**Environmental Review for Housing Rehabilitation**

**Nov. 17-18 | Bow, WA**

This interactive workshop addresses the environmental review requirements of 24 CFR Part 58 as they apply to HUD-funded housing rehabilitation activities. Participants will learn about the specific requirements that apply to housing rehabilitation, including NEPA and the other related laws and authorities, and how to evaluate and address them in the environmental review record, from project planning through HUD approval and release of funding. Participants will work with a specific project case study to develop a completed review, enabling them to learn and then use the new knowledge they have gained. The session will wrap up with a discussion of key stumbling points and environmental review best practices.
