Please be advised that the Office of Public and Indian Housing (PIH) Enterprise Income Verification (EIV) system weekend summarization job failed on September 3, 2011. This means that the following reports contain data as of **August 27, 2011**:

1. Deceased Tenants
2. Identity Verification
3. Immigration
4. Multiple Subsidy
5. New Hires
6. Income Reports By Reexamination Month

The Income Discrepancy Report is not available. However, in accordance with guidance provided in the May 2, 2011, PIH EIV webcast training materials, PHAs are **not** required to access the Income Discrepancy Report. EIV will display the following message if a PIH EIV user attempts to access the Income Discrepancy Report:
