
# The Texas Program – Hurricanes Dolly & Ike

- ▶ \$3.1 billion Disaster Recovery Program
- ▶ 11 million Texans affected (45% of population)
- ▶ 63,000 square miles, 22% of land area
- ▶ Over 300 communities in 62 counties
- ▶ Over 4,000 infrastructure projects
- ▶ Over 10,000 single-family homes

# The Texas Program – Hurricanes Dolly & Ike

- ▶ Three phases of funding:
  - **Round 1 – \$1.3 Billion**  
(50% housing/50% infrastructure)
  - **Round 2.1 – \$200 Million**  
(non housing only)
  - **Round 2.2 – \$1.6 Billion**  
(55% housing/45% infrastructure)




# Total Expenditures

# Planning & Admin Expenditures


## Texas Disaster Recovery Program Planning and Administrative Expenditures



- ▶ Reduce “Red Tape”
    - Expedited Contract Process
    - Amended DOB Policies
    - No Change Order Approval
  - ▶ Increase Oversight and Uniformity in Services
    - Housing Standards Manual
    - Regional Organizational Approach
  - ▶ Expedited Processes
    - Direct Contracting – Builder Assignments
    - Assignment Method for Construction Contractors
    - “Sweeping” Funds
    - Pre-agreement applicant qualifications
