

The President's Fatherhood Pledge

One simple way to engage dads at your event is to have them sign the President's Fatherhood Pledge. The pledge is part of the President's Fatherhood and Mentoring Initiative. Dads who sign the pledge will receive information on local and national events supporting fatherhood and mentorship; links to exceptional fatherhood and mentoring resources and access to specialized content.

HUD is encouraging all PHAs to have their dad sign the pledge. To request pledge cards, contact [Ben O'Dell](#) from the Department of Health and Human Services; the National Responsible Fatherhood Clearinghouse will mail you the cards. When sending your request, please include:

1. Name of the PHA contact
2. PHA Name
3. Address
4. Number of English cards they would like to receive (up to 400 cards per request)
5. Number of Spanish language cards (if any) that they would like to receive (up to 400 cards).
