

INFORMATION ON FILING FOR UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION

Furloughed federal employees may be eligible for unemployment compensation. State unemployment compensation requirements differ. Some States require a 1-week waiting period before an individual qualifies for payments. In general, the law of the State in which an employee's last official duty station in Federal civilian service was located will be the State law that determines eligibility for unemployment insurance benefits.
