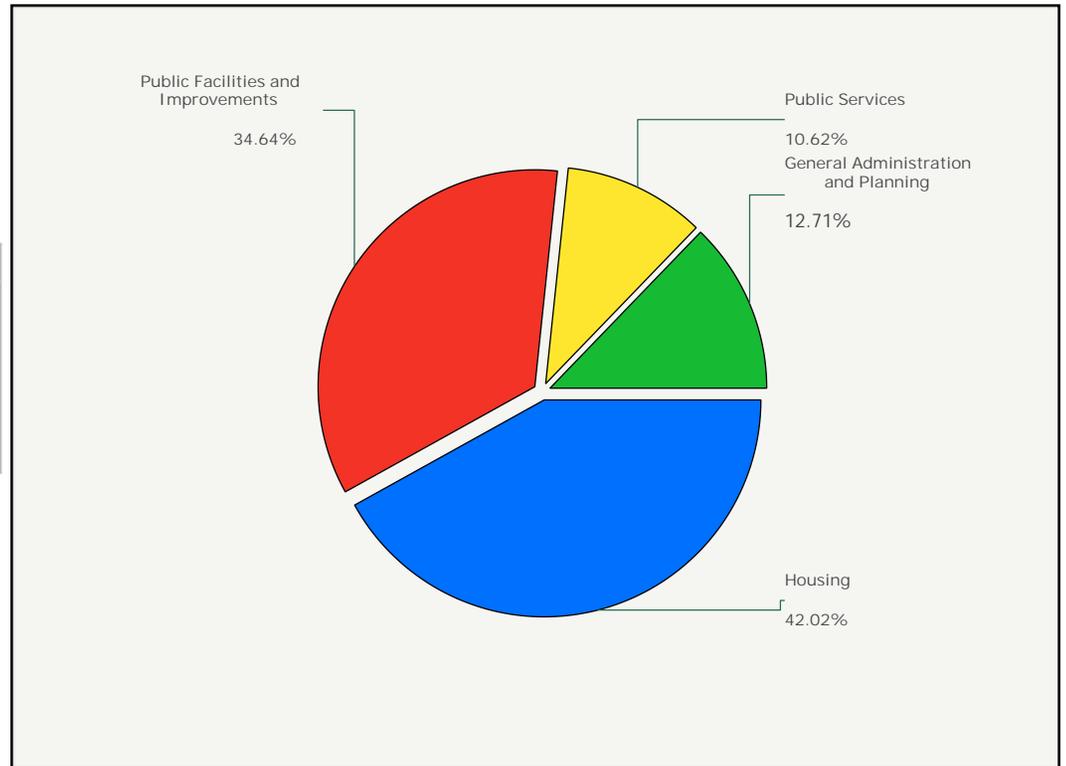

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



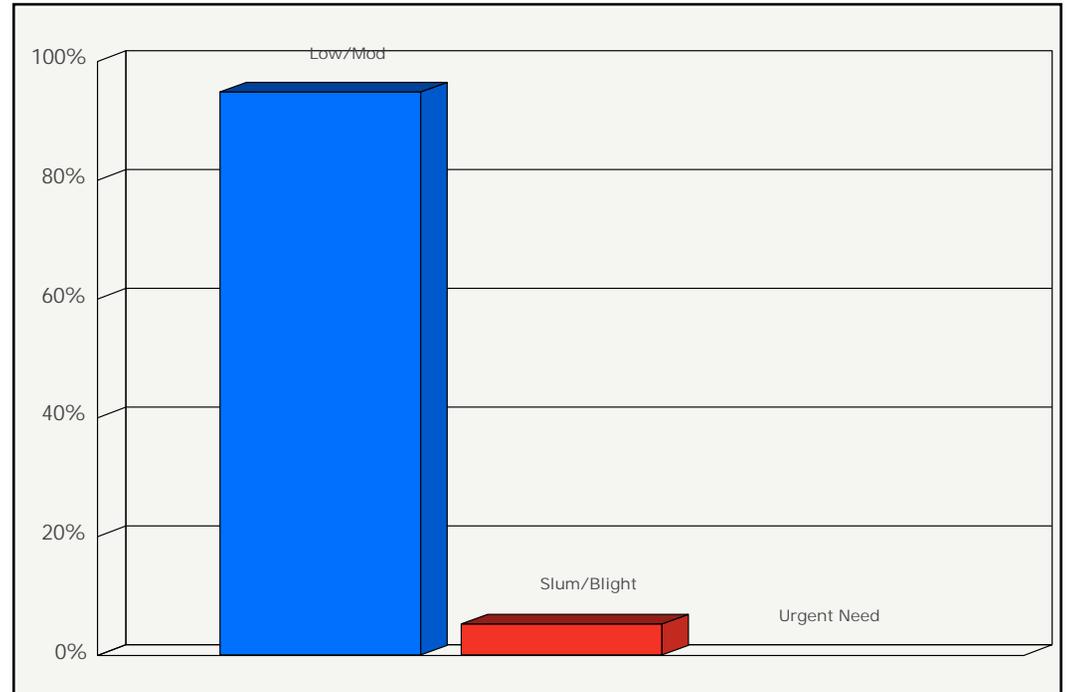

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



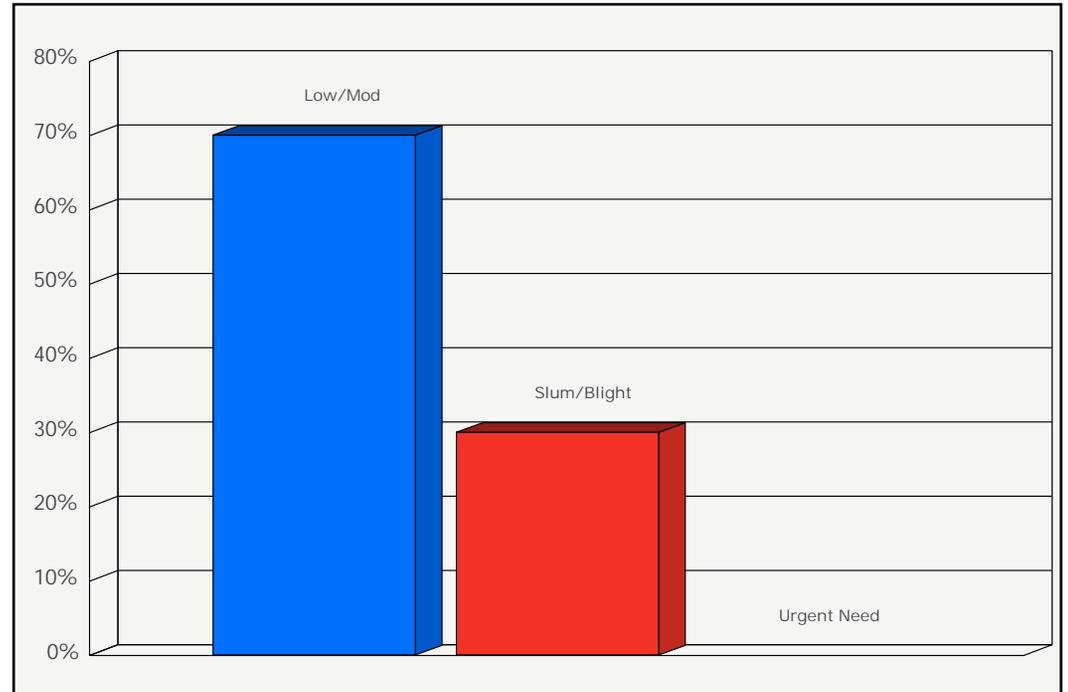

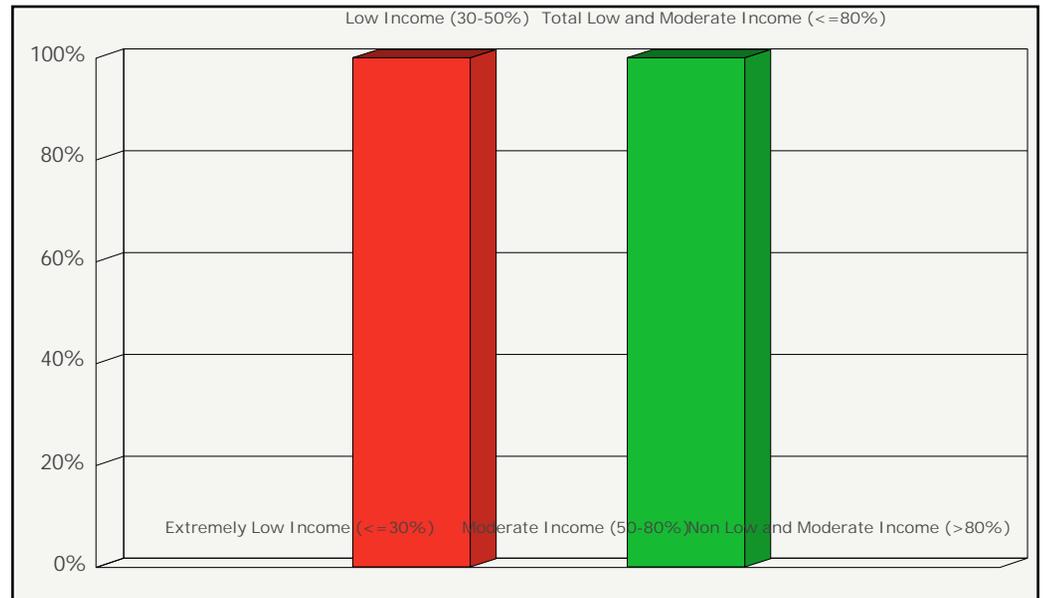

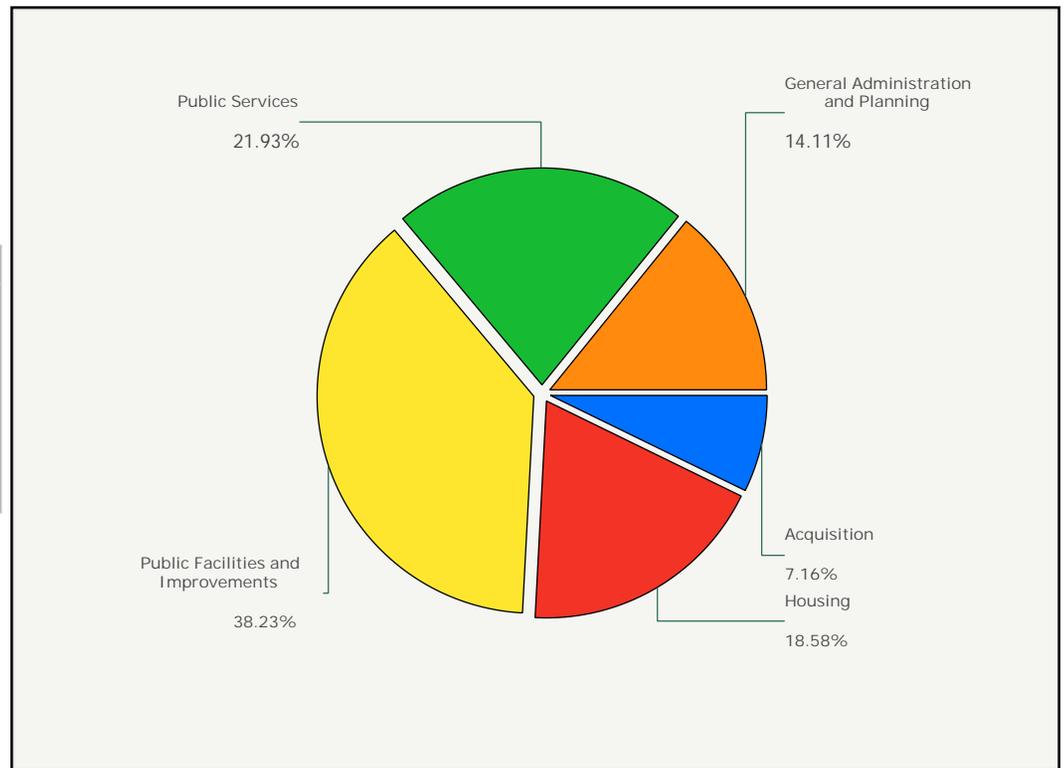

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



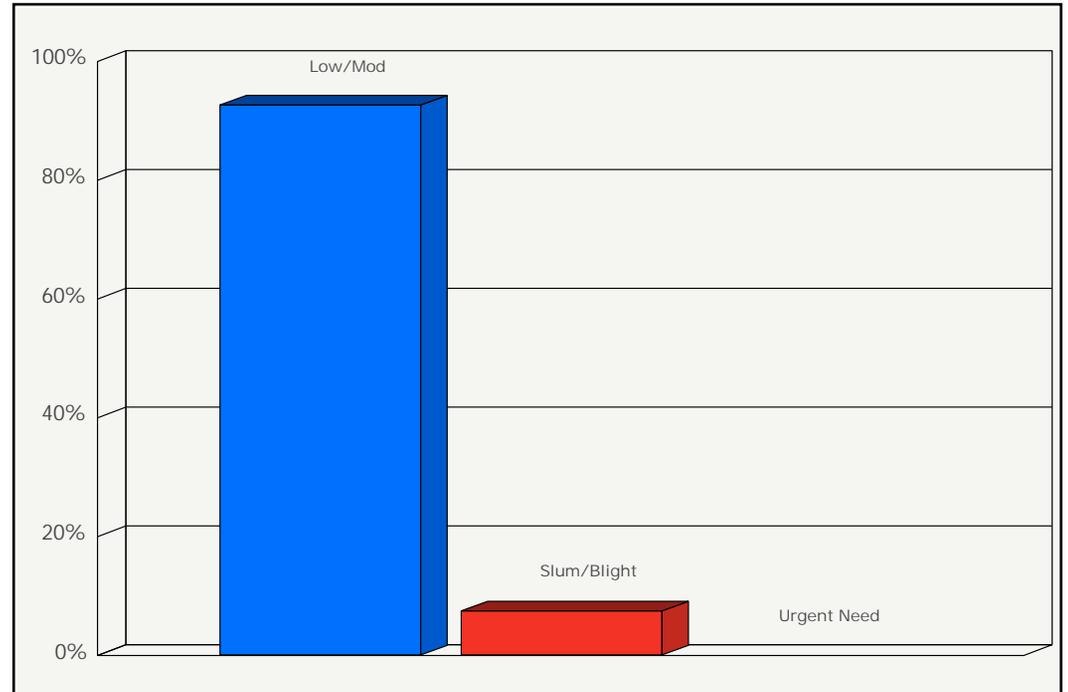

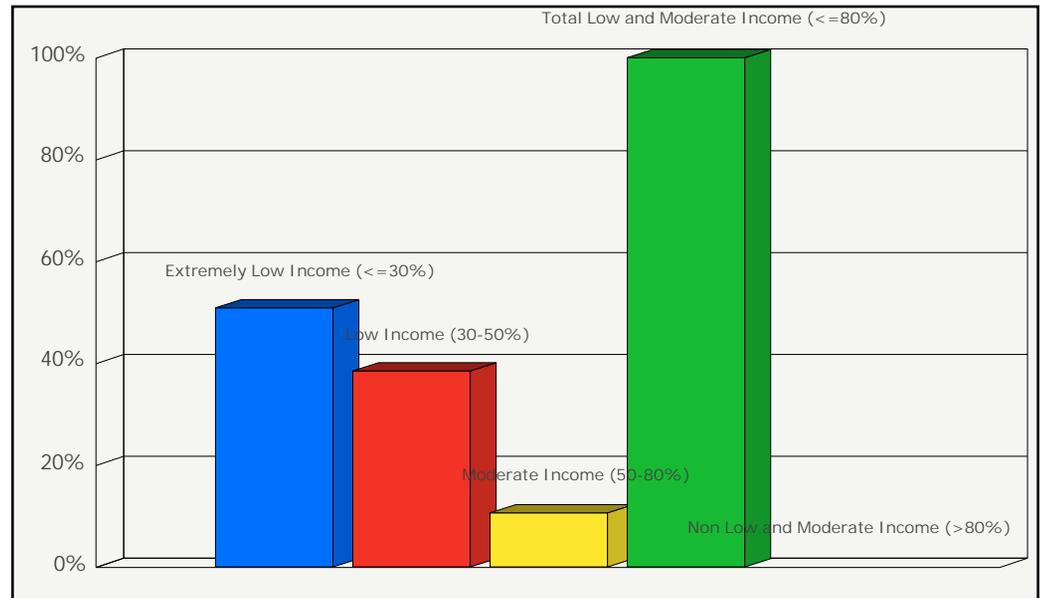

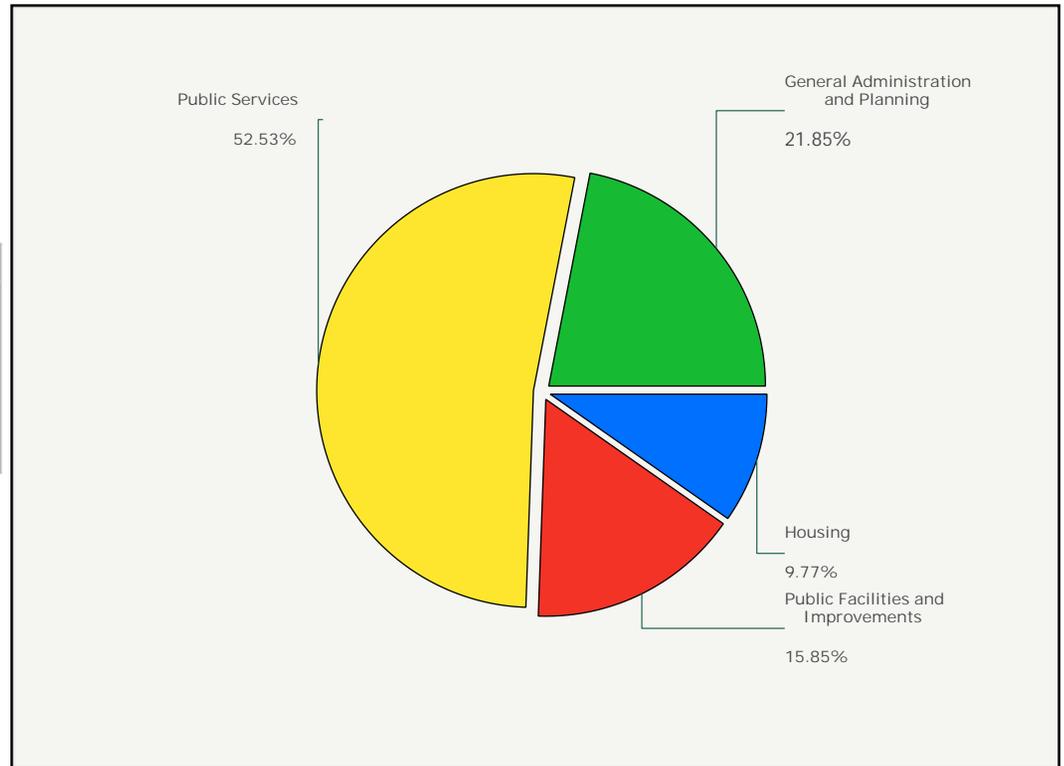

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



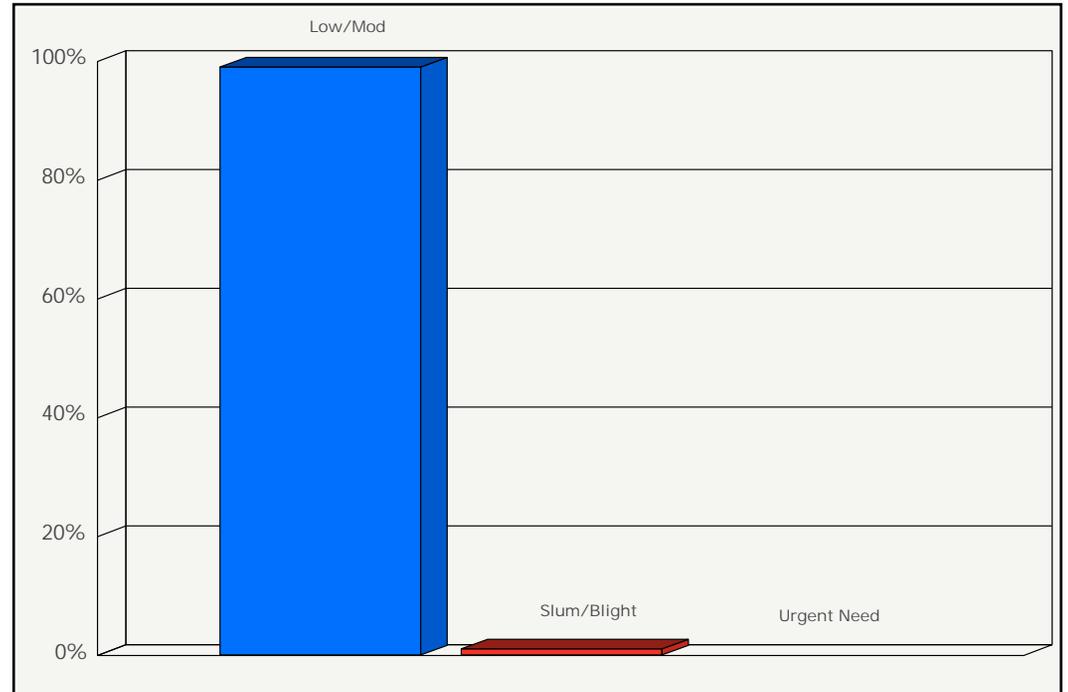

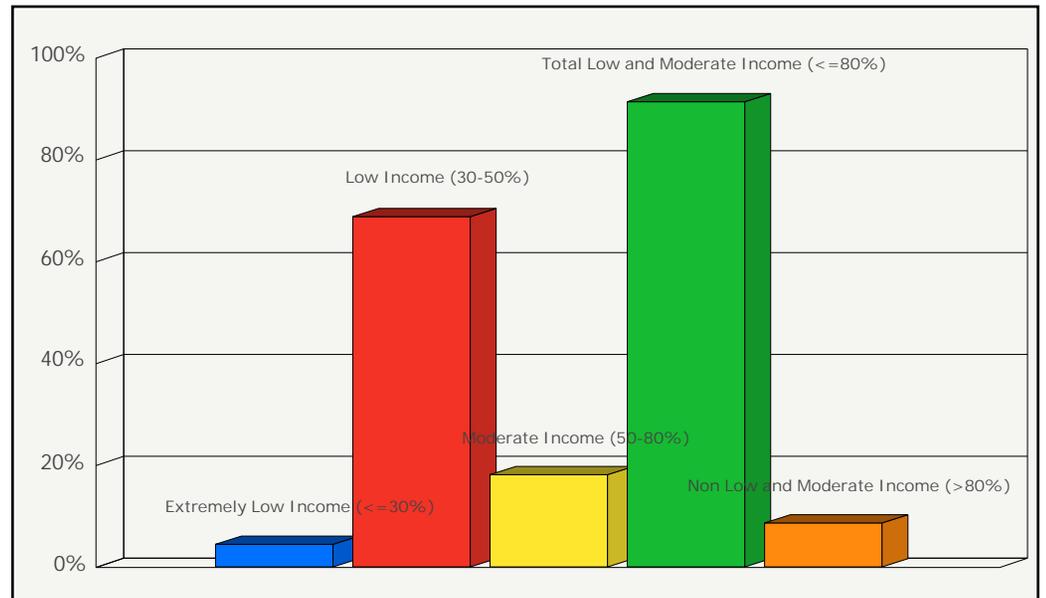

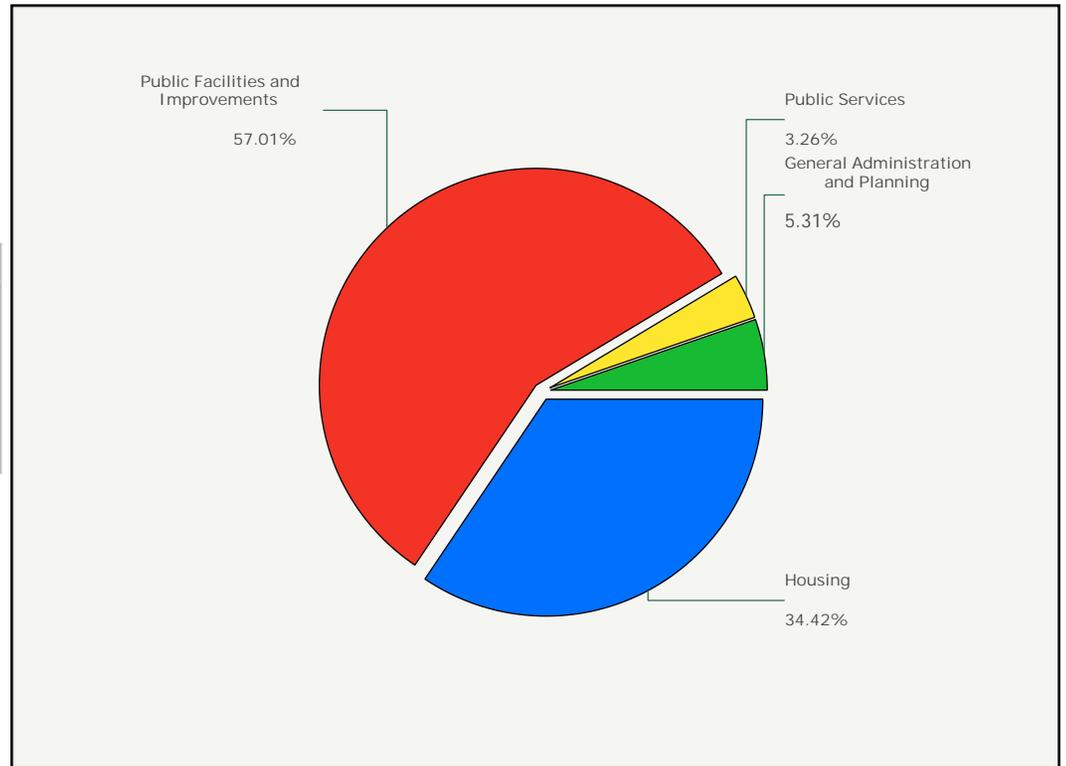

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



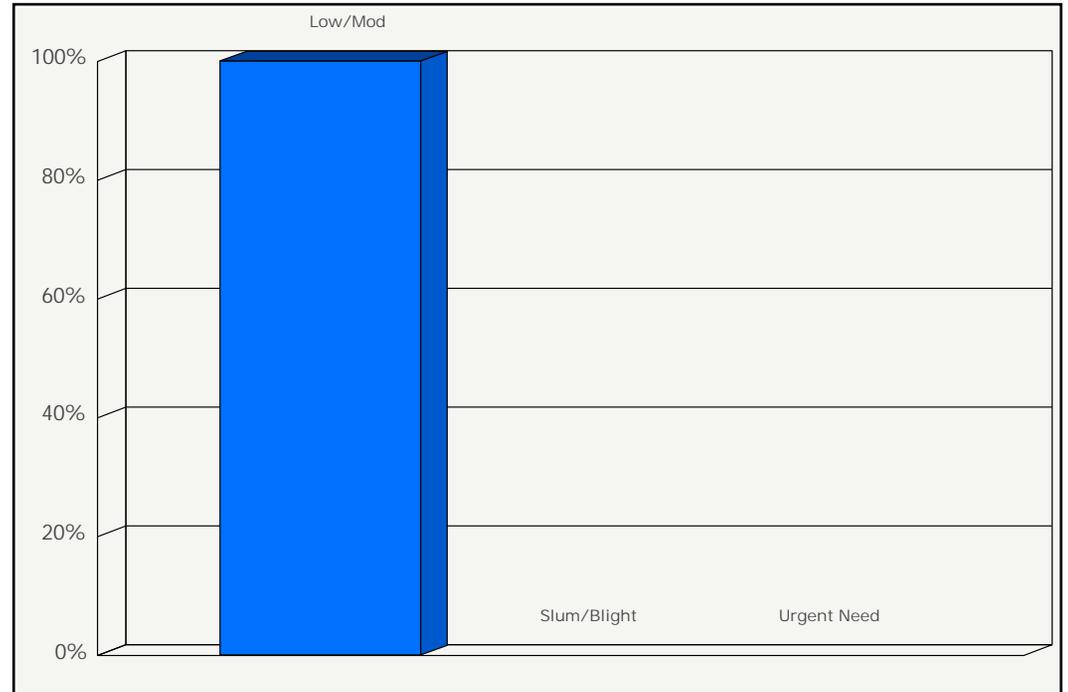

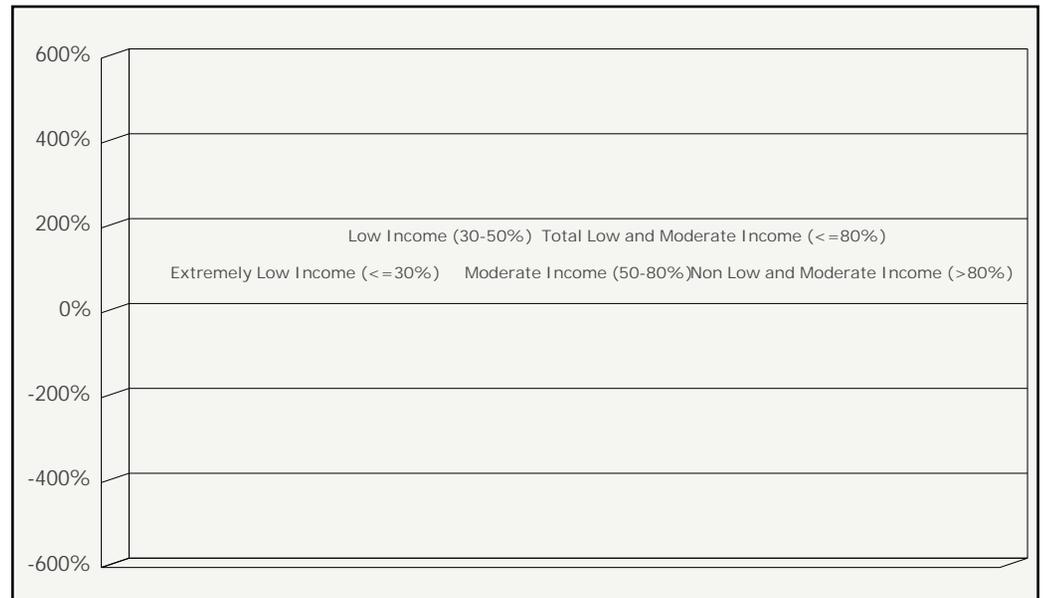

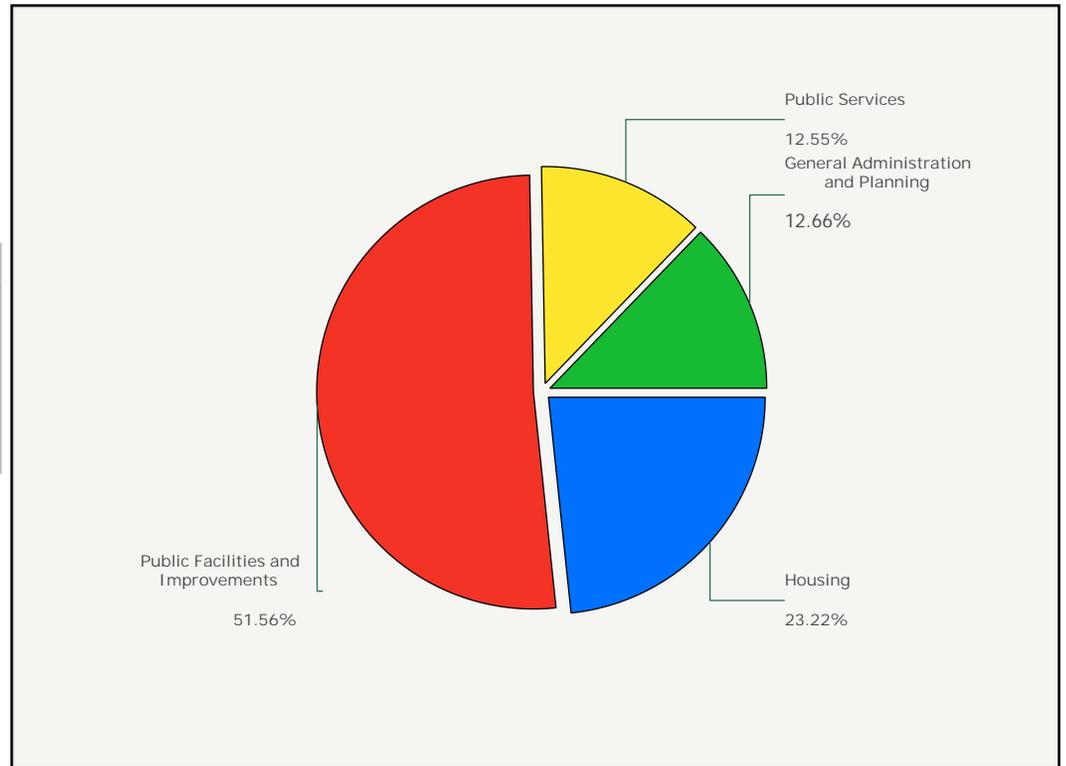

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



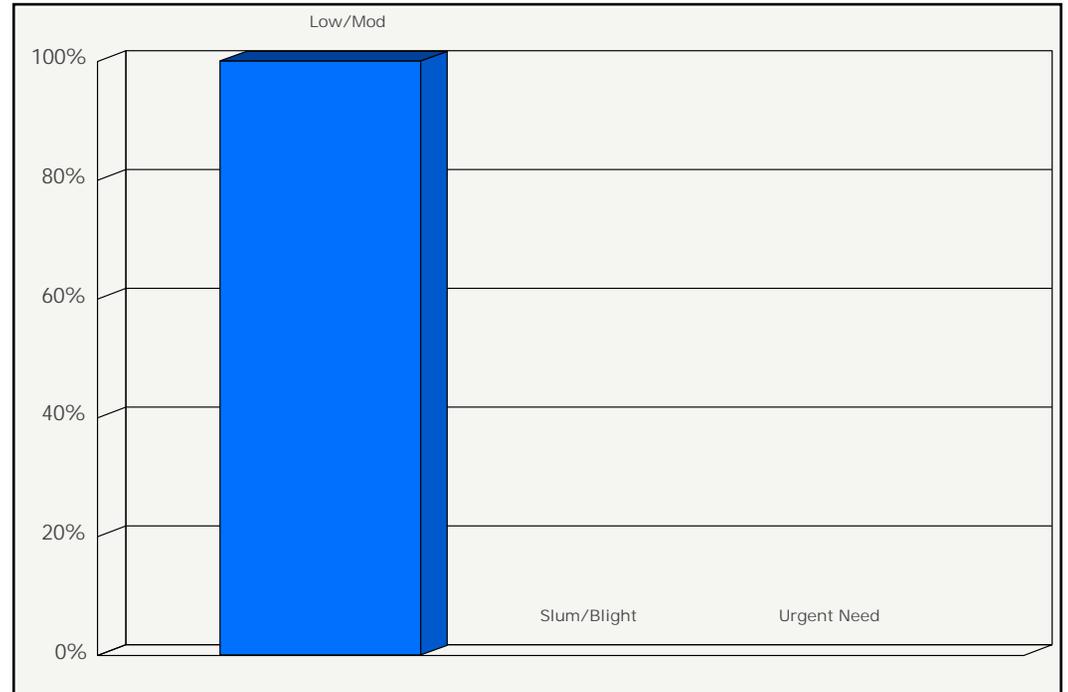

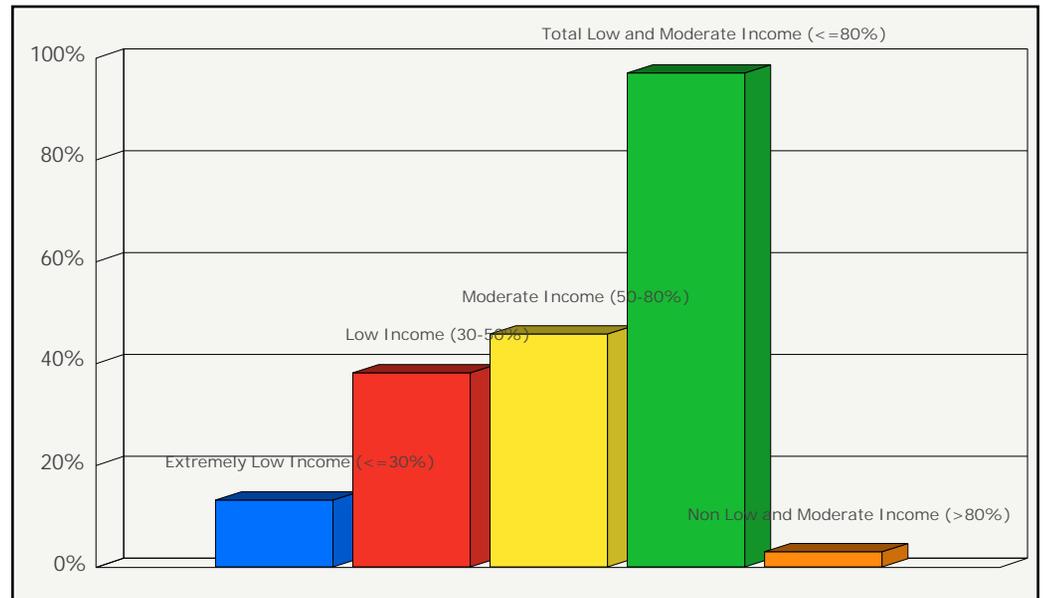

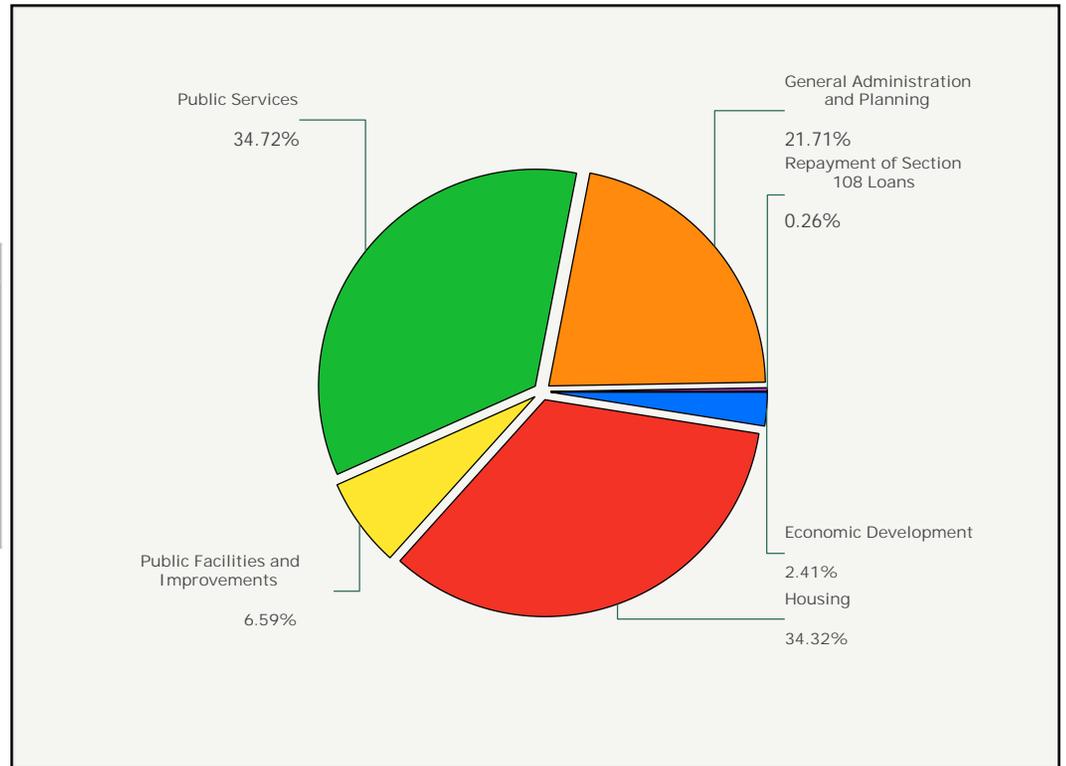

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



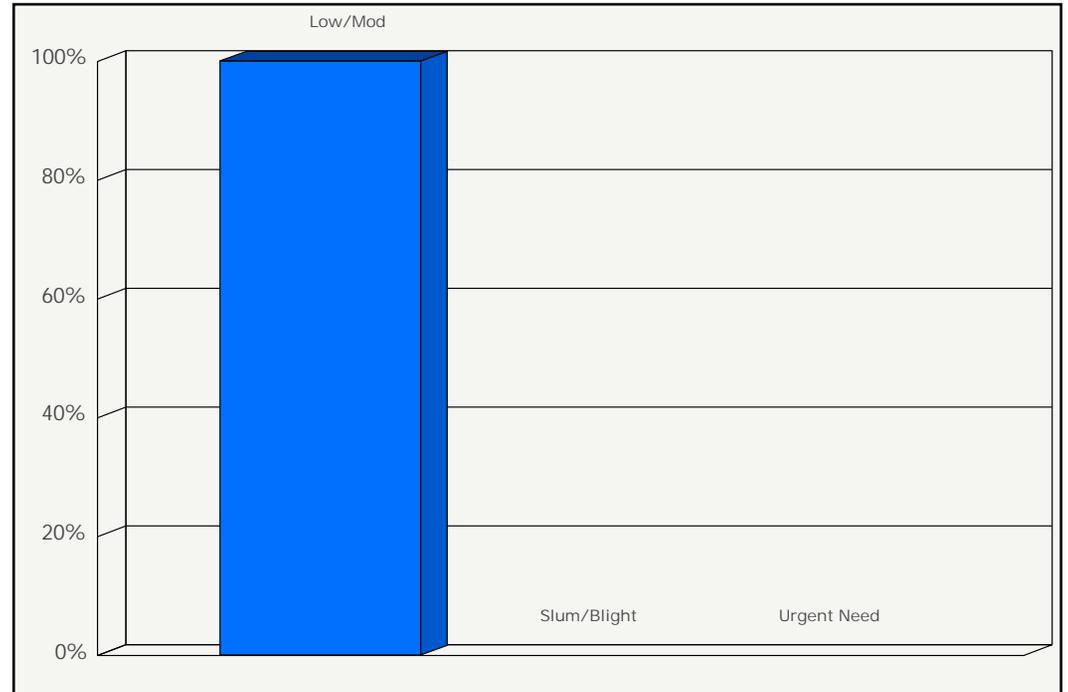

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



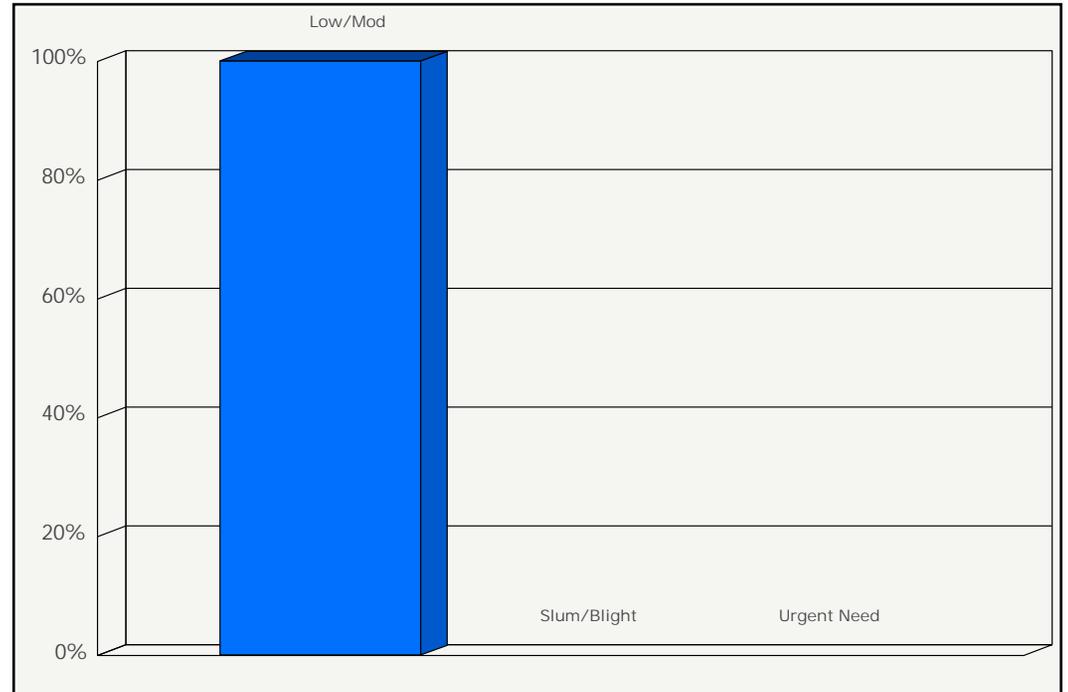

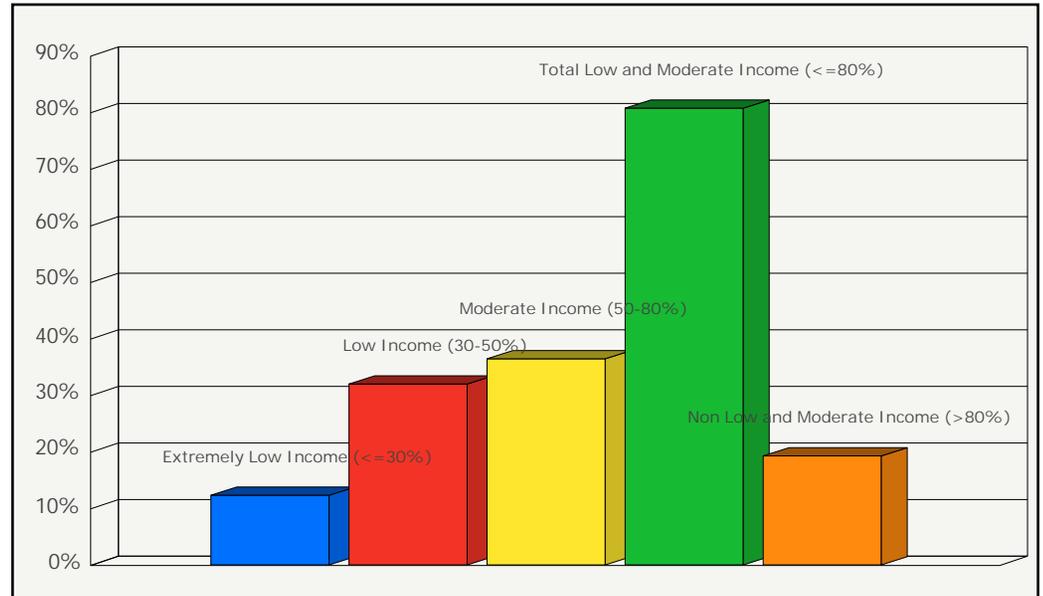

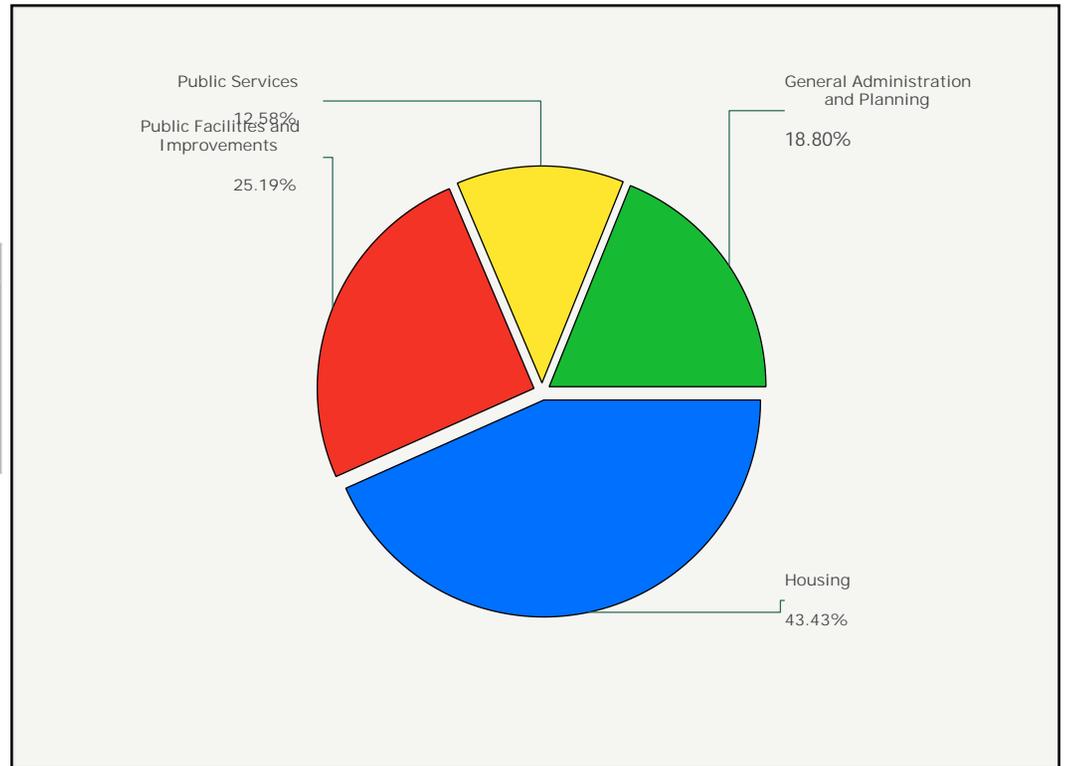

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



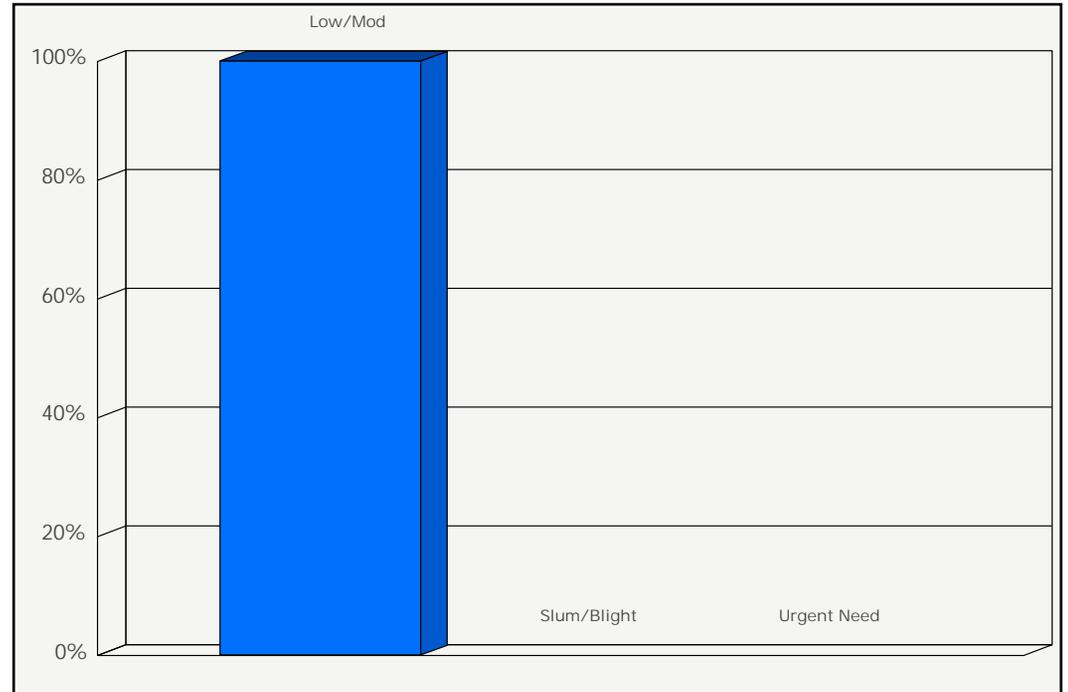

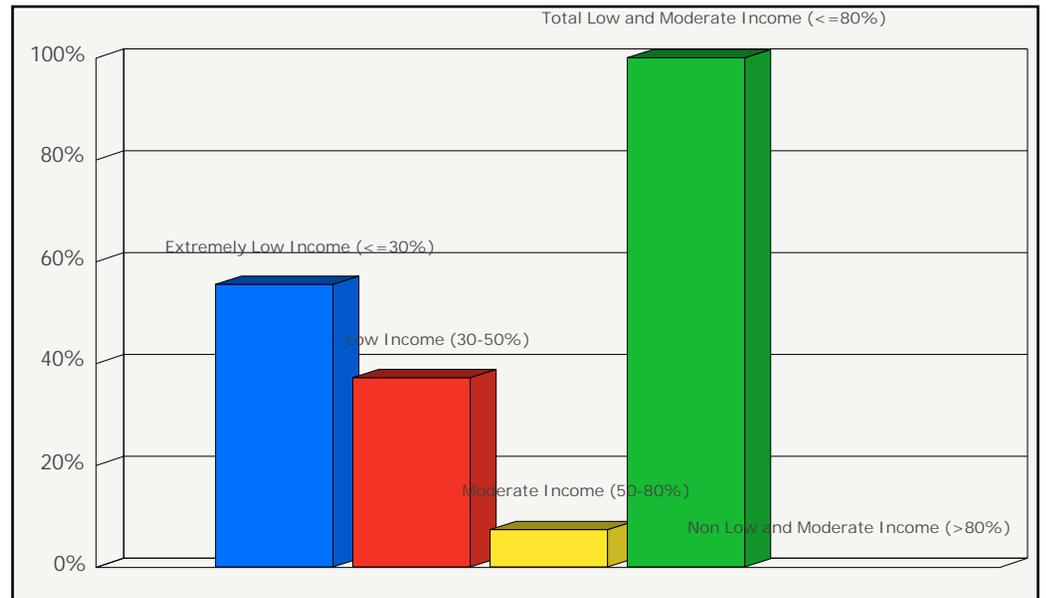

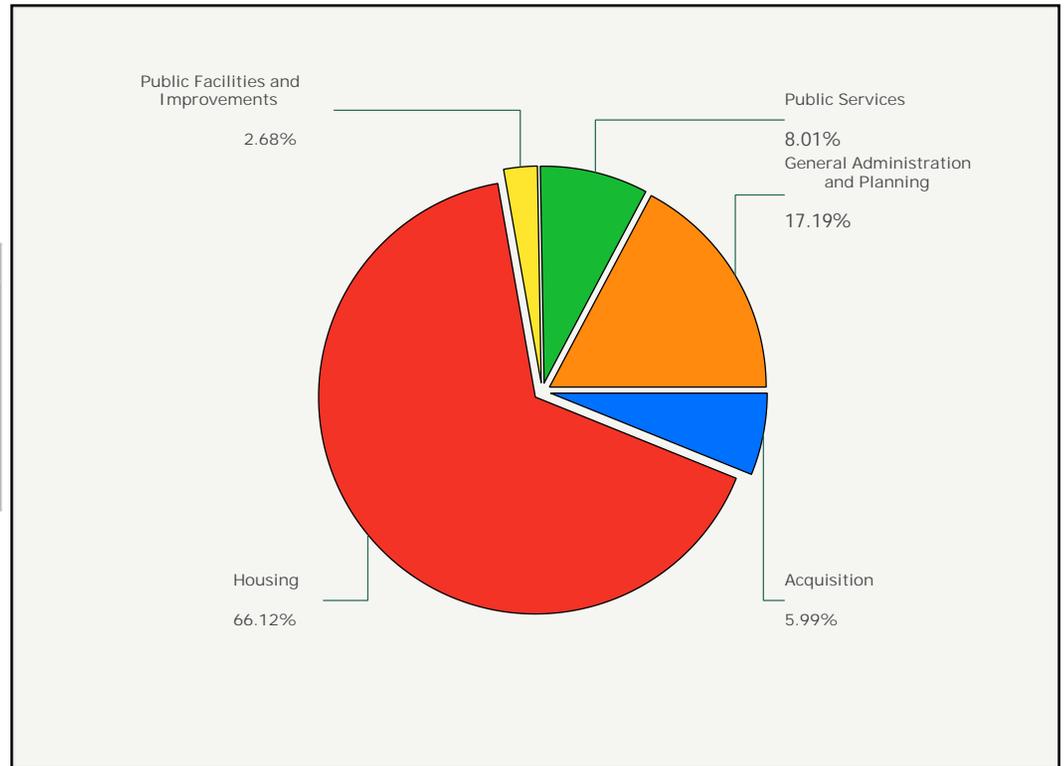

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



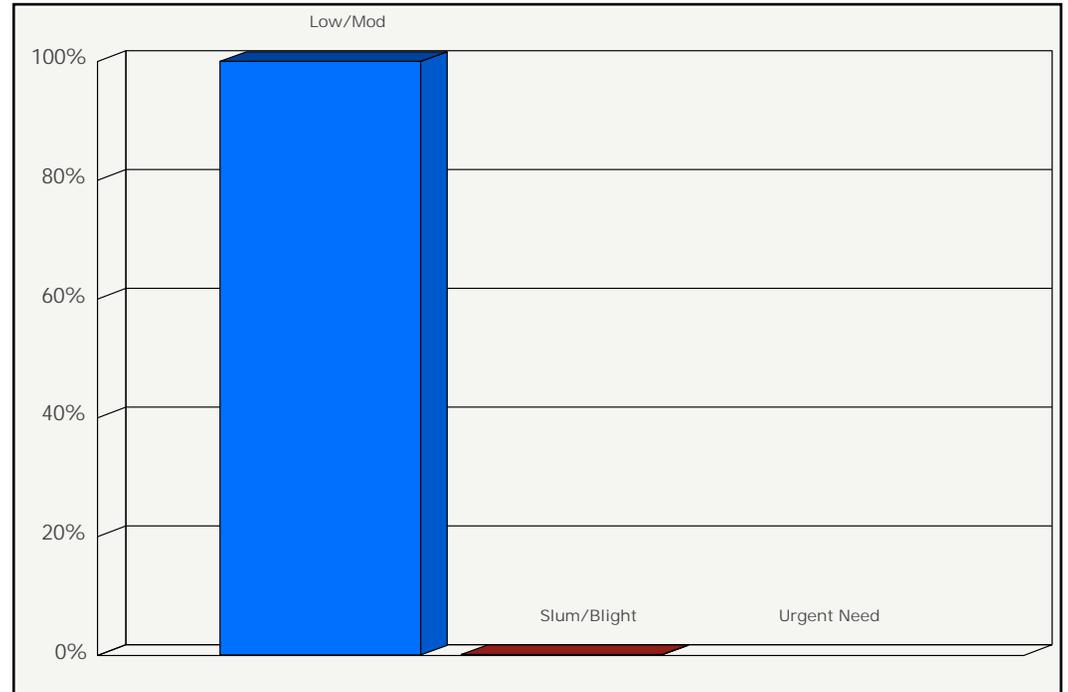

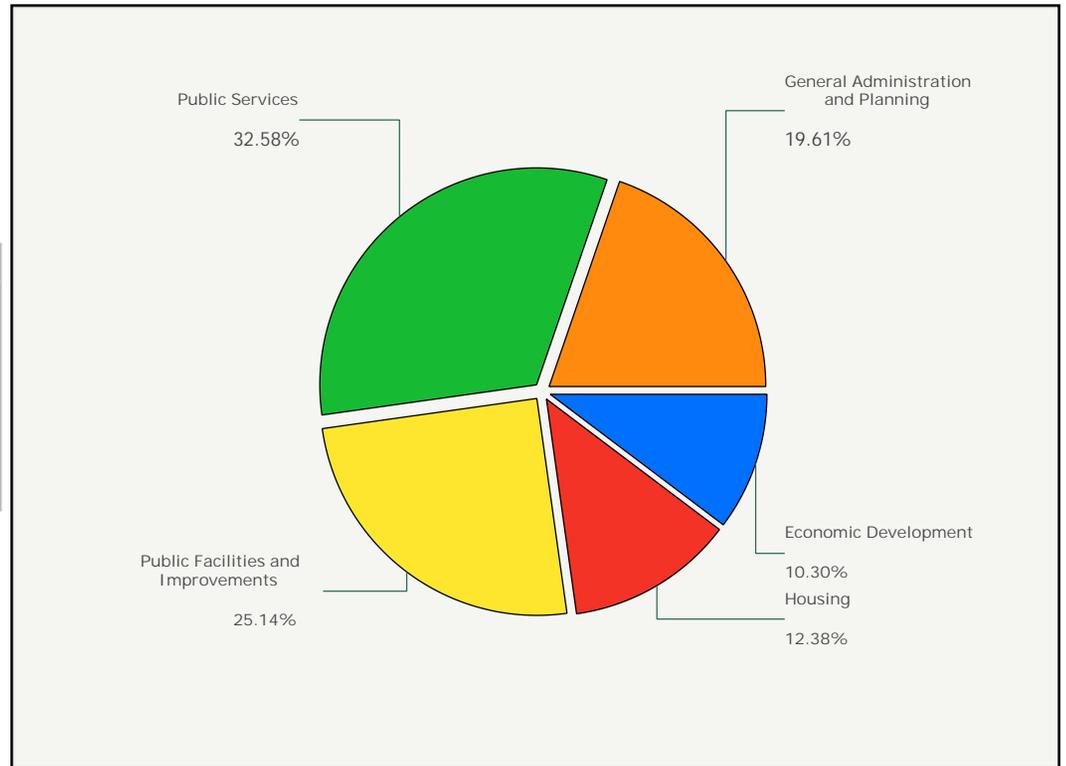

**Expenditures by Type of Activity (%)**



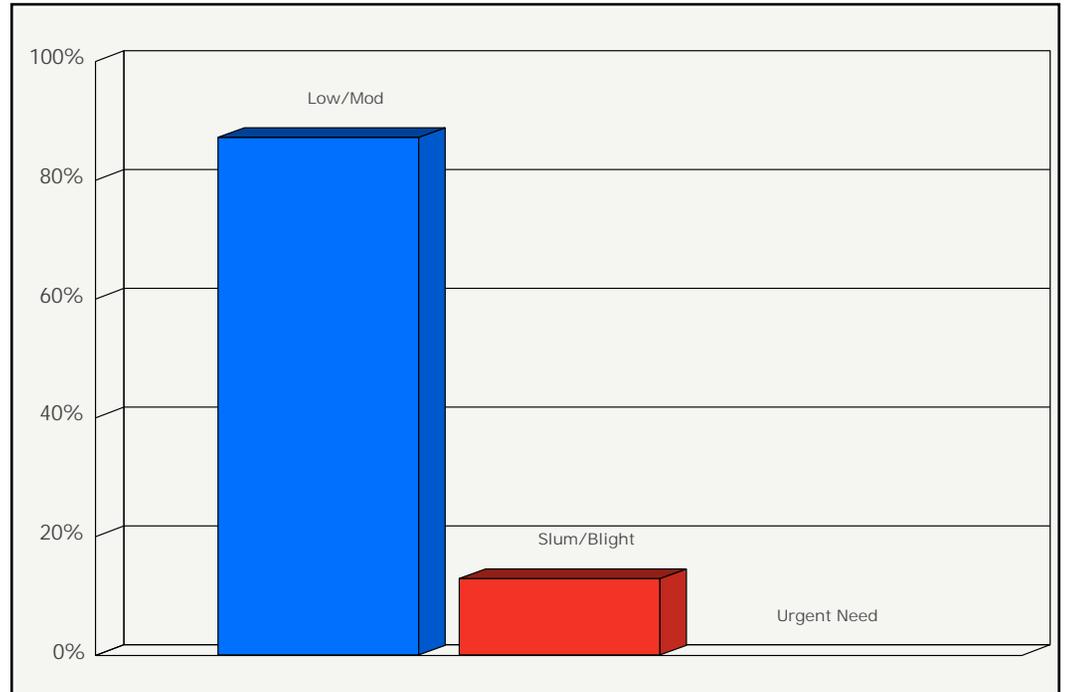

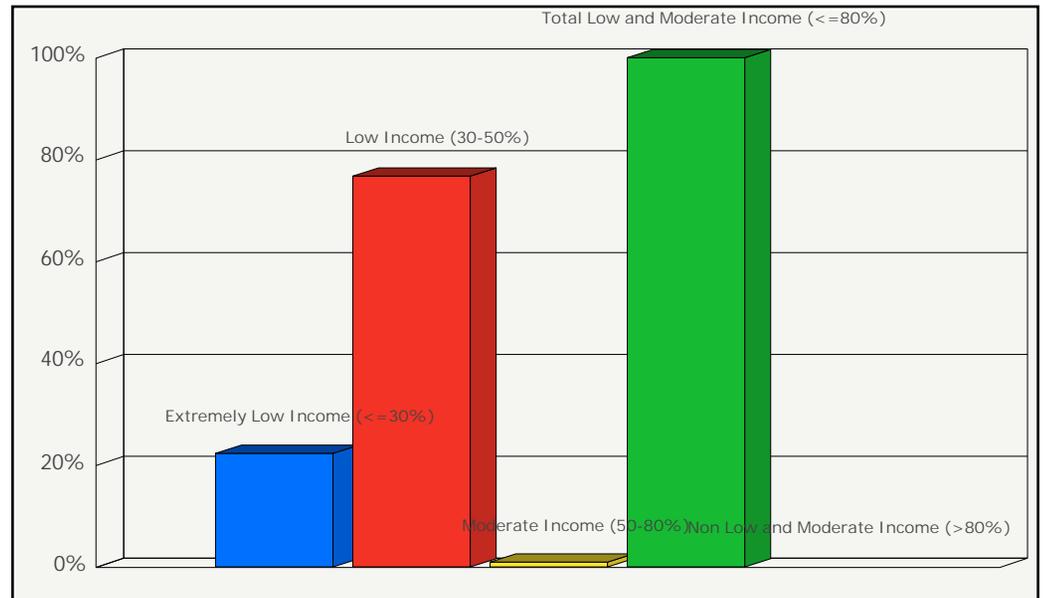
