

## CHANGE IN DATE OF CLOSE OF COMMENT PERIOD

Please be advised that close of the comment period specified in the Notice of Intent To Prepare an Environmental Impact Statement for the HOPE SF Development at Sunnydale and Velasco Public Housing Developments, San Francisco, CA published in the Federal Register on November 16, 2012 has been extended until January 18, 2013. This change from the current close of the comment period of December 16, 2012 is being made in response to requests from members of the public.

AGENCY: Mayor's Office of Housing, City and County of San Francisco.

ACTION: Extension of Comment Period for Notice of Intent To Prepare an Environmental Impact Statement for the HOPE SF Development at Sunnydale and Velasco Public Housing Developments, San Francisco, CA.

SUMMARY: The City and County of San Francisco gives notice to the public that the Mayor's Office of Housing (MOH) as the Federal Responsible Entity acting under authority of section 104(g) of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (42 U.S.C. 5304(g)), section 288 of the HOME Investment Partnerships Act (42 U.S.C. 12838), section 26 of the United States Housing Act of 1937 (42 U.S.C. 1437x) and HUD's regulations at 24 CFR part 58, intends to prepare a Draft Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Impact Statement (EIR/EIS) for the HOPE SF Development at the Sunnydale and Velasco Public Housing Developments (Sunnydale-Velasco HOPE SF Master Plan Project). The EIR/EIS will be a joint National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) document.

The Proposed Action is the approval by HUD of funding and development agreements associated with redevelopment of the Project Site with affordable housing. This notice is in accordance with regulations of the Council on Environmental Quality at 40 CFR parts 1500 – 1508.

All interested agencies, tribes, groups, and persons are invited to submit written comments on the scope of the Draft EIS to the contact person shown below. Comments received will be considered in the preparation and distribution of the Draft EIS. Particularly solicited is information on reports or other environmental studies planned or completed in the project area, major issues that the EIS should consider, recommended mitigation measures, and alternatives to the Proposed Action. Federal agencies having jurisdiction by law, special expertise or other special interest should report their interest and indicate their readiness to aid in the EIS effort as a "Cooperating Agency."

Dates: Comments relating to the scope of the DEIS are requested and will be accepted by the contact person listed below until January 18, 2013.
