Lance took those lessons learned early on in life and put them to good use. Lance acquired the reputation as a talented student athlete. Lance's strong desire to let athletics become the spring board towards a college degree, and career opportunities were established during his youthful participation in public housing programs. After graduating with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration, he headed to the Piedmont area of North Carolina. Not fully realizing that giving back to those less fortunate was what his heart was yearning for.

After years toiled in the private and non-for-profit sectors Lance, began working with distressed families who found themselves in trouble with the court system. It is this strong commitment to trying to reach out to those hard to reach individuals that no one else wants to work with or cannot seem to communicate with. It was his shared rough beginnings of going in and out of crime-ridden communities, prison and economic challenged communities that motivates Lance to work with community partners and stakeholders associated with public housing. Lance began work with SHA after working for the largest independent senior living housing company in the county where he served in the position as a property manager in both Virginia and North Carolina. His other work includes working with adjudicated individuals as a program director, manager and volunteer coordinator for the Governor's Mentoring program.
