OVERVIEW

Recipients of the Indian Housing Block Grant (IHBG) are required to complete an annual self-monitoring to ensure compliance with IHBG and other applicable federal requirements. During this 2-day course, participants will learn how to properly plan and execute a self-monitoring review with the help of appropriate case studies, exercises, and hands-on review of HUD's self-monitoring plan checklists. Other training topics will include: sampling methods, managing the self-monitoring process, preparation and submission of the self-monitoring report, and developing and implementing a Corrective Action Plan.
